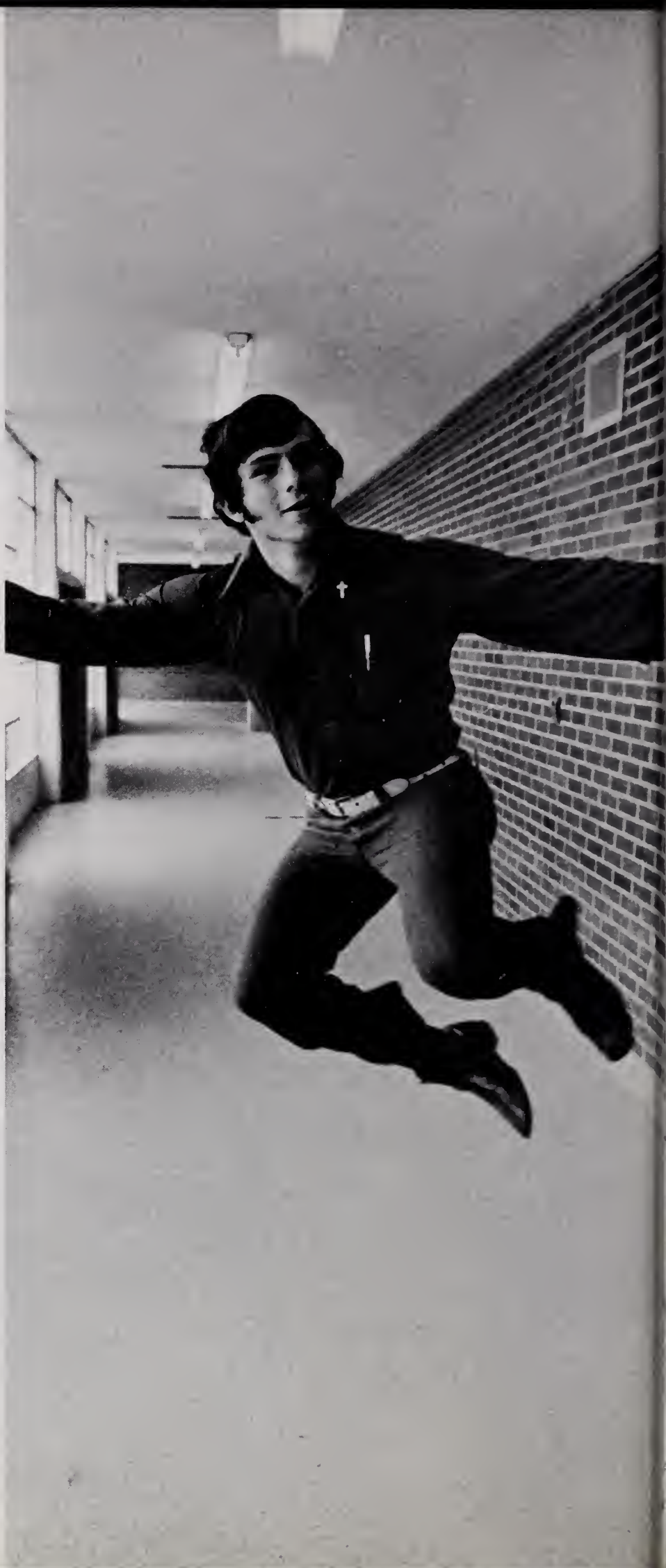

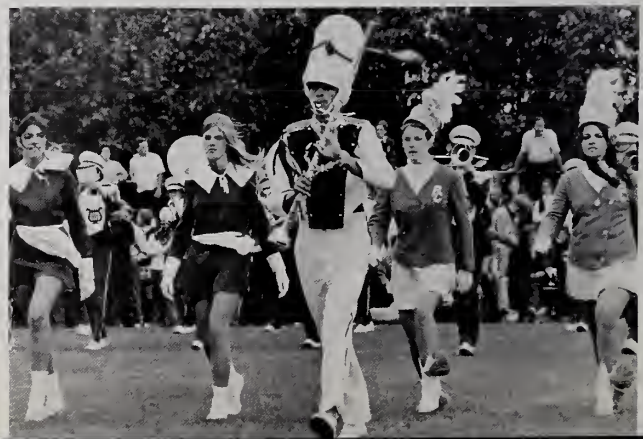

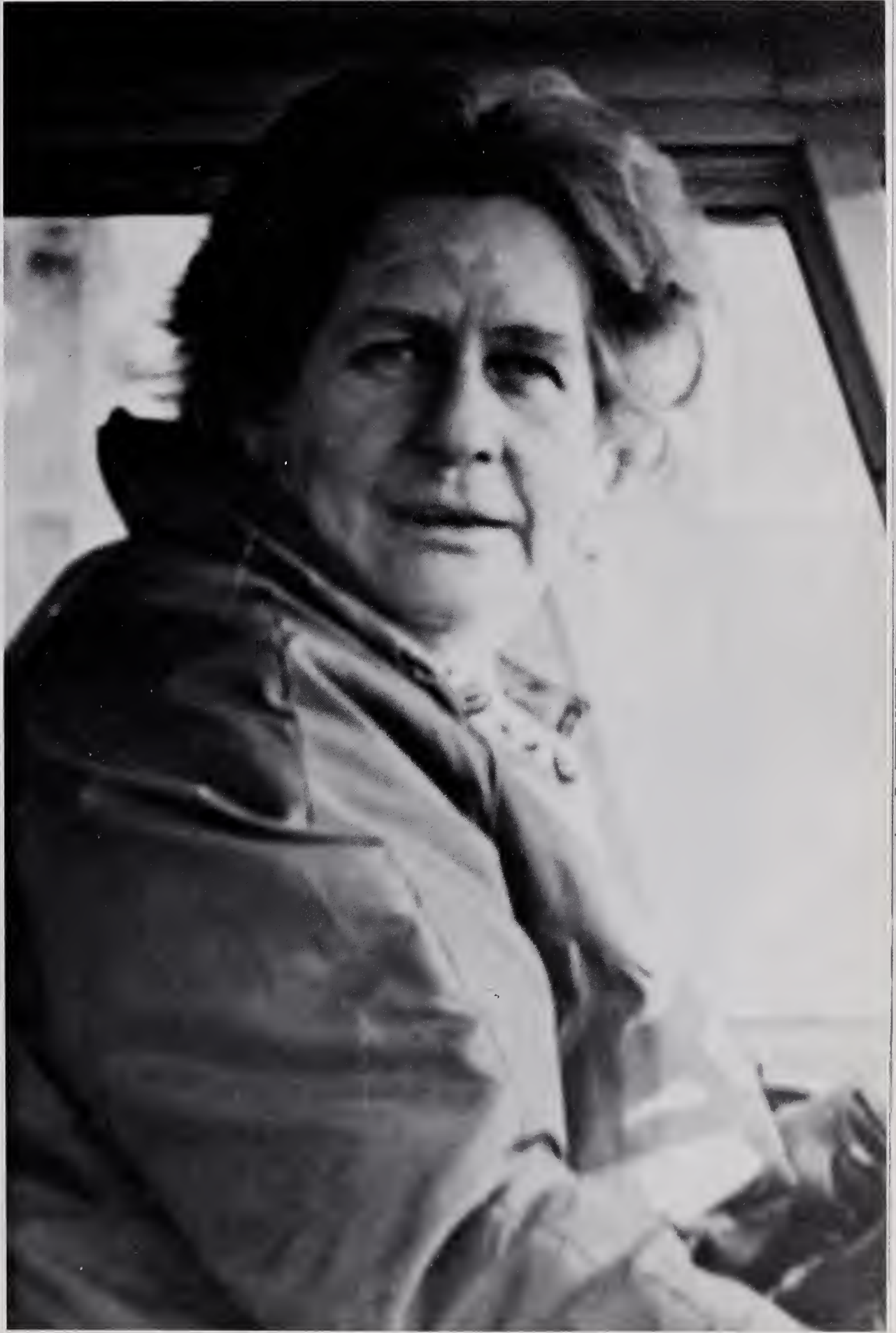
DEDICATION

This past winter roundball was back into its old form here at Plymouth-Carver as the Blue Eagles under Coach Hank Rogers won the Old Colony League Title.

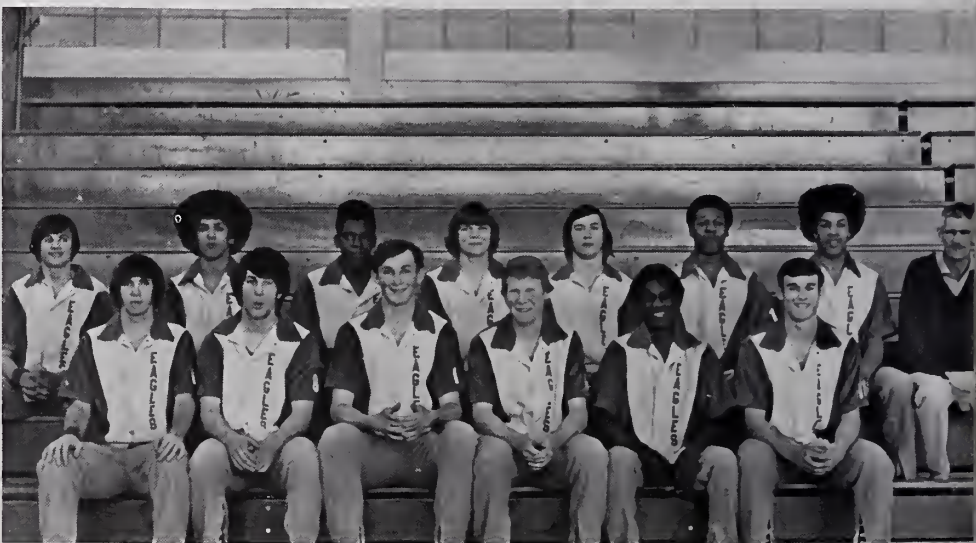

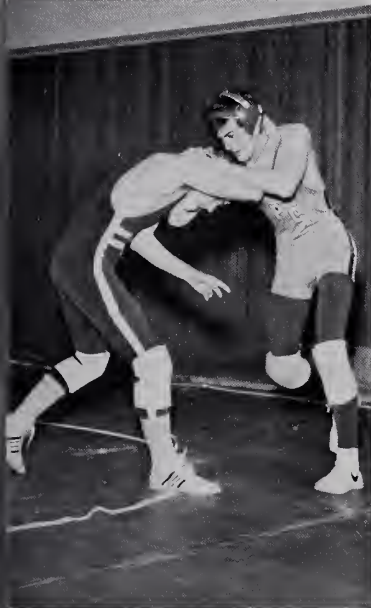
The first win came at the first Interscholastic Wrestling Match at P.C. 39-36 over Hingham, that effort was duplicated at Hingham the last match of the season.
