Intensity


Maximum sustained winds of **75 km/h** near the center, gustiness of up to **90 km/h**, and central pressure of **996 hPa**

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GENERAL OUTLOOK FOR THE FORECAST PERIOD

- "MALAKAS" will track generally northwestward today through Monday before decelerating while turning northward
 on Tuesday. On the forecast track, this tropical cyclone may enter the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) by late
 Monday or early Tuesday. "MALAKAS" will then turn to the northeast or north northeast beginning on Wednesday.
- This tropical cyclone is forecast to continue intensifying throughout the forecast period, reaching typhoon category by late Sunday or early Monday. A peak intensity of 155 km/h may be reached on late Monday or early Tuesday.
- "MALAKAS" is unlikely to directly affect the weather condition in the country. However, it may influence the movement
 and development of Tropical Depression "AGATON" as it tracks generally northwestward towards the PAR region.

Considering these developments, the public and disaster risk reduction and management offices concerned are advised to continue monitoring for updates related to this tropical cyclone.

Unless an intermediate advisory or initial tropical cyclone bulletin is released, the next tropical cyclone advisory will be issued at 11:00 AM today.
