Intensity


Maximum sustained winds of 45 km/h near the center, gustiness of up to 55 km/h, and central pressure of 1006 hPa

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GENERAL OUTLOOK FOR THE FORECAST PERIOD

- This tropical depression is forecast to track very slowly westward in the next 24 hours before gradually accelerating
 westward over the Philippines. On the forecast track, it may enter the PAR region on Monday and will be named
 QUEENIE. A turn to the west northwestward may occur by Tuesday as it approaches the sea area east of Mindanao.
 This tropical cyclone is forecast to remain as a tropical depression until Tuesday and may weaken into a remnant
 low on Wednesday.
- This weather system is unlikely to directly affect the country throughout the forecast period.

Considering these developments, the public and disaster risk reduction and management offices concerned are advised to continue monitoring for updates related to this tropical cyclone.

Unless an intermediate advisory or initial tropical cyclone bulletin is released, the next tropical cyclone advisory will be issued at 11:00 AM tomorrow.
