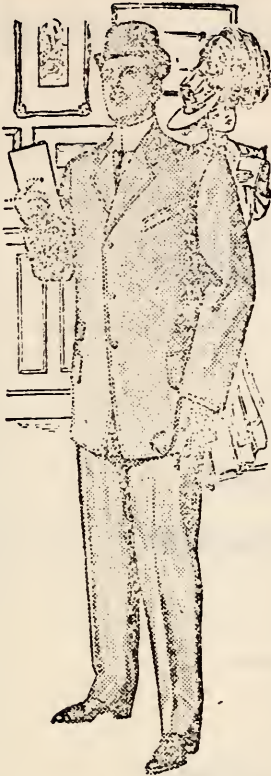

Richmond is understood to be the postoffice address of all families where no address is given. Gardiner is designated by Gard; Richmond Corner—Corner. R. D. routes are designated by number. R. D. 13 goes from Gardiner P. O.

Streets are abbreviated thus: Chestnut—Chest; So. Front—So F; No. Front—No F; School—Sch; Pleasant—Pleas; Kimball—Kimb.
