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
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




















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








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







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







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Philipse Manor Inn

THE INN

Is situated within 200 yards of the river, on rising ground, in a restricted colony. It has an unobstructed view of many miles, which is not surpassed for extent or beauty, and yet is within a short distance of New York City. Sunsets on the river, both winter and summer, are beyond description.

Rooms are of unusual size. Some are provided with open fireplaces and some have balcony, while all have large windows which look out either upon the river, or the Sleepy Hollow country. They are





tastefully furnished; are cool and airy in summer, and in winter are protected with double window-sash and heated by a hot water system. Ample closet space is a feature of all the rooms.
