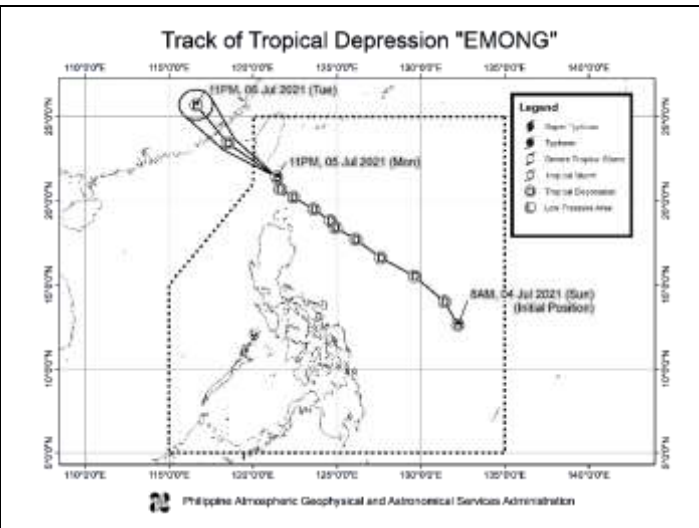
**Tropical Depression "EMONG"**

Issued at 2:00 AM, 6 July 2021

Valid for broadcast until the next bulletin at 5:00 AM today

**"EMONG" TURNS NORTH NORTHWESTWARD AND IS NOW NEAR THE COAST OF SOUTHERN TAIWAN**

<b>Location of Center (1:00 AM)</b>
The center of Tropical Depression "EMONG" was estimated based on all available data <b>at 140 km Northwest of Itbayat, Batanes (21.8°N, 121.0°E)</b>
<b>Intensity</b>
Maximum sustained winds of <b>55 km/h</b> near the center, gustiness of up to <b>70 km/h</b> , and central pressure of <b>1002 hPa</b>
<b>Present Movement</b>
<b>North northwestward at 30 km/h</b>
<b>Extent of Tropical Cyclone Winds</b>
<b>Strong winds</b> extend outwards up to <b>200 km</b> from the center

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<b>TROPICAL CYCLONE WIND SIGNALS IN EFFECT</b>			
<b>TCWS No.</b>	<b>Luzon</b>	<b>Visayas</b>	<b>Mindanao</b>
<b>1</b> (30-60 km/h Strong winds prevailing or expected in 36 hours)	<b>Batanes</b>	-	-
TCWS #1 over the Babuyan Islands is hereby lifted.			

<b>HAZARDS AFFECTING LAND AREAS</b>
<b>Severe Winds</b> Strong winds (strong breeze to near gale) will continue to prevail over Batanes. Winds will gradually weaken in the coming hours as the tropical depression moves away from Extreme Northern Luzon.
<b>HAZARDS AFFECTING COASTAL WATERS</b>
Under the influence of the tropical depression, rough seas (2.5 to 4.0 m) will be experienced over the seaboard of Batanes and Cagayan including Babuyan Islands. Sea travel is risky over these waters, especially for those using small seacrafts. Mariners without the proper experience should immediately seek safe harbor.
<b>TRACK AND INTENSITY OUTLOOK</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A landfall over Pingtung County in southern Taiwan is increasingly likely. On the forecast track, “EMONG” may exit the Philippine Area of Responsibility this morning.</li> <li>The high movement speed of “EMONG”, the weak nature of its circulation, and the frictional effects of Taiwan’s rugged terrain prevents it from further intensifying. “EMONG” is forecast to maintain its strength until it makes landfall over coast of Fujian or Guangdong country in southeastern China between this noon or afternoon.</li> </ul>

Considering these developments, the public and disaster risk reduction and management offices concerned are advised to take all necessary measures to protect life and property. Persons living in areas identified to be highly or very highly susceptible to these hazards are advised to follow evacuation and other instructions from local officials. **For heavy rainfall warnings, thunderstorm/rainfall advisories, and other severe weather information specific to your area, please monitor products issued by your local PAGASA Regional Services Division.**
