RULES

I.

Change in location of telephone must be preceded by at least ten days notice to the company.

II.

Cost of change will be charged to the subscriber.

III.

Moving or altering telephone or wiring, must be done by company only.

IV.

Attachments to telephones must not be made.

V.

Improper Language must not be used through the telephone.

VI.

Conversations between exchanges are limited to five minutes. Do not hold the line for a longer period.

VII.

Change in numbers may have to be made by the company, which reserves to itself the right to do so, although such action will be made as infrequent as possible.

VIII.

Toll Messages will be charged against the telephone which originated them, and the subscriber for that telephone will be held responsible for the payment of all such charges.

IX.

Toll Charges. If you wish a toll call sent collect, notify the Operator when you give the call, as message cannot be made collect after the conversation has taken place.

X.

Telephones are rented to subscribers for their own use, and the use of the immediate family and employees. You must not permit outsiders to use your telephone, as it is a violation of your contract with this company, and it is also detrimental to the service.

XI.

Subscribers will receive no refund for voluntary non-use of their telephone unless the telephone is not used for 30 consecutive days and the company is notified before the beginning of that time, in which case a refund of one-half rental will be allowed.

WHERE THE COST OF INSTALLATION is out of proportion to the exchange revenue, the subscriber will be required to pay a reasonable portion of such cost.

THE CONTINUOUS USE OF A PARTY LINE is limited to five minutes. Subscribers are necessarily associated on the line with the others located nearest to them using the same class of service. Mutual accommodations usual in public service of any kind where two or more persons are concerned should be extended between party line users.

IN FURNISHING OUR TWO PARTY BUSINESS and two and four party service, we reserve the right to place any subscribers together on party lines that have the same class of service.

ALL BILLS FOR TELEPHONE SERVICE are due on the first day of each month.

ALL RURAL SUBSCRIBERS must pay bills at local office.

OUR COLLECTOR WILL CALL ONCE ONLY on each subscriber within the city limits, at any place designated by the subscriber. If for any reason, payment is not received when the collector calls, the subscriber will then be required to make the payment at our local office.

ALL BILLS MUST BE PAID by the 20th of each month, otherwise the service will be discontinued until settlement is made.

RULES FOR GOOD SERVICE

1. **Use the Directory.** Never try to remember a telephone number. It's all right if you do remember it; but to try to remember is to begin to guess. If you have the least doubt about it look it up and thus save time and trouble.

2. **Speak Out All Figures, by giving each figure separately,** as "one, three, seven, nine," for "1379."

(The following of this rule is essential to good service. A majority of errors in calls is directly traceable to confusion between "eighteen" and "thirteen," "twenty-three" and "thirty-three," etc., which sound so much alike over the telephone; also to the fact that subscribers do not correct the Operator if she repeats the wrong number.)

3. **Speak Distinctly, especially when giving the number to the Operator and when talking over the toll line.** Talk into the mouthpiece, loud and close enough so they can hear you easily.

4. **Answer Your Bell Promptly.** A ring means a friend calling you—don't make him wait, or perhaps miss you entirely.

5. **Be Brief but Courteous to the Operators.** We require them to be so to you. They have no time to converse with you; they do not know subscribers' names; they deal entirely with numbers.

Courtesy, like virtue, is its own reward, but pays extra dividends in connection with telephone service. Try it!

6. **Call for "Information"** when you can't find the telephone number you want, or to get answers to any questions regarding subscribers' names or numbers. Your regular Operator cannot answer such questions.

7. **Report all Complaints to Chief Operator, 1000,** to be most effective they should be not only prompt, but should describe accurately the trouble encountered. Many forms of trouble look alike at first, and most of them we will not know about until you tell us. If you can't get Central at all, call us from a neighbor's or send us a post card.

We Want This Help from You—in the form of accurate detail complaints—by printing these pages in our directory; by explaining in any way we can the operation of our system and the reason for our rules and regulations; also by calling attention to our Simple Rules which, if followed by all, will make it easy for us to give, and for you to get, Good Service—which is what we are here for.

Important Notice

We have so many subscribers that it is obviously impossible for our operators to remember their telephone numbers; in fact, we cannot allow them to even try to, as that would too often result in their **Guessing** at them, thus disturbing other subscribers. Therefore, will you **Please Call by Number Only-- Look Up the Number--Do Not Guess at it!**
