

NEWPORT Michelle LaBarre says her ex-boyfriend haunts her inrough the court system and by ha rassing her family

It was on March 2, 1992, that LaRarre's ev-boyfriend assaulted her, and she decided to press charges. Since that time, there has been litigation, intimidation and a constant string of harassment she said.
