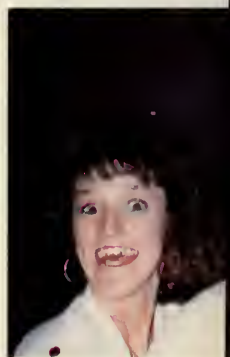

Salve Regina Scores Winning Season



Salve Regina College scored a winning season on all fronts with championships in hockey, men's basketball and women's basketball and an impressive first competition for the equestrian team.

The **Ice Hockey** team won the 1988 Regular Season Championship of the Northeast Collegiate Hockey Association (N.E.C.H.A.), Division II. The team finished the season with nine wins and one loss. They went to the New England playoffs where they defeated Emerson College in the semi-finals to place second in the regional tournament.

Men's Basketball won the 1988-89 Commonwealth Coast Conference Championship. The team had finished the regular season in a tie with Wentworth Institute, and they broke the tie by defeating Wentworth, 74-70, on Feb. 28.

Commonwealth Coast Conference Awards, chosen by coaches from all the league teams, went to senior, Chris Grasso and coach, Mike Raffa.

Women's Basketball won the 1988-89 Commonwealth Coast Conference Championship for the second consecutive year. The team had finished the season in a tie with Curry College, and they broke the tie with a 53-42 victory on Feb. 26.

Commonwealth Coast Conference Awards went to first team players Tricia Reall and Christine Elliott, both seniors, and to Tracy Giroux, a junior. Chris Julius, a junior, won the Coach's Award and second team award.

The **Equestrian Team** won three first place ribbons and two second place ribbons in their first intercollegiate competition, held in March at Yale University. The Salve Regina team competed against riders from Brown University, Smith College, Trinity College and other New England colleges. First place ribbons went to students Be Kufins (a freshman), Janis McClinch (sophomore) and Sarah Carroll (sophomore). Second place ribbons were carried off by Marianne Mullaney (senior) and Dominique Melone (senior).

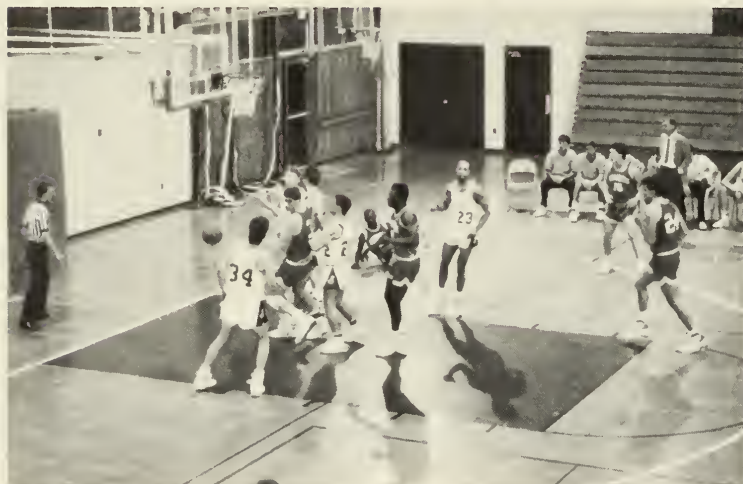

SPORTS ROUND-UP

The Fall season was one of the most successful ones for the Athletic teams. The Women's Tennis finished with a 11-1 record, their best in their eleven year history. They compiled consecutive wins before their first loss to Connecticut College at the end of the season. The Lady Newporters finished 2nd in the Rhode Island Women's Championships, just a few points behind the strong Division I URI team. Three days later, they defeated URI in a close dual match. The team also won the Grass Court Doubles Tournament held by Salve at the International Tennis Hall of Fame. With only one senior on the team, the eleven returning team members should still prove to be a strong force in the upcoming season.

The **Men's Soccer** team also boasted their best record in its history. The Newporters closed the season with a 9-3 record. They began their season with a tough loss to Wentworth Institute and Bridgewater State College. They then proceeded to outscore their opponents in nine out of the next ten games, winning their last six in a row. In seven of those games, senior goalie Mike Rego (110 saves this year) was able to hold the opponents scoreless. The season was capped with a win over the team from Connecticut to clinch the Roger Williams tournament.

The **Women's Soccer** team began their season with 2 wins, 1 loss and 1 tie in the Wheaton College Round Robin Tournament. Freshman Jackie Conlon was the Lady Newporters top scorer with 11 goals. Senior Kerry Conlon was second with 7 goals and lead the team with 5 assists. Sophomore goalie Stephanie Spagnolia lead the team with 187 saves in the net. Their 6-7 record was the best record any Women's Soccer team had posted.

The **Women's Basketball** Team continued their winning ways of the fall teams. Senior Tricia Conlon broke the Career Points Record set in 1985 with 870 career points. Junior Tracy Giroux led the season with 789 career points and looks to break the record next year, needing only 82 points. The Lady Newporters finished their regular season with a win over Curry College. The win put them in a tie with Curry for the Commonwealth Conference Championship and forced a play-off game. The Lady Newporters defeated Curry again to give them the Conference Championship for the second year in a row. The next

day, Salve was chosen for the ECAC's, the first Salve team to ever be chosen for post-season play. They traveled to SMU for the first round and soundly defeated the favored team. Their seven game win streak came to an end in the semi-final round against Bowdoin College. Their 18-6 record was the best record posted by any Salve team and with ten players returning, the outlook for next year is bright.

Although the **Men's Basketball** overall record does not show it, the team had a very successful year. Losing senior point guard Matt Fannon before the first game was a tough break but this young team, often starting three freshmen, did not give up. Freshman Dante Mabray was Salve's top scorer in fourteen games. Teammate Freshman Kent Katter was the team's top rebounder in 13 games. Senior Chris Grasso became Salve's all time scoring leader breaking Paul Graziano's record of 1132 career points. Chris ended his career with 1140 points. He also holds the school's career assist leader and leads in 3 point goals scoring 109 baskets in three years. The season finished with a play-off game against Wentworth Institute for the Conference Championship. After losing to Wentworth twice during regular season play, the Newporters defeated Wentworth to take the Championship for the first time in the five year history of the Conference.

The **Ice Hockey** team completed their season with a 13-5-1 record, the best record of any previous hockey team, scoring 100 goals to their opponents 60. Their 9-1 record in the Small College Intercollegiate Hockey League earned them a play-off bid. As defending New England Champions the Salve team had a tough road to travel. They defeated Emerson College in the semi-final Round but lost to Central Connecticut State College 5-4 in the finals. Senior Jim Gaiser led the team with 18 goals and 12 assists. (This ranked him second in New England)

The **Softball** Team completed their season with an impressive 12-7 record. The season was highlighted by a 2nd place finish in the Commonwealth Coast Conference Tournament. Five members of the team were also selected to play in the Rhode Island All-Star game. Salve's sophomore pitcher Lisa Dellaquila (8 wins and 4 losses for the season) was the winning pitcher. The team was led by senior Chris Elliott (27 for 52) with a batting

average of .450. Chris Julius was the team leader for stolen bases with 14. Pitcher Maureen Martinack ended the season with her 14th career win in two years. The season ended with a 14-0 romp over Albertus Magnus College.

The **Baseball Team** finished their season with an outstanding 15-6 record. The season was highlighted by a first time victory over a strong SMU team. The game also was the start of an eight game win streak. The team scored 153 runs to their opponents 96. They also had 94 stolen bases and held their opponents to only 24. Bob Schumacher was one of the team's leading hitters, batting an impressive .410 (Four of these hits were home runs). Senior Jim Morris came back from a broken leg in pre-season to hit .414. The team was also backed up by some outstanding pitching staff. Jon Lefebvre ended the season with five wins and only one loss, allowed only 5 earned runs giving him a tremendous 1.33 earned run average. Freshman Steve Soba finished with an earned run average of only 2.60, 46 strike outs and only 16 walks and will prove to be a great asset to the pitching staff for the next three years.

The **Men's Tennis Team** closed out their season with a close 5-4 win over East Nazarene. Because of rain cancellations, their last matches were cancelled and their chance to end with a winning record was not fulfilled.

The **Track Team** started the season off with a cancellation due to snow. Their next meet at SMU turned in some fine performances. Freshman Ryan Vaughan broke the school's 200 M record. The following week, freshman Karen Luchum broke the javelin record with a toss of 116'6". This distance also qualified her for the ECAC Championships.

The **Golf Team** opened their season with a win over Roger Williams College. The team traveled to New Seabury, Mass. to participate in the New England Intercollegiate Golf Association Championships in the Fall. Sean Flanagan was the low man for Salve shooting a 173 for the two days. The Spring season started out slow as their first match was cancelled because of snow. The loss of Sean Flanagan to Baseball was also felt as the Salve team lost to URI, SMU and Roger Williams. The team finished out the season with a win over Emerson and Roger Williams.

HONOR CORDS

Students at Salve Regina College who have distinguished themselves either through academic performance, leadership ability or service to the College wear honor cords with their academic costume during Commencement.

Cord colors and honors are: Gold — Summa Cum Laude; Blue — Magna Cum Laude; White — Cum Laude; Red — Senior Class Officers; Green — Sigma Phi Sigma, (National Mercy Honor Society)

THE MACE

The "mace" and bearer represent a custom which dates back to the Middle Ages. The mace was a club-like staff carried by a bearer who was responsible for protecting a dignitary taking office or opening court. From the 16th century in England and since colonial days in America, it has become a symbol of office used in ceremonies and carried by the procession leader or macebearer.

Salve Regina's mace is silver, twenty-two inches long and is engraved with the words Salve Regina and Maria Spes Nostra (Mary Our Hope). Imprinted on the mace is the official corporation seal of the College.

The College mace is carried by the Chief Marshal who leads the procession to and from Commencement exercises. He is followed by students, faculty, distinguished guests and College officials.

PRESIDENT'S MEDALLION

The pewter medallion worn by the College President symbolizes leadership and authority of the institution's highest office.

Inscribed on the medallion are names of the five Sisters of Mercy who have served in the presidency at Salve Regina College. Each woman has made a distinctive contribution to the integrity, growth and life of the College.

The medallion's design is based on the College shield which symbolizes the commitment of the Sisters of Mercy to Salve Regina College, the dedication to learning by all members of the Salve community, and the unending search for wisdom which flows from the knowledge of the liberal scholar.

The medallion is worn by the President at all formal academic occasions as public testimony of the ideals of Salve Regina College.

ACADEMIC REGALIA

When universities were taking form in the 12th and 13th centuries, they were under the jurisdiction of the Church. Most of those studying were clerks in Holy Orders, monks or priests. They wore a habit or cloak to which was attached a cowl or hood. This could be pulled up over the head or thrown back, according to weather. Gowns were necessary for warmth in the unheated buildings and hoods served to cover the tonsured head before the use of the skull cap. Today, the academic costume of cap, gown and hood has taken on a symbolic meaning. Colors and shapes conform to a generally accepted code and indicate the faculty conferring the degree and the kind of degree conferred.

Gowns for the bachelor's degree are worn closed and are distinguished by their long, pointed sleeves. Master's degree gowns are designed to be worn open. They have very long sleeves, oblong in shape. Gowns for the doctoral degree, usually black, are also designed to be worn open and have velvet panels. Three velvet bars are stitched to the upper part of the full, bell-shaped sleeves. College President Sister Lucille McKillop wears a blue doctoral gown, signifying the primary institutional color for Salve Regina.

Hoods are trimmed with a slim strip of velvet to indicate the specific faculty awarding the degree. The colored lining is the official color of the institution conferring the degree. Hoods may be trimmed to represent the following academic areas:

Arts, Letters, Humanities — White; Science — Golden Yellow; Education — Light Blue; Philosophy — Blue; Social Service — Citron; Theology — Scarlet; Nursing — Apricot; Fine Arts — Brown; Business Administration, Commercial Science — Sapphire Blue; Economics — Copper

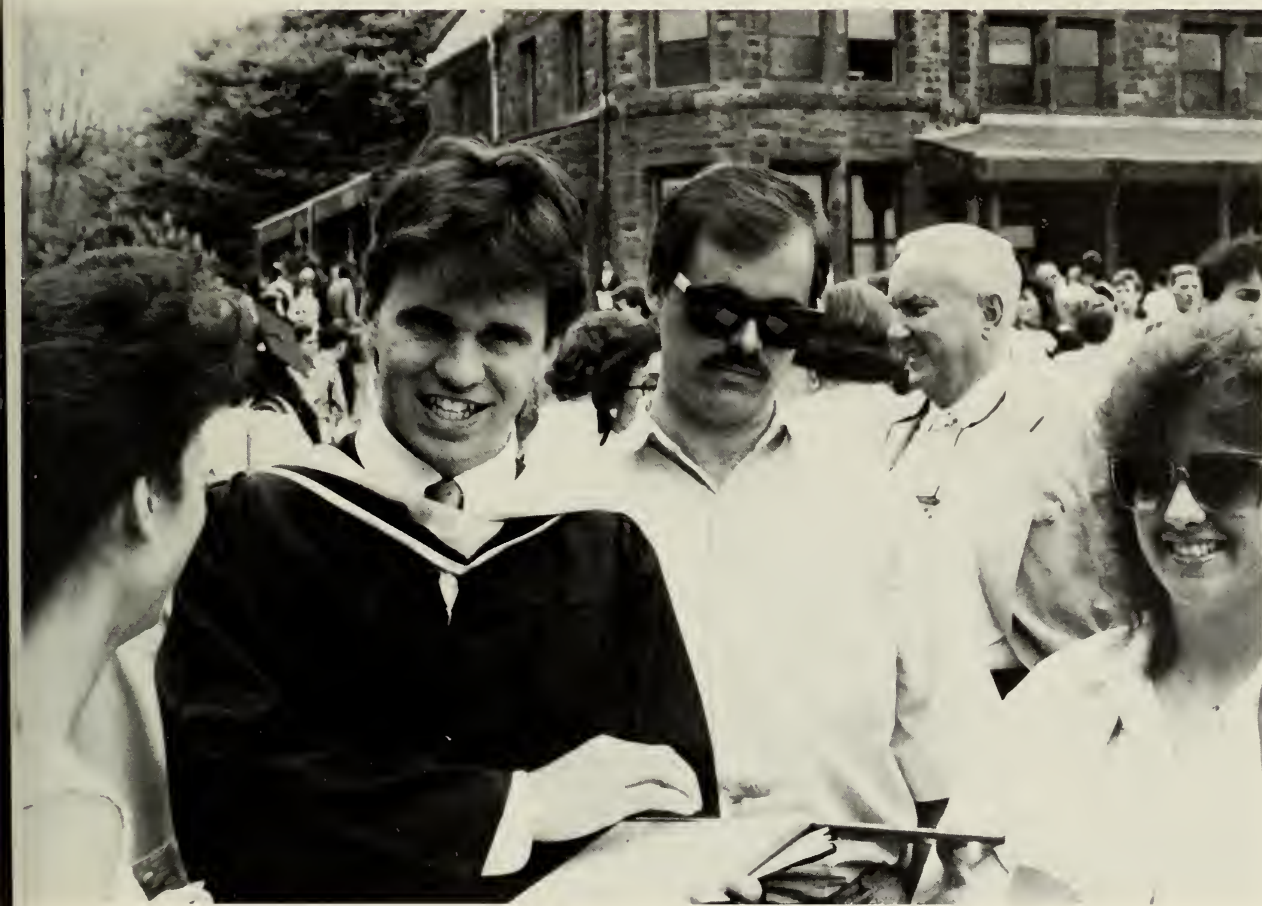
