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ADVERTISEMENT.

The contents of this book are copied from three manuscript volumes.

A. is a parchment book of 38 leaves ($10\frac{1}{4}$ ins. by 6 ins.) of which a half of the last one has been lost. It is in very bad repair and is in some places quite illegible, in others only capable of being read by those who are accustomed to decipher such documents. It contains weddings from 1596, baptisms from 1600, and burials from 1594, and ends in the middle of the year 1722.

B. is a paper book, of which 36 leaves ($14\frac{1}{2}$ by $9\frac{3}{4}$) contain weddings from 1754 to 1812.

C. is a paper book, of which 32 leaves ($9\frac{1}{2}$ by $7\frac{1}{2}$) contain baptisms from 1757 and burials from 1778, in each case to 1812.

The reprint aims at being an exact copy of the original MSS., and except that in B. and C. an economy has been practised in the case of common words which constantly recur, the entries are given letter for letter as they were first written.
