### CLOTHING RELIEF WORK

The American Friends Service Committee needs clothing and other materials in its work to relieve suffering at home and abroad, where its representatives are continuously active. Their work is made possible by contributions from Americans of good will.

## Shipments Are Made to:

- 1. United States: A center in the bituminous coal fields; southern Negro and other schools; migrant workers; sharecroppers; refugees from Europe; others as needs arise.
- 2. Mexico, Jamaica, Puerto Rico, Ecuador.
- England for the work of the English Friends.
- 4. War sufferers anywhere, as opportunities for service are available. It is hoped that way will open to ship to Spain, Switzerland and North Africa.

#### **NEEDS**

- 1. New clothing for all ages. It may be purchased, made by hand or by sewing machine. Materials may be wool or cotton depending upon the articles to be made. The Clothing Committee carries knitting wool which it sells to those who knit for the Committee's work. Samples upon request. For details see leaflet "Directions for clothing for relief".
- 2. Second hand clothing is just as welcome as new for many uses. See leaflet "Stretching Pennies".
- 3. Shoes new or mended answer a great need.
- **4. Quilts,** blankets, sheets, pillow cases, towels, wash cloths, rugs.
- 5. Soap, toilet articles.
- 6. Sewing materials, buttons, needles, thread, findings, pins.
- 7. Toys in good condition, games, athletic equipment.
- 8. Money to purchase clothing, and pay transportation charges.
