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Preface.



THE Registers of the Parish Church of Lee are described in the "Population of Great Britain, 1831," Parish Register Abstract, as follows :—

No. I and II. Bap. and Bur. 1579-1812

Mar. 1579-1753

No. III-V. Mar. 1754-1812.

The first Register Book consists of forty-four leaves of parchment, 11½ in. by 8¼ in., rebound some years ago in rough calf. This book originally consisted of fewer leaves than at present, fresh sheets having been added as they were required. It was commenced on 25th March 1579, as appears from a note at the top of the first page, the writing being a large court-hand, and places were opened in three different parts of the book for Marriages, Baptisms and Burials. The space allotted to Marriages being soon filled up, a fresh start was made further on, and consequently the entries for each "state" do not run straight forward. As this would have caused needless trouble to the searcher, all the Marriages have been placed together in printing, and the same plan has been adopted for the Christenings and the Burials; such of the entries at the beginning of the seventeenth century as were made in Latin being rendered in English.

This book (No. I) contains the Marriages and Baptisms from 1579 to 1734 and the original Burial entries from 1579 to 1677, the latter having been brought down to 1734 from the entries in a sort of waste-book. This part of the book, although written comparatively recently, is much faded, and reference to the original had constantly to be made to verify the entries.

The waste-book referred to contains the Burials from 1678 to 1734 (now copied, as above stated, into No. I). It begins: "Burialls in y^e Parish of "Lee, in Kent, according to a late Act of Parliament, intituled 'An Act "for burying in Woollen.' Burialls in y^e yeare 1678," etc. The affidavits were made before the following, amongst others:—

At the end of the book is a long list of Briefs, from 1707 to 1772.

The second Register is bound in rough calf, and is of parchment, 15¾ in. by 9½ in. It contains (1) the Marriages from 1734 to 1754, when the new Act came into force, and printed forms were substituted, giving many necessary details not always entered in the older registers; (2) the Baptisms and Burials from 1734 to 1812, when printed forms were also substituted. This book has on the fly-leaf: "A Register made the 1 day "of Jan. 1734." Only about half the book was used, the remainder being still blank.

The best thanks of the Society are due to the Rev. F. H. LAW, Rector of Lee, for permission to print the registers; to J. J. HOWARD, Esq., LL.D., for kindly placing the Wildgose Deed, noted on p. 1, at our disposal; and to Mr. C. NORTH, Parish Clerk of Lee: also to the authorities at Somerset House, who have kindly permitted extracts to be taken from the Wills

of the Rochester Diocese, now in their custody, of persons formerly residing at Lee, and whose burials are here recorded. These extracts are printed together as "Appendix A"; and notes from Wills in the Prerogative Court of Canterbury are printed as "Appendix B."

With regard to these extracts, it must be observed that no attempt has been made to thoroughly annotate the Burial Register. To have done so would have delayed the issue of the book for an indefinite period. Those wills, etc., here noted are from a collection made for the purpose of annotating the Registers of Lewisham, a work the Society hopes shortly to be able to announce for publication.

The attention of those interested in the Elizabethan Stage is directed to the entries relating to the families of Burbage, Laynam and Touné.

For a detailed history of the Parish and Church of Lee, the reader is referred to Hasted's "History of Kent," new edition, 1886, Vol. I (containing the Hundred of Blackheath, edited by Dr. H. H. DRAKE), which also contains pedigrees and notes on many of the families referred to herein, viz., Stoddard, Annesley, Boone, Fludyer, Hatcliffe, etc. The monumental inscriptions in the Church and Churchyard (noted "M.I." in the Burials in this volume) will also be found at greater length in the above, and also in Lysons' "Environs of London," and Thorpe's "Registrum Roffense."

Since the above was written, the whole of the Register Books, etc., of this Parish have been rebound, and are now in excellent order.
