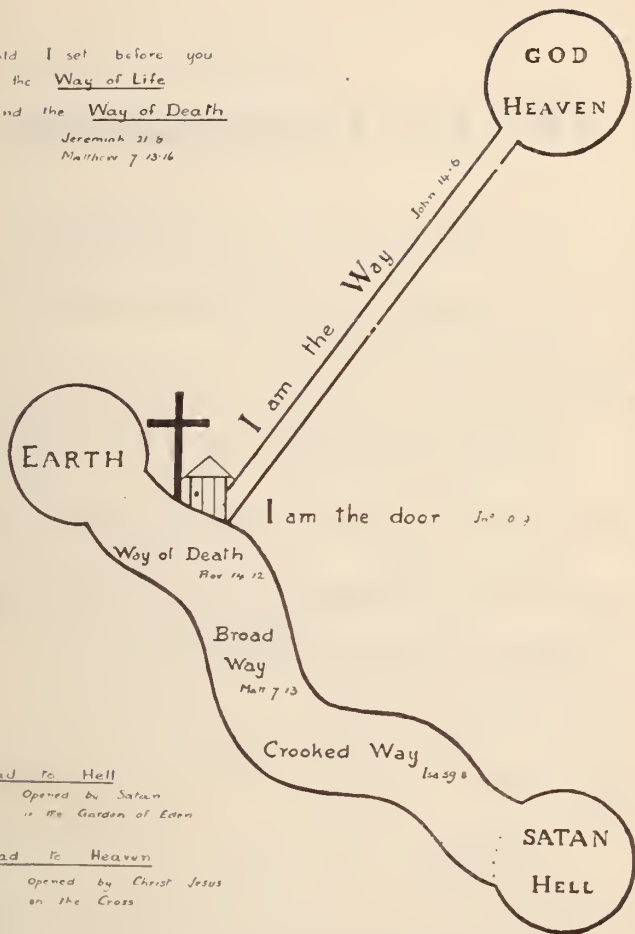

7. Thou shalt not commit adultery.
8. Thou shalt not steal.
9. Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour.
10. Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, ...nor anything that is his. EXODUS 20. 1-17.

1. What do you call this?
The Ten Commandments.
2. Who spoke these words?
God.
3. Where did he speak them?
On Mount Sinai.
4. Who did he speak them to?
To Moses and the children of Israel.
5. Were they only for the children of Israel?
No, for everyone.
6. Why did God give us the Ten Commandments?
To shew us our sin.
7. Has any man kept the Ten Commandments?
Only one—Jesus.
8. The Ten Commandments are like three things;
what are they?
**God's looking-glass; Chain with 10 links; God's
foot-rule.**
9. What do you see in this looking-glass?
Sin in my heart.
10. How are the Ten Commandments like a chain?
If you break one link you break the chain.
11. Use God's foot-rule to try man, what do you find?
**All have sinned and come short of the glory of
God.**

Texts.

1. Tell me one text where God says if we break one command we are guilty of all.

Whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one point, he is guilty of all.

JAMES, 2.10.

What does "whosoever" mean?

Every-one.

What does "the whole law" mean?

All God's Commands.

What does "offend in one point" mean?

Break one command.

What does "guilty" mean?

Sinner.

2. How many men have sinned?

All have sinned, and come short of the glory of God.

ROMANS, 3.23.

3. What is the end of sinners?

The soul that sinneth, it shall die. EZEKIEL, 18 4.

4. What are the wages of sin?

The wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life, through Jesus Christ our Lord.

ROMANS, 6.23.

5. How do you know God loves us?

God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

JOHN, 3.16.

What does "the world" mean?

Everyone who lives on this earth.

What does "perish" mean?

Die, and go to hell.

What does "everlasting life" mean?

To live in heaven for ever.

6. Why did Jesus come from Heaven?

"Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners."

1 TIMOTHY, 1.15.

7. How does Jesus save sinners?

"While we were yet sinners, Christ died for us."

ROMANS, 5.8.

8. How can we become children of God?

"Ye must be born again—born of the Spirit."

JOHN, 3.7,8.

9. What must we do?

"Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out."

ACTS, 3.19.

10. If we turn from sin, will that save us?

No. God says "Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved."

ACTS, 16.31.

11. When we believe what must we do?

Be baptized. "When they believed . . . they were baptized, both men and women."

ACTS, 8.12.

Does baptism save us?

No.

What must we be before we are baptized?

Born again.

Why do you want to be baptized?

Because I belong to Jesus, and I want to do what He says.

What do you do when you are baptized?

Confess Jesus before men.

What is baptism a picture of?

Death and resurrection.

How is it a picture of death?

We go under the water to shew we are buried with Christ.

How is it a picture of resurrection?

We come up out of the water to shew we are risen again to walk in newness of life.

12. Why must we confess the Lord Jesus?

Because God says, With the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

ROMANS, 10.10.

13. What does God say about being a new creature?

Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature; old things are passed away; behold all things are become new.

2 CORINTHIANS, 5.17.

14. What does God promise if we are faithful?

Be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life.

REVELATION, 2.10.

The Creation and Fall, Cain and Abel and the Flood.

1. Who made everything?
"In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth."
2. What does "create" mean?
To make out of nothing.
3. How long did God take to make the world?
Six days.
4. What does God say about His work?
"God saw everything that he had made, and behold it was very good."
5. What did God do on the seventh day?
He rested.
6. How did God make man?
God made man in His own image—out of the dust of the ground.
7. How did God make woman?
He made the man sleep, and took a rib out of his side.
8. How did God give them a spirit?
He breathed into their nostrils the breath of life.
9. What were the names of the first man and woman?
Adam and Eve.
10. Where did God put them?
In the Garden of Eden.
11. Were they happy?
Yes.

12. Why?
Because there was no sin, no sickness, no trouble,
no death.
13. Of one tree God said, "Thou shalt not eat."
What tree?
The tree of the knowledge of good and evil.
14. Who wanted to spoil God's work?
Satan.
15. How did he come to Eve?
As a snake.
16. What did he tempt her to do?
To disobey God.
17. What did Eve do?
She eat the fruit and gave it to Adam.
18. What were Adam and Eve now?
Sinners.
19. How did God punish them?
He gave them hard work, pain, sickness, and death.
20. What promise did God give?
To send a Man who would destroy Satan.
21. Did He tell them the name of that Man?
No, but we know it was Jesus?
22. When Adam and Eve had children, were they
sinners?
Yes.
23. Why?
Because their father and mother were sinners.
24. Who were Adam and Eve's first sons?
Cain and Abel.

25. When Cain and Abel wanted to worship God, what did they bring?

Cain brought fruit, and Abel brought a lamb.

26. Why was God pleased with Abel's offering?

Because it was a picture of Jesus, the Lamb of God.

27. Why was God not pleased with Cain?

Because he brought his own work without the shedding of blood.

28. What did Cain do?

He was very angry, and killed his brother Abel.

29. By and by the earth was full of people. What were they like?

Very wicked.

30. How did God punish them?

He sent a great flood.

31. Were they all drowned?

No.

32. Who was saved?

Noah and his family.

33. How were they saved?

God told Noah to make a great ship, the ark.

34. What is the ark a picture of?

Jesus.

With God in Heaven.
2. When Jesus came from Heaven where was He
born?
In Bethlehem.
3. Who was His mother?
Mary.
4. Who was His father?
God.
5. Who was Mary's husband?
Joseph.
6. Who came first to see Jesus?
The shepherds.
7. Who told them Jesus was born?
An angel.
8. What did the angel say?
"Fear not, for behold I bring you good tidings of
great joy which shall be to all people, for unto
you is born this day . . . a Saviour, which
is Christ the Lord."
LUKE, 2.10,11.
9. Who also came to worship Jesus?
The wise men.
10. How did God show them the road?
He sent a star.
11. When they found Jesus what did they do?
They gave Him presents and worshipped Him.

12. Who wanted to kill Jesus?
Herod.
13. Why did he not kill Jesus?
Because God had told Joseph to take Him away to Egypt.
14. Where did Joseph take Jesus when Herod died?
To Nazareth.
15. What work did He do in Nazareth?
He worked with Joseph as a carpenter.
16. How old was Jesus when He left Nazareth?
Thirty years old.
17. What did He do for three years after He left Nazareth?
He went about doing good, and teaching everyone about God.
18. When He left Nazareth where did He go first?
To the river Jordan.
19. What for?
To be baptized.
20. Who baptized Him?
John the Baptist.
21. Who came from Heaven upon Jesus?
The Holy Spirit.
22. Who spoke from Heaven?
God the Father.
23. What did He say?
"This is My Beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased."
24. What did the Holy Spirit take Jesus to the wilderness for?
To be tempted of the devil.
25. How long did He eat nothing?
Forty days and forty nights.

26. When Satan tempted Him, how did Jesus say
 "No" ?
He used the word of God (the sword of the Spirit).
27. When Jesus went about doing good who did
 He take with Him?
His disciples.
28. What for?
To teach them.
29. What disciples did He call first?
James and John, Andrew and Peter.
30. What were they?
Fishermen.
31. What did Jesus say to them?
"Follow Me, and I will make you fishers of men."
32. How many disciples did Jesus choose to be
 apostles?
Twelve.
33. Who came to Jesus by night?
Nicodemus.
34. What did Jesus say to Nicodemus?
"Ye must be born again, born of the Spirit."
35. How can a man be born again?
He must believe in Jesus Christ. JOHN, 1,12,13.
36. How do we know Jesus is God?
**All things were made by Him.
 He is in every place.
 He knows everything.**
37. When He came to be a man what did He do to
 shew His power?
He worked miracles.

38. What miracles did He do?
Healed the sick, stilled the storm, fed 5000, raised the dead, made lame men walk, blind men see, deaf men hear, dumb men speak.
39. Who did Jesus raise from the dead?
Jairus' daughter, the widow's son, Lazarus.
40. How did Jesus make the wind and sea quiet?
He said "Peace be still," and there was a great calm.
41. When Jesus fed 5000 men, how many loaves had He?
Five loaves and two fishes.
42. When He fed 4000, how many had He?
Seven loaves and a few fishes.
43. How do we know Jesus was man as well as God?
He slept, He eat, He had joy and sorrow like us, He was tempted, hungry, thirsty, tired.
44. When the time came for Jesus to die, where did He go?
To Jerusalem.
45. What was the last thing Jesus taught His disciples before He died?
To take the Lord's supper.
46. What did He tell them to do?
Eat this bread and drink this wine in remembrance of Me.
47. What does the bread mean?
It is a picture of the body of Jesus broken for us.
48. What does the wine mean?
It is a picture of the blood of Jesus shed for us.

49. How long are we to keep this feast?
Till He come.
50. Who betrayed Jesus?
Judas.
51. Who denied Him?
Peter.
52. Where did the High Priest send Jesus?
To Pilate.
53. What did wicked men do to Jesus?
They mocked Him, beat Him, put a crown of thorns on His head.
54. What did they want Pilate to do?
To crucify Him.
55. What did Pilate say?
I find no fault in this man, I will let Him go.
56. What did all the people say?
Crucify Him.
57. Where did they erucify Jesus?
On Calvary.
58. Who was crucified with Jesus?
Two thieves.
59. What did God do at mid-day?
Made darkness come for three hours.
60. What did Jesus say before He died?
“It is finished.”
61. What was finished.
The work He came from Heaven to do.
62. What work did He come to do?
To bear the punishment of our sin.

63. Who buried Jesus?
Joseph of Arimathea.
64. How long did Jesus stop in the grave?
Three days.
65. What day did Jesus rise again?
Sunday morning.
66. Who saw Him first?
Mary Magdalene.
67. How many days did Jesus show Himself to His disciples?
Forty days.
68. Before He went back to Heaven what did Jesus tell His disciples to do?
“Go ye into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature.”
69. How did Jesus go up to Heaven?
He ascended from the Mount of Olives, and a cloud received Him out of their sight.
70. When Jesus ascended what did the angels say?
“This same Jesus shall so come in like manner as ye have seen Him go.”
71. How did Jesus promise to come again?
“I will come again and receive you unto myself.”
72. Who did Jesus promise to send to be our teacher?
The Holy Spirit.
73. When did the Holy Spirit descend?
On the day of Pentecost.
74. When was that?
Ten days after Jesus went back to Heaven.

The Lord's Prayer.

As he (Jesus) was praying...one of his disciples said...Lord teach us to pray...

And he said unto them, when ye pray, say:

LUKE, 11.14.

Our Father which art in Heaven, Hallowed be Thy name. Thy Kingdom come. Thy will be done on earth, as it is in Heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive them that trespass against us; And lead us not into temptation; But deliver us from evil; For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever and ever.—Amen.

1. Why do we call this "the Lord's prayer"?
Because **Jesus** taught it to his disciples.
2. Who is this prayer for?
Disciples of Jesus.
3. What does "disciple" mean?
Men who trust in Jesus and follow Him.
4. Is God the Father of every man?
No, only the Father of men who are born again.
5. What does "hallowed mean"?
Holy.

6. What does "Thy kingdom come" mean?

We want God to be King.

7. What does "Thy will be done on earth as it is in Heaven" mean?

We want every one to do what God wants; like the angels do in Heaven.

8. What does "daily bread" mean?

Food for the body and food for the soul.

9. What does "trespasses" mean?

Sins.

10. What does "lead us not into temptation" mean?

Do not take us to any place where Satan will catch us.

11. What does "deliver" mean?

Save.

12. What does "from evil" mean?

From sin.

13. What does "Thine is the kingdom" mean?

God is King.

14. What does "and the power" mean?

God is Almighty.

15. What does "and the glory" mean?

God is everything—we nothing.

16. What does "Amen" mean?

Yes, that is what we want.

8. What does "Almighty" mean?
Strong, God can do everything.

He spoke, He created out of nothing.
10. What does "Jesus" mean?
Saviour.
11. What does "Christ" mean?
King.
12. "His only Son"—whose Son?
The Son of God.
13. What does "Lord" mean?
Master.
14. Who was the Virgin Mary?
The Mother of Jesus when He came to be a man.

25. What does He do for us?
He gives us life, and He teaches us to know Christ.
26. Where does He promise to live?
In the heart of every Christian.

27. What does "Church" mean?

Christian men and women.

28. How many Churches are there?

Only one.

EPHESIANS, 5.23,27.

29. Who belongs to the one Church?

Everyone who truly believes in Christ.

30. What does "Communion" mean?

To love and help one another.

31. What does "saints" mean?

People who belong to God.

32. How do we know our sins are forgiven?

Because God says to all who trust in Jesus "Your sins are forgiven you for His name's sake."

33. What does "resurrection" mean?

The body will rise from the grave.

34. Who will rise first?

Christians, "The dead in Christ shall rise first."
