## ORDERS FROM UNKNOWN CORRESPONDENTS

Must be accompanied by remittance or satisfactory reference.

## TO PARTIES KNOWN TO US

Accounts are payable June 1st, 1895, for all bills bought previous to that date. For subsequent purchases prompt settlement will be expected on December 1st.

## A CASH DISCOUNT OF 5% (except where noted)

Allowed on orders accompanied by remittance, as also on all bills paid within ten days after receipt of goods. It is, however, distinctly understood that Potatoes, Onion Sets, Grass, Grain, Clover and Bird Seeds, Tools and Implements of all kinds, Fertilizers and Insecticides are not subject to any discount and are sold strictly *net cash*.

## 10 Lbs. and Upwards Furnished at 100 Lb. Rates

Whenever seeds are offered by the hundred pounds, we furnish 10 lbs. at 100 lb. rate, but we cannot supply less than a quarter lb., or a quarter bushel at the lb. or bushel rate. When less quantities (by weight or measure) than these are wanted they will be billed at retail rates, from which we allow a discount of one-third.

## We Shall Adhere to the Prices Herein Given

As far as possible but we reserve the right to advance prices without notice should circumstances require it. We also reserve the right to decline orders for any one variety should the demand for it be likely to force us to shorten up customers who annually depend upon us for their general supplies of seeds. Orders accepted subject to being unsold.

## WE MAKE NO CHARGE FOR CARTAGE

Boxes, barrels, or packing. Bags only are charged for, and these at cost.

## WE DO NOT "COMMISSION"

Or placé Vegetable or Flower seeds out "on sale." In no case are the choicest and best germinating stocks used for commission boxes. The public, too, are becoming aware of this and avoid "commission" seeds, while ours are sought after, because they are of the very best quality and such as are supplied to our most critical market gardening trade.

To have all seeds, plants and bulbs pure and reliable, we do not give any warranty express or implied. If the purchaser does not accept the seeds on these terms and conditions, they must be returned at once, and the money that has been paid for the same will be refunded.—P. H. & Co.

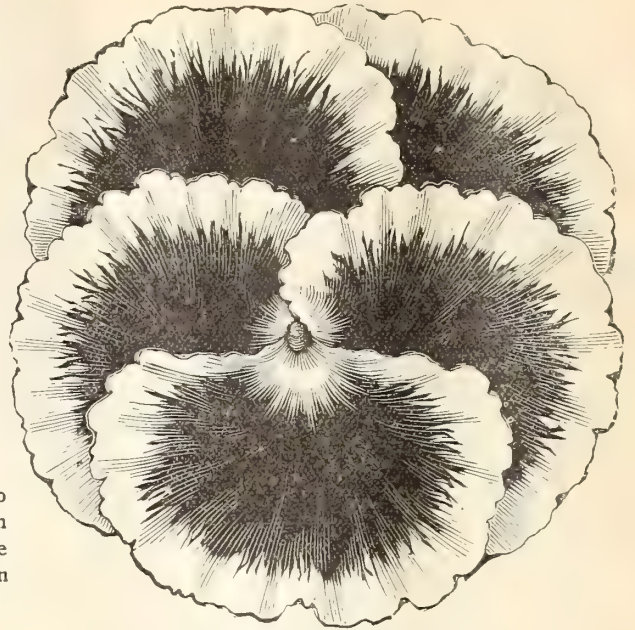
