

RECORDS OF HISTORIC CAPE COD BUILDINGS IN HABS

Check list of measured drawings and photographs of buildings in Barnstable County, Massachusetts, in the HABS, December, 1963. Compiled from HABS Catalog (1941), Catalog Supplement (1959), and records at National Park Service, Philadelphia, not yet deposited at the Library of Congress.
