Salve Regina University established its Football team just four years ago in 1992. In Salve's inaugural season, they posted a 4-2 mark as a club team. Their first year of league play was in the 1994-95 season where Salve finished with a remarkable 8-1 overall record and 6-0 in league play. Head Coach Tim Coen was a well respected high school coach before coming to Salve. He has coached the Newporters to an overall 24-8 record in four years. Coach Coen is teamed up with excellent assistants which have made the Newporters so good. The players have complimented the coaching staff by producing several All-Conference Awards and two All-American Awards in the last two years. Salve is shooting for a post-season birth next year as they missed out this year by only one game - not bad for a team that had only 20 guys in its first season.






