This was more important than any rig played in Belfast. The last time the Clash attempted to play they were thwarted by authority and we were attacked by the cops. The group suffered & from the trip because of the Army photos and the "I only saw hi -s back" disaster experienced by the edit -or and many more. When the whole sickening business was over they said they'd be back I didn't believe them but they kept their word.

I prefer to forset about the controversy over the cancellation of one of the shows. So lets start about 8.00. The queues getting bigger and bigger, the fuzz are getting worried, I'm getting drunk and car -ried away(literally)(s'rite-Ed)and the Clash are tuning up. Fecause of a disagree -ment I missed THE LOU'S(he got lifted). But I was back just in time to hear the c -pening mumber-Complete Control ... it sounded great. Proving that it was the single of '77 no matter what anyone says. I don't know what the sound should've been like(Strummer says it should have been better), but it didn't matter to me or any of the other 600 kids or so in the hall. "U.S.A.", "Janie", "Frotex", "1977", all those fucking classics from that fucking classic album & "Capital Radio". No bouncers either Mick said to me the rext day ... "Hey, wasn't it great without any heavior to we your way" ... 

RUDI, reckoned by many to be Ulster's top new wave tand, have been coing fo -r almost 3 years now and have had several line-up changes. Changes which have improved the band from very good to excellent. XX XXXXXXXX Until recet -ntly their bass player was John Stu art but he left and has since been replaced by a very impressive bass player-Cordon Flair. (Due to circumst -ances beyond our control, we ain't got any pics of him ... we'll print one in the next issue to make up for it. O.K.?) The band have built up quite a following and claim that they have played more gigs than any other band ... "'Cos we're the bast". The band have played such select places as the Glenmachan Tower Hotel and Bangor's Trident.

Brian tells me that the band do not want to be classed in any category whatsoever ... "We don't want to be in a class with a load of bandwagon jump -ers.We don't want to be classed as 'new wave' because the term only appl -ies to STUPID groups. We are in a cla -ss of our own. "Cops"-if you haven't guessed it is about the fighting outside the Uls ter Hall when the Clash called off th -eir gig on Oct.20th.It starts with wailing siren and the chant .. "S.S.RUC" it HAS to be released as a single."Cops' is the REST tune I have ever heard from one of 'our own' bands.





I've only been here once before a lad of 12 and I can't remember much about that. We've been trying to get to play here for ages but we have had prob -lems so we couldn't get here. I've had a few hassles with that man McCann and we don't really get on too well." What groups do you like? "I really like the Pamones, I saw them last week and they w -ere great, big Joey don't like the Pistols though. He saw them play and he told me "Man, they look so fucking amateurish" .. they do, and Sid Vicious is THE worst bass player I have ever saw in my life. God, you could pick up someone lying in II the gutter with a bottle in his hand and he could play better bass. Don't get me wrong though, I loved their first 3 records but " ddicn't like ".I.m.s." ,I think the Clash are a really great bunch of guys but I don't agree with what they are trying to say." Why are you in a band?? "I want to be famous I want to have money, I want to have women ... I've never had fame, money, or women and I want that ... why shouldn't I have those thing -s if I want them?"

Geldof also says that punk won't change anything..."No, it won't, writing songs isn't good enough, youv'e got to get up and say something big, like a big politician...the new wave will last, but it wen't change a thirm.

Pete Briquette, bass player was in a good mood when I spoke to him...What did you thin -k of the sig?..."A ggod one..very enjoyable" How long have you been in the band? "From the start, which was 2 years ago." I've been told that you didn't used to play punk music so what did you play?..."Well, we didn't play punk music and we still don't...we play good rock'n'roll, we always have done. It's that which attracts such a mixed crowd to our gig

-s, sometimes we get beavy punks'...in fact, that happens a lot...and at the same gig we get beavy hippies'..if there is such a thing as beavy hippies'...and you see all those guys up there and they are pogoing and it really makes you feel good. It means you are doing something worthwile."

Well, there you have it, the test gig I have ever been to, and I'll be there when they return in March '78. Watch out for the noo album in Feburary called (according to Geldof) "As Seen On T.V."
