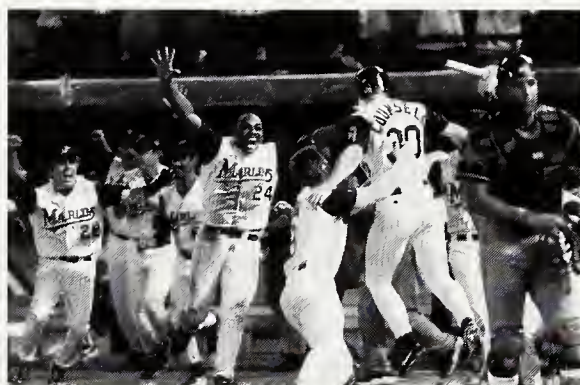
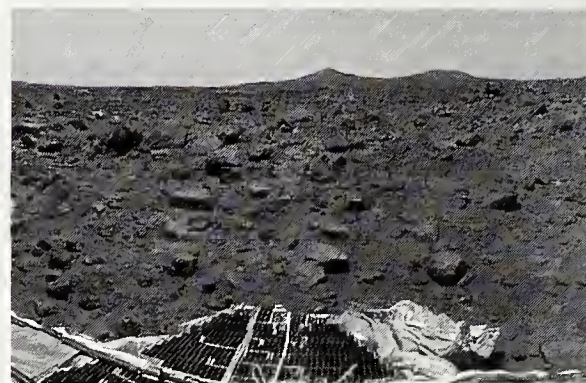

# 1997-1998

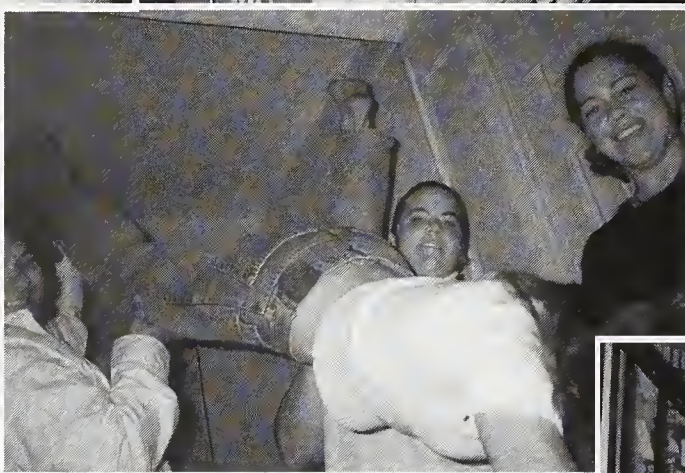

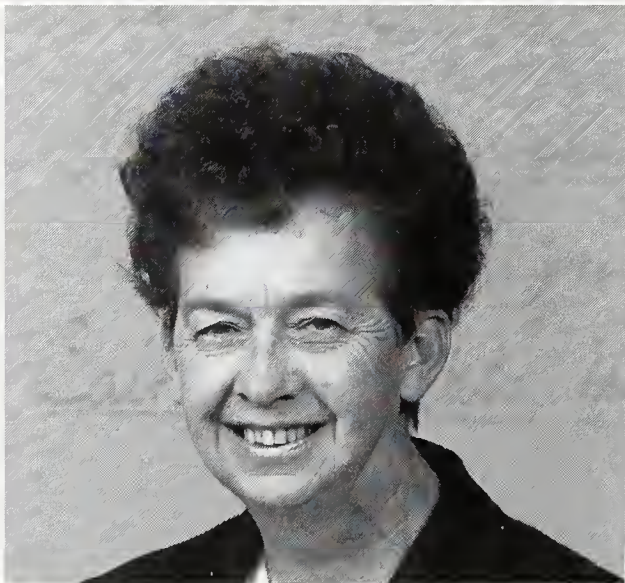


















In the Fall of 1994 a support group was put together with the assistance of Liz Minifie, MSW. This support group spoke on issues of Domestic Violence and Date Rape.

## One woman tells Salve audience of her struggle with violent boyfriend

**NEWPORT** — Michelle LaBarre says her ex-boyfriend haunts her — through the court system and by harassing her family.

It was on March 2, 1992, that LaBarre's ex-boyfriend assaulted her, and she decided to press charges. Since that time, there has been litigation, intimidation and a constant string of harassment, she said.

"I am a victim of domestic violence," LaBarre told an audience at Salve Regina University Tuesday night during a forum on domestic violence.

LaBarre is a 27-year-old Salve nursing major, whose story began in her hometown of Bristol, Conn. "I was standing outside crying one night," she recalled. "And if that police officer hadn't asked me if I was OK, I would've returned to that abusive relationship."

LaBarre filed charges and obtained a restraining order against her ex-boyfriend. But he was relentless, showing up at the junior college she attended in order, she said, to stare her down.

"They said they couldn't do anything," she said. "It's a public place,

and he said he was finding out about a course."

During the course of her case, the ex-boyfriend once grabbed her at a nightclub and dragged her to the dance floor, she said. "I lost some people I once considered friends," she told the audience of mostly students. "One said she was sorry what happened, but if I could get past it, he's really a nice guy," LaBarre said.

Meanwhile, her ex-boyfriend moved two tenths of a mile from LaBarre's parents' home. "He was right in my neighborhood," she said.

LaBarre's ex-boyfriend was convicted of assault and sentenced to six months in jail with 90 days to serve, she said, and was placed on probation for two years. "But he has not spent any time in jail," she said. "He is dragging me through the appellate court."

Even though LaBarre now attends

## Matter of respect

About 150 rally, march to 'Take Back the Night'

**NEWPORT** — The young woman choked back tears.

"It's the shame," the Salve crowd told the men and women gathered Friday night on the O'Brien Court veranda at Salve Regina University.

In a quiet voice, she confessed that "the biggest problem with rape is the shame." Then it happened to her, "the whole world toppled."

Rape, assault, violence — they lurk in light's shadows.

But the shadows began to lift Friday as nearly 150 students, faculty and administrators attended the university's first "Take Back the Night" march and rally. The event was a chance to affirm their power as women and men, said organizer Colleen Rau, a Salve senior and a member of the student group WIN — or Women's Issues Now.

The candlelight march and rally attracted more than local interest. Students from Roger Williams University in Bristol, the University of Massachusetts at Dartmouth and Stonehill College in North Easton, Mass., also participated.

Before the march began, many added signatures to a banner made from a sheet and handpainted with the words "Take Back the Night." Marchers lighted white candles. Members of WIN carried purple

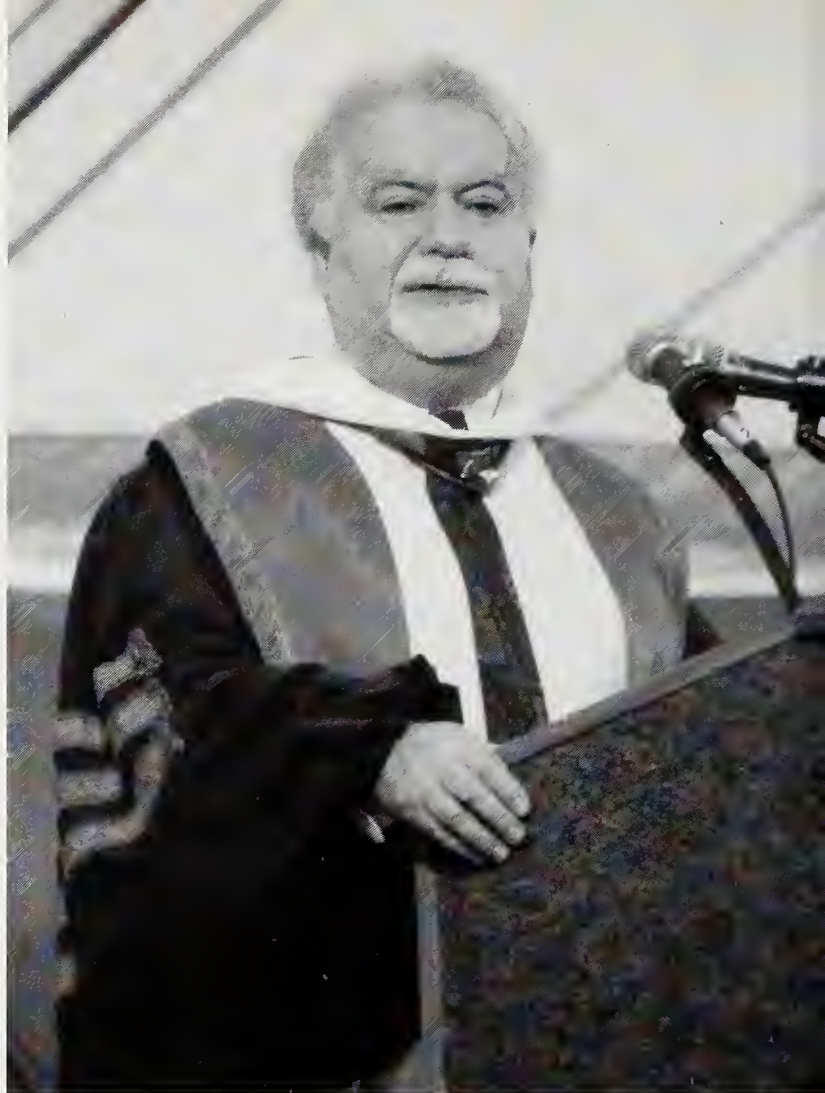
