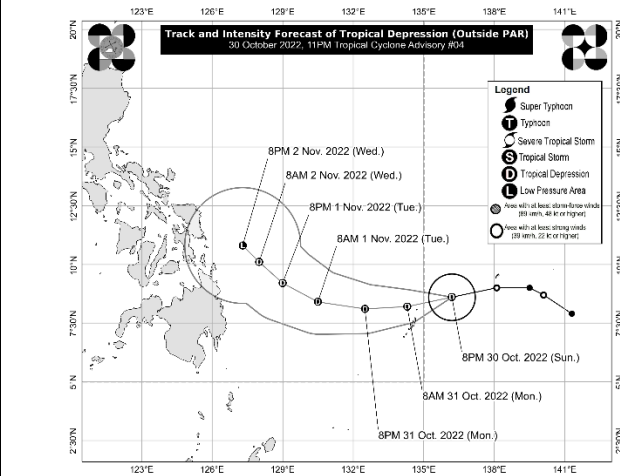
THE TROPICAL DEPRESSION TRACKS WEST SOUTHWESTWARD TOWARDS PALAU

Location of Center (10:00 PM):
 The center of the Tropical Depression was estimated based on all available data at **1,055 km East of Northeastern Mindanao (Outside the PAR) (8.3°N, 135.9°E)**

Intensity:
 Maximum sustained winds of **45 km/h** near the center, gustiness of up to **55 km/h**, and central pressure of **1004 hPa**

Present Movement:
West southwestward at 15 km/h

Extent of Tropical Cyclone Winds:
Strong winds extend outwards up to **110 km** from the center

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GENERAL OUTLOOK FOR THE FORECAST PERIOD

- This tropical depression is forecast to track west southwestward towards the vicinity of Palau in the next 12 hours before gradually turning westward over the Philippine Sea. On the forecast track, it will enter the PAR tomorrow morning as Tropical Depression QUEENIE. Inside the PAR region, this tropical cyclone will begin turning generally northwestward by late tomorrow or on Tuesday while heading towards the sea area east of Caraga Region or Eastern Visayas. Until Tuesday evening, this weather system will likely remain as a tropical depression. Weakening into a low pressure area is likely by Wednesday.
- This weather system is unlikely to directly affect the country until Tuesday. However, it may bring scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms over the Eastern Visayas-Caraga area on Wednesday.

Considering these developments, the public and disaster risk reduction and management offices concerned are advised to continue monitoring for updates related to this tropical cyclone.

Unless an intermediate advisory or initial tropical cyclone bulletin is released, the next tropical cyclone advisory will be issued at 11:00 AM tomorrow.
