**Tropical Depression "EMONG"**

Issued at 11:00 AM, 6 July 2021

**TROPICAL DEPRESSION "EMONG" SLIGHTLY WEAKENS AND IS NOW OUTSIDE THE PHILIPPINE AREA OF RESPONSIBILITY.**

<b>Location of Center (10:00 AM)</b>	
The center of Tropical Depression "EMONG" was estimated based on all available data <b>at 335 km Northwest of Itbayat, Batanes (OUTSIDE PAR) (22.5°N, 119.2°E)</b>	
<b>Intensity</b>	
Maximum sustained winds of <b>45 km/h</b> near the center, gustiness of up to <b>55 km/h</b> , and central pressure of <b>1004 hPa</b>	
<b>Present Movement</b>	
<b>Northwestward at 20 km/h</b>	
<b>Extent of Tropical Cyclone Winds</b>	
<b>Strong winds</b> extend outwards up to <b>200 km</b> from the center

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HAZARDS AFFECTING LAND AREAS
With the lifting of the wind signal in Batanes, "EMONG" is no longer directly affecting the country.
HAZARDS AFFECTING COASTAL WATERS
Under the influence of the tropical depression, moderate to rough seas (1.5 to 3.0m) will be experienced over the seaboards of Batanes and Cagayan including Babuyan Islands. Mariners of small seacrafts are advised to take precautionary measures when venturing out to sea. Inexperienced mariners should avoid navigating in these conditions.
TRACK AND INTENSITY OUTLOOK
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>"EMONG" left the Philippine Area of Responsibility at 9:00 AM today. On the forecast track, "EMONG" will continue moving northwestward towards southeastern China and may weaken into a remnant low before it reaches the southeastern coast of southern China.</li></ul>

With these developments and unless re-entry occurs, this is the final bulletin for this tropical cyclone.
