Article of Association for An Episcopal Church

Filed & Recorded in the Record of Deeds for La Porte County
Indiana in Book C, Page 227 on the 15th day of Oct. 1839.
Fee \$1.50 Paid (Gratuitous)

To all to whom these presents may concern
I knowye that I Franklin Thwing Clerk of the elect[ion]
at which Church Wardens & Vestrymen were chosen
as hereinafter mentioned, do certify that in pur-
suance of notice duly given according to law & the
rules & usages of the Protestant Episcopal Church
in the State or diocese of Indiana, for that pur-
pose, an Association of ten or more adults met
at the house of Franklin Thwing in the Town
of La Porte & County of La Porte & State aforesaid
on the 25th day of July A. D. 1839 for the pur-
pose of incorporating or organizing them-
selves under an Act entitled "An Act for the
appointment of Trustees to receive deeds for
Schools, meeting houses or Masonic lodges," and
the Act approved Feb'y 16th 1839 entitled "An Act
supplemental to an Act entitled "An Act for
the appointment of Trustees to receive deeds for
lots or lands given or purchased for the use of
Schools, meeting houses & Masonic lodges ap-
proved Feb'y 10th 1831 - at which meeting the
number of ten or more adults as aforesaid resolved
in Convention to adopt & be governed by the
Constitution & Canons of the Protestant Episco-
pal Church; That at the same time & place, The
Rev. D. V. M. Johnson was appointed Chairman
& Franklin Thwing Secretary, John Hobbes
Franklin Thwing were elected Church Wardens
P. Holbrook, Jacob Early, P. B. Bill, J. H. Phillips,
Samuel Stewart, J. H. Phillips, Samuel Stewart, J. H. Phillips,

James Whittier were elected Vestrymen, by
a majority of the persons present duly
qualified to vote for said Officers, and that
the name of the Church Warden & Vestry-
men of St Paul's Church in the Town of
La Porte was in like manner fixed on &
agreed to as that by which the said Church
Church Congregation or Society shall be
known in law. And that Monday in
Easter week be the day for the Annual Elec-
tion of the Officers aforesaid, according to the
rules & usages of the Protestant Episcopal
Church. In testimony whereof I have here-
unto set my hand this 25th, day of July 1839
Franklin Thwing, Clerk.

Walter E. Franklin was elected Rector July 12th 1854.
July 18th He arrived in La Porte,

July 19th 1856. The Rev. Walter E. Franklin, Rector of St Paul's (Old La Porte), died.
August 5th 1856. The Rev. Almon Gregory A. M. then Rector of St Thomas (Old La Porte, N. Y.)
was elected Rector of St Paul's (Old La Porte). Officialled in the same & preached
next Sunday, Sunday, 14th after Trinity, Aug. 24th & catechized - dignified his ac-
knowledgment of his Rectorship to the 1st of September 24th 1856 to commence (Oct. 1st 1856 -
with the 1st of June of the same year, Oct. 30th & held his first Sunday service
consisting of two religious observances of the Holy Communion on ^{as Rector} Nov. 2nd 1856. He died

The Rev Almon Gregory resigned the Rectorship of St Paul's
Old La Porte, Ind. April 15th 1861; & here places on Record the fol-
lowing facts: - The Parish was organized July 25, 1839. The earliest recorded
baptism was on Nov. 24, 1838; & the first confirmation in 1839, but in whose month does
not appear. The Register of communicants dates from July 1st 1840. The two earliest
marriages are without date: the first recorded date being July 4, 1843. The first Bazaar
(as far as the Register shows,) was in 1842.

The whole number of Baptisms recorded is 145 - 6 by the Rev. S. V. M. Johnson,
on - all of whom appear to have been children; 53 by the Rev. J. W. Mearns,
of whom 5 were adults; - 1 by the Rev. F. S. Naviman; - 15 by the Rev. F. R. Hoff, of
whom 2 were adults; - 5 by the Rt. Rev. G. Appold D.D., all of whom were children; -
3 by the Rev. W. E. Franklin, 7 of whom were adults; - one, an adult
by the Rev. G. A. Bruce; & 49 by the Rev. A. Gregory, of whom 9 were
adults. There were confirmed, while the Rev. Mr. Johnson
was in charge of the Parish, 3 persons; 23 while the Rev. Mr. Mearns
was in charge of it; 4, during the Rev. Mr. Hoff's Rectorship; 12, while
the Rev. Mr. Franklin was Rector; & during the Rectorship of the
Rev. A. Gregory, 27 - (4 of them at Plymouth;) - making in all
total of 69 persons confirmed.

The whole number of Marriages, as indicated by the Parish Register, is 59. Of these 2 were probably by the Rev. Mr. Johnson; 20 by the Rev. Mr. Manney; 3 by the Rev. Mr. Haff; 13 by the Rev. Mr. Franklin; 23 by the Rev. A. Gregory.

The Register contains the entries of 51 Burials:— 21 by the Rev. Mr. Manney; 5 by the Rev. Mr. Haff; one by the Rev. Mr. Franklin; one by St. Cyprian; & 23 by the Rev. A. Gregory.

As it regards the List of Communicants, (omitting to count any name more than once,) there are in all 138 names on the Parish Register. Of these 138— 54 seem to have been recorded by the Rev. Mr. Manney; 16 are in the handwriting of the Rev. Mr. Haff; 19 were entered by the Rev. Mr. Franklin; & 49 by the Rev. Mr. Gregory.

Making a total exclusive of Rector's Salary of 3836.42 for a period of (say,) four years & ten months.

The writer of this Record, has, during his rectorship of the Parish read divine service 820 times— (712 at La Porte & rest chiefly at Plymouth.)— Preached 644— (102 at Plymouth.)— Administered the Holy Communion 76 times— (68 in St. Paul's & La Porte.)— & catechised 104 times the children of the Parish.

This Record covers a period of about 32½ years: The part relating to acts done during the Rectorship of the Writer of this is only 4½ years, or just one fifth of the whole time; while the proportion of the Baptisms, number Confirmed, Marriages, burials, & names of Communicants entered on the Parish Register during the last 4½ years by the Rev. A. Gregory is more than One third of the whole.

July 1st 1862. Rev. H. Bishop accepted charge of this parish of St. Paul's La Porte Ind.

April 23^d 1864. Rev. James H. Lee accepted a call to the rectorship of this parish of St. Paul's La Porte Ind. Entered upon his duties the following day, Apr. 24th 1864.
