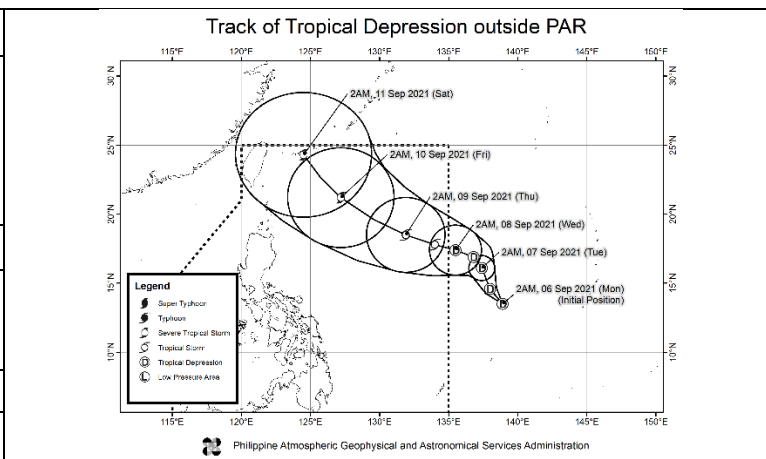
Tropical Depression

Issued at 5:00 AM, 06 September 2021

Valid for broadcast until the next advisory at 11:00 AM today.

THE LOW PRESSURE AREA OUTSIDE THE PHILIPPINE AREA OF RESPONSIBILITY WEST OF GUAM HAS DEVELOPED INTO A TROPICAL DEPRESSION

Location of Center (4:00 AM)
The center of the Tropical Depression was estimated based on all available data at 1,585 km East of Southern Luzon (13.7°N, 138.9°E) (outside the PAR)
Intensity
Maximum sustained winds of 45 km/h near the center, gustiness up to 55 km/h , and central pressure of 1006 hPa
Present Movement
North Northwestward at 15 km/h

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GENERAL OUTLOOK FOR THE FORECAST PERIOD

- The tropical depression developed from an area of low pressure over the Philippine Sea at 2:00 AM today.
- The tropical depression is forecast to enter the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) on Wednesday (08 September) morning. On the forecast track, the tropical cyclone will move generally northwestward and west northwestward over the Philippine Sea while inside the PAR region and will remain far from the Philippine landmass.
- The tropical cyclone is forecast to begin intensifying on Wednesday morning reach tropical storm strength by the afternoon or evening hours of the same day. By Friday (10 September), this weather system is forecast to reach severe tropical storm category.
- The tropical cyclone is unlikely to directly affect the weather condition in the country. However, this weather system may contribute to the moderate to rough seas over the northern and eastern seaboard of Northern Luzon on Friday.

Considering these developments, the public and disaster risk reduction and management offices concerned are advised to continue monitoring for updates related to this tropical cyclone.

Unless an intermediate advisory or initial tropical cyclone bulletin is released, the next tropical cyclone advisory will be issued at 11:00 AM today.
