The articles in MORID'S FORK of which you spoak, have been very widely commented on, though they contain nothing that misaionary noricers have not long known. The world at large, however, has little ider of the inmonse extent of the missionaxy activities, and would be still more astoninina if it knew how economically and frugally they are carried on. For instance, all the medical mismionary work of our Board, with its one hundred hospitals and diapensaries, treating overy year between three hundred and four hundred thousand patients, costs less than one of our large Now York hospitals.

I think that either one of the plans which you auggest would be very useful in bringing misbionary information bofore the reader of the RECORD. Indeed, I should thikk that it would be well to use both plans. one year having a series of articles, each of which would treat some ane gratt mission field comysehensively, and the next year having a series dealing with the various methods or departments of mork in all the fiolds. You would. have to allow time for the proparation of the ariticlea, and also get hold of men and women compotent to write thom. If I can bo of any heln to you in auggesting names, I shall be very glad to do anything I can.

As to the other matter, - a short article giving rwasons for fowign Migtsions, I will write it if I cas, but Ihev got a lot of other thinge on hera just row. I have no doubt thut mat you asy is true, that a gront ruchy peopte
