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PREFACE

The civil history of this county begins with the passage by the Fifth General Assembly of the State, held at Vandalia, commencing on the fourth day of December 1826, and closing on the nineteenth day of February 1827, of the "Act Creating Perry County". The act was signed by Governor Ninian Edwards on January twenty-ninth, 1827, at which time it took effect and went into force.

The county was named in honor of the great naval commander, Commodore Oliver H. Perry. Pinckneyville was later selected as the county seat.

The first marriage license recorded in this county was issued 17 November 1827. Any previous to that time might perhaps be found in Randolph or Jackson, the parent counties of Perry, or in Washington or Franklin counties which adjoin Perry.

These records were originally copied by Dorothy I. Cooke and Elizabeth Eiker Spurgeon and were later indexed and corrections made by Mrs. Spurgeon. The many notations are also hers and were taken from probate and other court house records, tombstone inscriptions, and consent of parent or guardian from the original application.

This record has been considerably updated since the original and we trust that to any who are searching you will be saved much time and your work made easier by this effort.

PREFACE

The civil history of this county begins with the passage by the 17th General Assembly of the State, held at Nashville, commencing on the fourth day of December 1816, and closing on the thirtieth day of February 1817, of the "Act Creating Perry County." The act was signed by Governor Hilditch on January twenty-ninth, 1817, at which time it took effect and went into force.

The county was named in honor of the great naval commander, Commodore Oliver H. Perry. Winchester was later selected as the county seat.

The first mortgage license recorded in this county was issued in November 1817. Any previous to that time might perhaps be found in Randolph or Jackson, the parent counties of Perry, or in Washington or Franklin counties which adjoin Perry.

The many notations are also here and were taken from probate and other court house records, company inscriptions, and records of parent or guardian from the original application.
