PREFACE.

To provide in one handy volume everything needed for the singing of choirs of boys, school children, sodalities, and congregations at High Mass throughout the ecclesiastical year, at Low Mass and at Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament, is the purpose of this book. Vesper psalms are not given, because the book would thereby assume larger proportions and greater cost than was intended, and also because convenient separate editions of these, in conformity with the New Antiphonale, are now available. The Liturgical chants included are taken from the official—Vatican—edition. Care has been exercised in the selection of the English texts. For the greater part, only such melodies as have stood the test of long use have been employed. It is believed that those of more recent composition which have found place will wear equally as well as those that have come to us from former ages. No texts (not even translations, no matter how excellent) or tunes of non-Catholic origin have been knowingly incorporated. It has been the aim

to offer such hymns only as are worthy, both in text and melody, of the high purpose for which they are destined and are therefore fit to form the taste and intelligence of those who sing them, whether young or old. For the sake of variety, five Masses corresponding to the various feasts and their degree of solemnity have been included.

The compiler gratefully acknowledges permission to quote from the excellent hymn book "Hosanna," generously extended by Reverend L. Bonvin, S. J., and B. Herder, the publishers; to the "Revue du chant Grégorien," for permission to use several numbers of "petites feuilles grégoriennes;" to Aloys Mayer, for the use of Eucharistic hymn, No. 70; to the Boston Music Company, for permitting the use of hymn No. 27, and to Professor John Singenberger, for the right to quote some of his accompaniments contained in "Cantiones Sacræ," published by Fr. Pustet and Company.

For the accompaniments to the Gregorian Masses, it is suggested that Dr. Matthias' accompaniment to the Kyriale (Fr. Pustet and Company) be used. The harmonies to the remaining contents of the book will appear in a separate volume.
