



In the absence of the Right Worshipful Grand Master, the Chair was taken by Bro. Colonel WARING, M.P., D.G.M., and the Vice-Chair by Bro. HUGH BELL, sen., District Master. Bro. Rev. Canon DUDGEON, D.G.C., read the Opening Prayer, and Bro. Rev. HENRY VEREKER, D.G.C., a portion of Scripture.

Apologies were received from Bros. the Right Hon. Lord Arthur Hill, M.P., G.M.; William Johnston, M.P., G.S.; Rev. Canon Crozier, D.G.C.; E. S. Finnigan, C.G.L.I., and Thomas

Blythe, jun., D.S., No. 1 District. The minutes of last meeting were read by Bro. Major Price, D.G.S., and confirmed.

The resignation of Bro. Hugh Lavery, as Treasurer of No. 4 District, Newtownards, was accepted, and the election to that office of Bro. Alex. Filson confirmed.

Resignation of Joseph Edmunson, Lodge 20, No. 7 District, Banbridge, accepted.

Suspensions from Lodge 217, same District, confirmed. [See Suspensions].

Title granted Lodge 257, same District, subject to approval by G. L. Ireland.

Resignation of Bro. Robert Harvey, Lodge 14, No. 8 District Iveagh West, accepted.

Suspensions by Lodges 407, same District. [See Suspensions].

Suspensions by Lodges 45, No. 9 District, 1111, 1350, and 1361 confirmed. [See Suspensions].

Bro. Wm. Orr, District Master, No. 9 District, Newry, applied for a Re-Ballot of Lodge 1111, which was granted. Bro. Orr to preside at same. Due notice to all concerned to be given.

Suspensions by Lodge 727, No. 10 District, confirmed. [See Suspensions].

Bro. Hugh Bell, G.T., was instructed to pay £5, previously promised by the Co. Grand Lodge, as a subscription to Loughbrickland Orange Hall.

Resignations of Bros. Alexander Lee, Lodge 356, and David Gibson, Lodge 1445, No. 12 District, accepted.

Bros. Charles Keown, W.M., and W. J. Agar, D.M., of Lodge 356, appeared, and intimated to the Grand Lodge that the Private Lodge had complied with the decision of the Co. Grand Lodge, thus rendering the Suspension of the Warrant unnecessary.

An appeal on the part of certain members of Lodge 356, against the action of the District Lodge, in granting certificates to members of that Lodge, which had been refused by the Private Lodge, was referred to a committee, consisting of Bros. Wm. Davis, W. J. Martin, John Linton, Francis Bishop and Wm. Orr, who handed in the following finding :—

"That we, the Committee appointed to consider the question of Castlewellan District Lodge granting certificates to Bros. Abraham Thompson, James M'Neill, Joseph Gilmore, and William Thornton, find the District did not ask or receive any evidence from Lodge 356, and advise the County Grand Lodge to cancel said certificates, and also to suspend Bro. John Anthony, of Lodge 1445 from the Institution at large, until he gives up the key of Castlewellan Orange Hall, as ordered by County Grand Lodge."

"Signed,-Wm. Orr, D.M., No. 9 District, W. J. Martin, Francis Bishop, John Linton, William Davis." The finding of the Committee was confirmed by the Grand Lodge.

Suspension by Lodge 1678, No. 13 District, confirmed. [See Suspensions].

Bro. M'BRIDE, District Master, Gilford, intimated to the Grand Lodge, that Bro. Alexander Morrow had failed to comply with the resolutions of the Grand Lodge, requesting him to pay over the money he had received for the erection of a Hall in Gilford :—

Moved by Bro. HUGH BELL, D.M., No. 1 District, seconded by Bro. ROBERT BROWN, D.M., No. 18 District, and

Resolved—" That, inasmuch as Bro. Alexander Morrow, late District Master, Gilford District, failed to comply with the resolution of the County Grand Lodge, that he should pay to the proper authority the money in his hands connected with the contemplated Hall in Gilford, he be noticed to attend next meeting of this County Grand Lodge to answer this charge, and therein failing, to be suspended the Institution at large until this resolution be complied with."

Expulsion by Lodge 1687, No. 14 District, confirmed. [See Expulsions].

Warrant 1889, No. 16 District, cancelled, on application from Ballyhackamore District Lodge.

Bro. A. H. GORDON, D.M., Saintfield, No. 5 District, read the following finding of the Committee appointed to investigate matters connected with No. 16 District ;—

"The Committee appointed by the County Grand Lodge of Down at their meeting in November, to consider and report on the differences which has arisen in connection with the building of a Hall in Ballyhackamore, for Orange and Protestant purposes, met on Thursday, December 11th, and on Monday, December 22nd, in Clarence Place Young Men's Rooms; and after reading all documents relating to the matter, and hearing the evidence, which was most fully and kindly placed before them, came to the following findings :—

1. We decide that the 'Life Committee' were illegally elected on October 10th, 1889, inasmuch as no power was vested in the Committee which had been formed to solicit and collect subscriptions to elect any such body as a 'Life Committee' of Management.

"2. We find that the Trustees of May 27th, 1890, were properly and legally elected.

"3. We recommend that the ground chosen for a site be at

once legally vested in the Trustees, and that they be put in immediate occupation, and that they, and they alone, are responsible for the erection and further management of the Hall.

"4. We further recommend that the members of Lodges 938 and 1053 having resigned their seats on the so-called 'Life Committee,' the suspension of the Lodges named should not be sanctioned by the County Grand Lodge.

The names of the Trustees elected May 27th, 1890, are

Lord Arthur Hill, Dr. Irvine, Mr. Launcelot Shaw, Mr. William Ross.

Although all the above are Orangemen, the Hall is in no sense an Orange Hall, as all the papers and printed circulars showed it was for Protestant and Constitutional purposes, it could never be under the control of the Orange Body. A discussion of considerable length ensued, as to the correct interpretations of the matters given the Committee to consider, and Bro. R. W. CARSON, District Secretary, No. 16 District, moved an amendment to the Report, but ultimately allowed it to pass, when the following resolution was unanimously adopted, viz.:--

"First—That the Committee of the Grand Orange Lodge of Down having reported that neither the present ordinary Hall Committee nor the so-called 'Life Committee' should interfere with the proposed Hall, but that all responsibility of erecting the Hall should be thrown entirely on the Trustees, we hereby appoint Bros. Thomas Radcliffe, Robert Parsons, Alexander Moorehead, Samuel Moffett and R. W. Carson, as a Committee on behalf of the Orangemen of Ballyhackamore, to confer with the Trustees, in order to have a suitable Hall erected with the full powers of this District Lodge, No. 16, County Down, to take such action in every respect as they may consider right, to protect the interests of the Orange Institution in connection with the Hall.

"Second—That we disapprove of the building plan prepared by the so-called 'Life Committee' for the proposed Hall, and we also disapprove of the proposed site on Mrs. Barr's ground, as neither the plan nor the site is suitable for the proposed Hall, and the adoption of them would waste the funds subscribed by members of our Institution and by the public for our benefit and for the benefit of the Constitutional Party in this District.

"Third—That in order to obtain united action on the part of the arrangement of this District, we hereby declare that all communications and arrangements on behalf of the members of our Institution with the Trustees with reference to the Hall shall be made through the District Lodge, and the Committee appointed by it, and no private Lodge or Member shall make any such communication or arrangement except with the sanction of this District Lodge, first obtained under seal.

"Fourth—That until a satisfactory arrangement be come to between the District Lodge and the Trustees, under which the Orange Institution will be granted a fair share of the benefits of the Hall, and a proper representation on any committee that may be connected with the Hall, we hereby (under the authority given us by the resolution of the Grand Orange Lodge of Ireland, passed in December, 1889), prohibit any Lodge from sitting in or in any way using or becoming connected with the Hall, unless they first obtain the leave of this District Lodge, No. 16, County Down, under its seal.

"Fifth—That any member of the Institution or Private Lodge neglecting to obey these regulations shall (on such neglect being proved in the District Lodge to our satisfaction), be immediately suspended. Suspension to be for a period not exceeding two years.

"Sixth—That all the Private Lodges in this District and the Trustees, and also the Grand Orange Lodge of County Down, be informed of the passing of these resolutions by this District Lodge.


