## THE COLLECTION OF NUMISMATIC AND REFERENCE BOOKS OF THE LATE CLARENCE S. BEMENT, ESQR.

---

In presenting to collectors the Numismatic Library of the late Clarence S. Bement, Esqr., of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, some mention should be made of the features of this unusual offering.

Mr. Bement's tastes were scholarly and cultured, hence his great interest in classical, historical and artistic coins and numismatic books. Of those works which relate to Numismatics there are over a hundred different kinds on ancient and mediaeval coins, embracing the finest group of these ever offered at auction in the United States. The British Museum is represented by an almost complete line of books relating to this series and many of them are either out of print or very scarce. There are fine works by Cohen, Babelon, Head, Gardner, and many other writers no less distinguished.

The collection of finely bound, illustrated and priced auction coin sale catalogues, of the greatest aid to collectors for ready reference and for the identification of obscure pieces, is extensive. The numismatic works embrace around three hundred lots. Added to these are the special books used in connection with Mr. Bement's study of Numismatics and kindred subjects, which include fine works on Ancient History, Archaeology, Ancient Religions, Literature, the Fine Arts, Dictionaries, Reference Works and books on Mineralogy. There are a few interesting old Colored Prints and Water-Colors, as well as a small group of Ancient Egyptian Relics.

The entire sale, which embraces something over four hundred lots, has been put into a single session, as we feel there is not quite a sufficient number of lots to offer in two. On this account we urge those interested, who live in this vicinity, to kindly call within several days prior to the date of the sale and examine the lots, as it will be impracticable to exhibit each lot as it is put up for sale, except in the cases of the sets of books, such as Cohen's Work on Roman Coins, the Century Dictionary, Gibbons History of Rome, etc., one volume of which sets will be shown when the lot is being offered.
