Tropical Storm HAIKUI

Issued at 11:00 AM, 28 August 2023

Valid for broadcast until the next bulletin at 11:00 PM today.

THE TROPICAL DEPRESSION OUTSIDE THE PHILIPPINE AREA OF RESPONSIBILITY (PAR) INTENSIFIES INTO TROPICAL STORM "HAIKUI".

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GENERAL OUTLOOK FOR THE FORECAST PERIOD

- HAIKUI is forecast to move generally west northwestward over the Philippine Sea until Friday and may enter the PAR region on Wednesday evening or Thursday morning. Once inside the PAR, the domestic name "HANNA" will be assigned to this tropical cyclone. A generally northward or north northwestward turn may take place beginning Friday evening or Saturday morning as it moves over the northeastern region of the PAR.
- HAIKUI is forecast to steadily intensify over the next five days. It may reach severe tropical storm category within 36 hours and become a typhoon prior to entering the PAR region.
- The current forecast scenario suggests that HAIKUI is less likely to directly affect the country. However, it may enhance the Southwest Monsoon beginning on Wednesday or Thursday. This may result in the continuation of occasional or monsoon rains over the western portion of Luzon and Visayas throughout this week.

Considering these developments, the public and disaster risk reduction and management offices concerned are advised to take all necessary measures to protect life and property. Persons living in areas identified to be highly or very highly susceptible to these hazards are advised to follow evacuation and other instructions from local officials. **For heavy rainfall warnings, thunderstorm/rainfall advisories, and other severe weather information specific to your area, please monitor products issued by your local PAGASA Regional Services Division.**

The next tropical cyclone bulletin will be issued at 11:00 PM today.
