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HAZARDS AFFECTING LAND AREAS

Heavy Rainfall

The trough of this tropical depression may bring rains over Metro Manila, Central and Southern Luzon, Antique, and Aklan. For more information, refer to Weather Advisory #2 issued at 11:00 AM today.

Severe Winds

In the next 24 hours, the enhanced northeasterly wind flow will bring occasional gusts reaching near gale to at times gale force in strength over Extreme Northern Luzon, while the enhanced southwesterlies will bring the same conditions over the coastal and upland/mountain areas along the western section of Central and Southern Luzon.

HAZARDS AFFECTING COASTAL WATERS

- Due to the hazardous sea conditions brought about by the tropical depression and the enhanced northeasterlies and southwesterlies, a Gale Warning is currently in effect over the seaboards of Northern Luzon and the westerm seaboards of Southern Luzon. For more information, refer to Gale Warning #3 issued at 5:00 AM today.
- Moderate to rough seas will prevail over the remaining western seaboard of Luzon and the eastern seaboard of the country. These conditions are risky for those using small seacrafts. Mariners are advised to take precautionary measures when venturing out to sea and, if possible, avoid navigating in these conditions.

TRACK AND INTENSITY OUTLOOK

Tropical Depression "LANNIE" exited the PAR at 5:00 AM today. On the forecast track, the tropical depression is forecast to move west northwestward in the next 24 hours towards central Vietnam.

Considering these developments, the public and disaster risk reduction and management offices concerned are advised to take all necessary measures to protect life and property. Persons living in areas identified to be highly or very highly susceptible to these hazards are advised to follow evacuation and other instructions from local officials. For heavy rainfall warnings, thunderstorm/rainfall advisories, and other severe weather information specific to your area, please monitor products issued by your local PAGASA Regional Services Division.

Unless re-entryoccurs, this is the final bulletin for this tropical cyclone. Succeeding updates will be incorporated in the 24-Hour Public Weather Forecast at 4:00 PM today.
