

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PREFACE.

I N placing before the reader an exact copy of the three small volumes which contain the Registers of Perlethorpe from 1528 to 1812, a short description of them cannot be deemed out of place.

Perlethorpe, or as it was formerly spelt Peverelthorpe and Palethorpe, was until recently a chapelry annexed to Edwinstowe, in which parish it is, and with Thoresby has a population according to the last census of 132. The number of inhabitants, judging from the registers, must always have been about the same.

The early date at which these registers begin constitutes their only claim upon the attention of the antiquary, two others alone, so far as I can ascertain, those of the adjoining chapelry of Carburton, and of Elsworth, near St. Ives, in Cambridgeshire, commencing as early as 1528. There are instances of entries in registers of an earlier date, but they do not appear to form part of the book itself, being probably memoranda which have been inserted at a subsequent period. It should be borne in mind that the first order for keeping parish registers was an injunction issued by Thomas, Lord Cromwell, in September, 1538. This was repeated in 1547.

Volume I. is a small folio written on parchment, measuring twelve inches by five inches, and is bound in a modern cover of the same material. It consists of sixteen leaves or thirty-two pages, the last of which has no writing upon it. The three last leaves appear to have been added after the previous ones had been stitched, in order to make the book larger. How far it is an original document is difficult to determine, as the handwriting affords but little clue. Previous to an order made in 1603 for keeping registers on parchment, they were usually written on paper. I am of opinion that this book is a copy from an older record down to the year 1599, if not to 1603. (Page 8.) The word "sence" in the title clearly indicates that the earlier portion is a copy, and the memorandum on page 6, by George Ormerod, Dean of Retford and Laneham, shows that in 1587, and for some time after, it was written upon paper and not upon parchment. With the exception of the first page, which has evidently been, previous to its modern binding, the outside leaf, and is consequently much worn, there are very few words which are illegible, although

many of the earlier entries have been galled. On page I I have been obliged to mark eight spaces as entirely illegible, the writing which was upon them being literally rubbed out, the other blank spaces on this and the subsequent pages never had any writing upon them. A few words will be found printed in italics, in these cases I am unable to determine with positive certainty what the word was, but I feel confident that any antiquary who examines the original document will not differ with me in opinion. Some observations on this volume will be found in Shaw's "History of Staffordshire," and also in Burn's "History of Parish Registers," of the former I have more to say, the latter I may dismiss by saying that his statements, that the title is illegible, and that there is just one entry for each year from 1528—1538, are not strictly accurate.

The Rev. Stebbing Shaw in his "History of Staffordshire," Vol. I., p. 412, mentions this register as "a curious little volume perhaps unique in point of age for a parish register, commencing ten years before the Vicar-General Cromwell's ordinance for parish registers, and continuing, with great regularity, and in a form as excellent as its age is singular, till Nov. 24, 1641; after which it seems to have fallen into hands which preferred disorder and deformity to regularity and neatness, and becomes much like the generality of the contemporary parish records." At Vol. II., App. pp. 12-13, he says "Parlthorp Register, being here [p. 412 of Vol. I.] noted as well for its excellent form as its singularly early commencement, it is conceived a specimen may be acceptable." He then gives a copy, fairly accurate, of the entries in the years 1568-1574, and adds the note (page 6 of this book,) "Seene pvsed & allowed," etc.

Mr. Shaw's reason for taking such particular notice of this register was in relation to the pedigree of Stanley connected with that of Wolferstan. The Stanleys were from the end of the reign of Henry VIII. to that of Elizabeth seated at Thoresby, and it contains several entries of them.

I have already remarked that many of the earlier entries have been galled, a practice which in my opinion is deserving of the severest condemnation it is in the power of the would-be preserver of parish registers to bestow. It admits of no justification, for however carefully the faded ink may be for the time restored, sooner or later it blots out the record for ever. Leave the faded ink alone, and faded though it be, it will if looked at through a magnifying glass, and with the aid of a bright sunlight last for many a long year to come, and the sin of destruction will not be laid to our charge by future genealogists, who, if I mistake not the signs of the times, will place a far higher value than we do on these records of their ancestors.

The pages which have been most galled are 1, 2, 3, 5, and 6. This process has rendered page 1 very difficult to read. Page 2 has suffered to an almost equal extent, especially the two Stanley entries in 1553 and 1554. The name "Alse Wylde" is galled on page 4. On page 6 the words "Seene pvsed & allowed," etc., have been galled all over. Mr. Shaw no doubt wished to make clear all the Stanley entries. That of "Alse Wylde" is the commencement of the specimen of the register which he gives at Vol. II., App., pp. 12-13, of his "History of Staffordshire," and the words beginning "Seene pvsed & allowed" he gives in their entirety. No other extracts which he prints are in the least degree difficult to decypher. His history-book was printed nearly ninety years ago, and so far

as my opinion is of value the galling of "Perlethorpe Register" has not taken place in recent years. I have known the book for a quarter of a century, and it is certainly now in the same condition it was then. Looking at these facts I incline to the opinion that the Rev. Stebbing Shaw is the antiquary on whose shoulders we must lay the blame of having rendered some of its entries illegible. I point this out from no desire to detract from the fame of so eminent an antiquary as Shaw, but to point a moral for the benefit of my genealogical confreres of to-day, to the effect that they will not earn the gratitude of posterity in marking their "footprints on the sands of time" by galling parish registers.

From 1642 to the end of the volume I do not know a more carelessly kept register. There are no entries for the years 1642, 1644, 1645, 1647, 1649, 1651, 1653, 1655, 1656, or 1660, and those which are set down were frequently written in wherever a blank space occurred, regardless of chronological order. Many might no doubt be recovered by consulting the Transcripts at York. Specimens of what they contain will be seen in notes to pages 27, 28, and at page 57 (App.). It will be remembered that during the Commonwealth period 1642 to 1659 there are no Transcripts at York, so that the entries omitted in these years are irretrievably lost. Unfortunately also no Registrar appears to have been appointed in 1653, a neglect perhaps owing to the smallness of the parish. In neighbouring parishes the law seems to have been complied with. Where a civil Registrar was sworn in one invariably finds the books well kept during his tenure of office—Alas, too brief!

Volume II. is also a small folio written on parchment, measuring ten inches by seven inches, and bound as Vol. I. It consists of twelve leaves written on both sides. Attached to the front cover by a piece of string are seven certificates of burial in woollen. I have added these as foot notes to the respective entries The entries are made for the most part in double columns, and are given here line for line and letter for letter, but I have not considered it necessary to print them page for page as I have done in the first volume. The earlier entries are evidently transcripts from an older book, a reference to this will be noticed preceding those relating to the Gace family, at page 36, column 1, of From its commencement to the year 1749 it is no doubt exceedingly defective, and was kept by an evidently illiterate scribe who took more pains in preparing a transcript for the Visitation than he did in writing the original. The transcript was no doubt the true return, made, I imagine, from the parish clerk's own note book or from his memory; this performed, he frequently neglected to write up the original from which he "professedly" transcribed. See a copy of the "transcript" for 1728, (page 38 foot note) not a word of which appears in the original record! The note "Rec'd the Duty" and similar memoranda (see page 44) refer to the duty of threepence on each entry, payable under an Act of 23 George III., which was repealed in 1794, eleven years afterwards.

Volume III. is a paper book nine and a half inches by seven and a quarter inches, bound in parchment. Most of the leaves are blank. The marriages are at one end and the births at the other, and the burials some at the end and some mixed with the marriages. In transcribing it I have exactly followed the original, but have not printed it page for page or line for line. To one or two burials a capital P is added, this, I suppose, stands for "Poor." There are very few entries of special interest. In two or three instances persons appear evidently

connected with the Pierreponts, but who were otherwise strangers in the parish. The burial of William Scot, "Captain of the Mary," in 1756, and the birth of Ann Winchester at the "Menagerie" in 1757, carry us back to the palmy days of Thoresby. Throsby in his edition of Thoroton mentions "the fine sheet of water bearing vessels of no great burthen," of which I suppose the "Mary" was the chief. The Keeper, the House Steward, the Baker, and the Clerk of the Kitchen to the Dutchess of Kingston, whose burials are entered, remind us of the residence here of Elizabeth Chudley, whose trial for bigamy is a cause célèbre.

With these brief remarks I commend this curious register to the attention of antiquaries and genealogists. All I need add is that my thanks are due to the Rev. Thomas Inglis Luard, Vicar of Perlethorpe, for allowing me to transcribe these interesting volumes, and thus I trust preserve their contents for the use of future generations, when the hand of time shall have obliterated them in their originality.

APPENDIX.

THE following WILLS are those of persons formerly resident in the parish of Perlethorpe, whose burials do not occur in the Register.

The extracts from the REGISTER TRANSCRIPTS supply to some extent the deficiency of the original at a period when it was very negligently kept. They either give a different date to that in the Register, or an entry which should be there, but is not.

The Assessments are interesting as supplying a list of the principal inhabitants in the years to which they relate.

It is needless to make any excuse for placing these memoranda as an appendix to this volume. I cannot, however, refrain from expressing my regret that the extracts from the Transcripts are so few. Had I known when I examined these documents years ago, that I should have had the pleasure of editing the Perlethorpe Register, I should have copied them in their entirety, and have thus been able to render this book more complete, and of greater value to the student of Nottinghamshire genealogies.

Will of Edward Pettynggar of Thowrsbye. Dated 15 Feb., 1556. To be buried in parish churchyard of Perlethorpe. To "Rychard Pettynggar my servant A violyt Jackytt." Mentions, brother Richard Pettynggar's three children. Four of my wyves brothers children. One of my brothers' daughters' childer. lyncolne wyffe. Zara lyncolne. Edward Oxlaye my godson. St John Byrren, [i.e. Byron.] Richard my brothers' son. Edward Oxlaye the son of William Oxlaye. Makes wife Alice and Richard Pettinggar my brothers' son executors. Witnesses, Will'm Brulay, clerke. Steven Pettinggar, and others. Proved in Exchequer Court at York, 13 May, 1557, by Alice his relict. (Vol. xv., part ii., fo. 134.)

Will of Alice Pettinger of Thowrsbie in the pishe of plethorpe in co. Nott^m, widdowe. Dated 27 Oct., 1557. To be buried in church or churchyard of plethorpe. Mentions, Robart Shawe. Humfray Shawe. Edward Shawe, and Margaret Shawe. To John Lyngcowne one stagg,—Emote his wife. Sarah Lyngcowne. Edward Oxley. Elsabeth Newbowld, and others. The Right worshippfull S^r John beren [Byron] Knyght shall be my supervisor. Richard Petinger sole executor. He proved in Exchequer Court at York, 5 May, 1558. (Vol. xv., part ii., fo. 251.)

Will of Edmonde Stringar of Parlethorpe, husbandman. Dated 17 April, 1557. To be buried in churchyard of Parlethorpe. "I gyve to the church of Parlethorpe iij yows," and to the "hie altar" for tithes forgotten viijd. "To Sr John biron my Maist' iij wethers." To John Lytster three ewes. To Will'm Stringer one ewe and a lambe. To Thomas Stringer my brother my best dublett, etc. Residue to Margaret my wife, Cuttbert my son, Henrie my son, Katherine and Agnes my daughters, and appoints them all executors. "To my forsaid iiij child' xl shepe wt all their renews ye which shepe goos at budbie." Sr John byron my maister supervisor. Witnesses, John Heath, John lyncolne, Ric. Heath, Will'm Tayllior, and Henrie Tynker. Proved in Exchequer Court at York, 13 May, 1557, by Margaret his relict, and power reserved to Cuthbert, Henry, Katherine, and Agnes, his children, minors. (Vol. xv., part i., fo. 233.)

Will of Thomas Stringer of Parlethorpe, husbandman. Dated 2 May, 1557. To be buried in churchyard at plethorpe. Mentions Harry Mycoke and his wife, and their son his (testator's) godson. My brother Edmund ij sons. "To Dynnys o' clerke an old cote." "To benson my best hose." "To Sanderson's wif a yow and a lambe." "Vnto the churche of plethorpe ij vestments and a cope willing that they said pishe shall pay vnto my Executor iijs iiijd for the weh vestments and cope I lade out vjs viijd for them." To "M'gret stringer my brother Edmund wif ijs iiijd whiche Wm banks of thoursby owes me." To John litster [i.e. Lister] of Nott taylo' viij shepe." Mentions, Ric. Roo, Will'm Dreycot of Allerton [i.e. Ollerton], and Rob't Bullocke of Allerton. Son Will'm Stringer to be sole executor and residuary legatee, but if he dies under age then goods to come to my brother Edmund' two sons Cuthbert and Harrie. Adm'on in Exchequer Court at York with the will annexed to Ric. Roo, William Draycot, Robert Bullock, and John Litster during the minority of William Stringer the son and executor, 19 July, 1557. (Vol. xv., part i., fo. 311.)

The probate entered in the Act Book is to "Edmund his son and sole executor," 13 May, 1557. I cannot reconcile this with the adm'on at the end of the will.

Will of Richard bowringe of plethorpe, husbandman. Dated 14 November, 1557. Thomas bowringe of Retford to be supervisor. Will'm bowringe iij youngest children. Bgert Jenyver. Alys Jenyver. M'garet Reve my sister. William Reve the younger. Nicholas Reve. Katheryn and Alice Reve. Will'm Reve my brother in law and Rowland his youngest son. Cuthbert, Henrie, Katheryn, and Agnes Strynger. William Lawe. Robert Bowringe, Thomas Bowringe, Agnes Bowringe, and Elizabeth Sturrope. John Jenever. To Sr Henrie Tynker xxd. "Jenever and Alice his wife." Henrie Jenyver. Sir John Markham, Knyght, supervisor, to be good Mt to my poor wife and help her to a farme for she is dissolate of a farm. Wife Margaret to be sole executrix. Witnesses, Henry Tynker, vicar, 1 Richard Wythers, John Heathe, and John Lyngcowlne. Proved in Exchequer Court at York, 5 May, 1558, by Margaret the relict. (Vol. xv., part ii., fo. 245.)

[Cf. the entry of burial of Richard Bowring in 1556.]

Will'm Cooe of Parlethorpe, husbandman, Dated 2 January (no year). To be buried in the church of Parlethorpe. Anne Gybsone my daughter. Grace my wife and the rest of my children. Wife Grace and son Richard executors. John Still, minister, a witness. Proved in Exechequer Court at York, 28 April, 1586, by the within named executors. (Vol. xxiii. fo. 204.)

Administration of the goods of Oliver Radclife of Thowarsby was granted, in the Exchequer Court at York, 31 July, 1588, to Robert Hall of Parlethorp.

No burial of this person appears in the Register, but on the second of July in this year is entered the burial of Oliver *Rockley*. If not the same person the peculiar christian name is a singular coincidence. It may be that he was Radclife *alias* Rockley and that the adm'on is entered in one name and the burial in the other.

Adm'on of Marmaduke Walker of Thoresby to Margaret wife of Thomas Milnes his sister in Exchequer Court at York, 11 Aug, 1690. (Retford Act Book.)

The following notes of persons connected with Perlethorpe may not be out of place here.

At p. 6 will be found the baptism of Eustace Rockley in 1584, and at p. 11 his marriage with Katherine Wilson. The burial of "Kathrine the wife of Eustace Rockley" is entered in the Ollerton Parish Register, May 18, 1624. The will (original only remaining) of Eustace Rockley of Ollerton, Co. Nottingham, Nuncupative, is dated 22 July, 1645. He gives to daughter Anne Andrew, the wife of Ralph Andrew, £10. To every one of my grand-children 18d apiece. Mentions brother Rockley. Appoints son Ralph Rockley sole executor. He proved in Exchequer Court at York, 25 July, 1645.

At p. 19, Robert Fether appears as marrying ... Kent. Her christian name was Rebecca, and she is mentioned in the will of Robert Stoakham of Sutton upon Lound, dated 2 July, and proved in Exchequer Court at York, 20 October, 1668, as "Rebecka Cleaton [i.e. Clayton] wife of Robert Feather. The John Smeeton who made this entry and the next to it, was probably "John Smeeton of East Retford, Gent.," whose will was proved in the Exchequer Court at York, 23 June, 1697.

Some account of the descendants of Mr. H. A. Dwarris, whose marriage occurs p. 41, and of his wife's family, will be found in Jewitt's "Reliquary," vol. ix., p. 191.

An obituary notice of Mr. George William Pierrepont Bentinck, eldest son of Vice-Admiral William Bentinck, whose marriage took place in 1802 (p. 51), is given in "The Times," of 23 February, 1886.
