Introduction

The great British naturalist J. B. S. Haldane was once asked by a reporter which characteristics of the Creator he could infer from his studies of Nature. He reportedly replied, "an inordinate fondness for beetles." It is estimated that the number of recorded species of beetle is somewhere around 450,000, making beetles by far the most diverse group of animals on this planet. The total number of catalogued insects is estimated at over 1,000,000 different species. Just what peculiar fascination insects bore for the original Creator remains a mystery. Whatever it was, today a similar fascination is shared by the origami creator.

Insects have always been among the most challenging of origami subjects, owing to their many long, slender appendages, which require origamibases with many long, slender points. Points are fundamental elements of origami design. Obtaining a base with a few points is easy; achieving many points from a single uncut square of paper is far more difficult. While many folders have historically used cuts, multiple sheets, or the imagination of the observer to produce the legs, wings, and antennae of an insect, there have also been a number of folders-myself among them-for whom the accurate representation of our jointed-legged friends using the purist's rules of origami-one square, no cuts-has held a particular appeal, drawing us like moths to a flame.






The technical developments in origami design of the past decade have made it possible for us insectophiles to finally indulge our passion for jointed-legged paper creations. In the past, origami designers began from one of a small number of existing bases and made small modifications to obtain new models. There was only one base-the Blintzed Bird Base-that possessed sufficient points to make six legs plus antennae or wings, and good insect designs were few and far between. Now, however, the art and science of origami have progressed to the point that the modern origami designer can construct a unique base with precisely the number, length, and location of points to make any desired shape. The effect that the techniques of technical design have had on modern origami has gone beyond a post-Cambrian explosion of paper beetles, butterflies, and bugs; freed from the necessity of concentrating on numbers of points to the exclusion of all else, origami designers can focus their efforts instead on the esthetics of folding, rather than upon getting enough flaps; on developing life, rather than upon meeting a parts count.

This book contains twenty designs for origami insects, spiders, and related creatures, for the origami and entomological enthusiast. In this collection. I have tried to provide a varied selection of subjects, folding styles, and techniques. All of the models in this book can be successfully folded from standard 25 cm (10 in) square origami paper. although in many of them, some especially artistic

effects are possible with use of foil-backed paper or wet-folding techniques. The models were invented over a period of several years, and therefore show not only an evolution in folding style, but an evolution of influences as well. The Butterfly was inspired by a model of the same subject by Peter Engel; the Spotted Ladybug was inspired by the striped and spotted creations of John Montroll; and the Samurai Helmet Beetle was inspired by a design of Seiji Nishikawa. Less overt influences permeate the rest of the models, for I admit that I get my ideas and techniques from everywhere I can. Or, as Picasso once said, "Good artists borrow; great ones steal."

And I hope you will steal-or at least borrowfrom me. Each of the models represents a different subject and a different base, symmetry, or technique as well. I have purposely tried to vary the details, as well as the bases, using different techniques for thinning points, for making legs, and so forth. None of the designs here should be regarded as sacred; I encourage you to experiment, folding them differently, seeing if you can fold different types of insects from the same basic shape. Most importantly, if you would like to learn how to design your own insects, by all means pull the finished model apart to see how it went together and why the initial folds were made where they were. Although the pre-creasing sequences for many models may appear to be arbitrary, every fold's location is chosen for a specific symmetry, and it is a fun challenge to figure out what that symmetry is.





I hope that these models will be fun to fold and a pleasure to view. One thing they will not be, however, is easy. In origami, many points mean many folds, and all of these models have long folding sequences—this book is not for the origami novice. The simplest model here is at a level of difficulty that would earn it the highest complexity rating at an origami convention. In addition to their long folding sequences, many of the models also require a little something extra-a closed sink here. a closed un-sink there, or some other manipulation that may tax your dexterity. Much of the appeal of origami comes from the challenge of successfully folding a model, and the most difficult designs here will prove a challenge for even the advanced folder. Therefore, a basic familiarity with the conventions and terminology of origami and some experience folding complex models is in order. That said, the instructions for the models are complete (although they may be difficult) and have been tested on a number of folders, somewhere, someone has folded everything in this book. Each model was a challenge for me to design. I hope you enjoy the challenge of folding them!



Symbols and Terms

The instructions for the models use the line and arrow notation originally developed by Yoshizawa and popularized in the West by Randlett and Harbin. Each model begins from a square and proceeds through step-by-step drawings. Each drawing shows the result of the previous step, and what action is taken next. Before performing the operation shown in a given step, it is a good idea to look ahead to the next step, or next several steps, to see what the result will be.

Although the drawings are intended to be sufficient to fold each model, verbal instructions are provided for each step for additional clarification. The terms "upper," "lower," "top," "bottom," "left," "right," "horizontal," and "vertical" refer to the dimensions of the page itself: "toward the top" means "toward the top of the page," for example. The terms "front" and "near" refer to location or motion perpendicular to the page, that is, toward the folder; the terms "far," "behind," and "back" refer to location or motion away from the folder. The terms "in" and "inward" mean toward the middle of the model; the terms "out" and "outward" mean away from the middle, An edge can be a folded edge or a raw edge, which is part of the original edge of the square. These terms are illustrated below.







Procedures

The basic folding procedures — inside and outside reverse folds, squash and petal folds, rabbit ears, crimps, and pleats — are described in many origami books, and you should be familiar with the procedures (if not the names) before you tackle the

models in this book. (For a list of books with more extensive descriptions of the procedures, see Sources, p. 155.) An example of each of the basic procedures along with its name is given below.


Valley Fold





A valley fold — the most common origami fold — is denoted by a dashed line and an arrow with a symmetric head.


Mountain Fold






A mountain fold is used when you fold a flap away from you. It is denoted by a dot-dot-dash line and a hollow one-sided arrow.


Unfold



Unfolding a previously made crease is denoted by a symmetric hollow arrow.

Crease (Fold and Unfold)





When you fold a flap and immediately unfold it (usually to make a reference mark or a crease for later use), the arrow will have a valley fold arrowhead at one end and an unfold arrowhead at the other.

Inside Reverse Fold





An inside reverse fold changes the direction of a flap by pushing its spine down between its edges and turning the tip inside-out.


Outside Reverse Fold





An outside reverse fold wraps the raw edges of the moving flap around the spine.

Rabbit Ear



A rabbit ear is usually formed by bisecting all three angles of a triangle and swinging the point to one side or the other to flatten.


Squash Fold






A squash fold is formed from a flap with at least two edges along one side; the two edges are spread apart, and the one flap turns into two shorter ones.

Petal-Folding a Point





There are two types of petal fold. The way shown here lengthens and narrows a point.

Petal-Folding an Edge





The other type of petal fold takes an edge and turns it into a point, as shown here.

Pleat





A pleat is formed by folding the paper back and forth in a zig-zag fashion.


Crimp





A crimp is a multilayered pleat in which the near layers form the mirror image of the far layers. You can make crimps by either unfolding the paper and pleating, or by two successive reverse folds.

Open Sink Fold












Spread Sink



The sink fold inverts a point that has no raw edges. A sink is an open sink if the point is completely opened out halfway through the fold as shown here.

A spread sink flattens a point that has no raw edges. It is also an easy way to make an open sink if you close it up afterwards. In addition to the well-known basic folds, several of the designs in this book make use of two lesserknown procedures that are rather more difficult to carry out. If you are unfamiliar with these procedures, you might wish to fold some examples as practice before you undertake a model that uses one of them; if you encounter one in a model for the first time, you should put the model aside and use a different piece of paper to practice the maneuver until you can do it neatly and cleanly.

Closed Sink



The closed sink looks like an open sink, but instead of opening out the point, you "pop" it inside-out without unfolding it



One way of making a closed sink is to invert the pyramidal point, beginning at the rim of the sink.



The corners of a closed sink are linked together, while those of an open sink are loose. Compare a closed sink.



To an open sink



Here is an easy way to make a closed sink. First, fold a rabbit car from the point.



Then bring a single layer in front of the rabbit ear.



Finally, push the edges of the rabbit ear down inside the hole, turning it completely inside-out.



Finished closed sink.

Open and Closed Unsinks

The unsink is exactly the opposite of a sink. In a sink, you turn a point into a pocket; in an unsink,

you turn a pocket into a point. And as do sinks, unsinks come in both open and closed varieties.



Here is a shape you can practice open and closed unsinks upon.



An unsink is indicated by the arrow that shows to pull some paper out. The difficulty is that for open unsinks, there is nothing to grab on to!



Here is a way of doing some open unsinks. Open the pocket slightly and push in the sides so that only a single layer bulges upward.



Then flatten the paper,



A closed unsink is indicated the same way as an open unsink.



In a closed unsink, though, you can reach inside the pocket and grab an edge to pull out.




The Treehopper is an insect that hides from predators by mimicking a thorn. When it clings to a twig, its green or brown body blends in with the stem and the horn on its head resembles a smaller twig or thorn. Under cover of camouflage, the treehopper sucks the juices out of the plants it clings to, and is therefore considered a pest by gardeners.





Ladybug beetles are a large family of insects, recognizable by their round bodies and distinctive patterns of spots. The number of spots depends on the species, and can vary from one or two up to as many as twenty-three. Ladybugs are voracious predators of aphids and other garden pests, and in the Middle Ages were dedicated to "Our Lady" in appreciation of their service—which is how they got their name.

Spiders, although they look like insects, are not; they are called arachnids, and are distinguished from insects by having eight legs (all insects have six) and only two body segments (insects have three). There are over 75,000 named species worldwide. Most spiders have the ability to spin fine strands of silk. Although some species use the silk only for lining their burrows or to ride the wind, several are known for spinning large, symmetric, elliptical meshes in which they catch their prey.


The Tarantula, like the Orb Weaver, is a spider, not an insect. Like all spiders, it has eight legs, but the male has two appendages, called pedipalps, that resemble a fifth pair of legs. They are actually part of the tarantula's mouth Because of their size (up to 4 inches in legspan), they are often thought to be dangerous. However, the bite of a North American tarantula is actually no worse than a beesting. They tend to be docile, and make good pets, with the males living 2 to 3 years and the larger females living up to 20.






Although the Tick may appear at first to be an insect, a close examination reveals that it has eight legs, rather than six. It is actually more closely related to spiders and scorpions. Ticks range in size from no larger than the period at the end of this sentence up to over 5 mm long. All ticks are parasites, attaching themselves to a host and sucking a meal of blood. Although the quantity of blood removed is insignificant, ticks transmit a number of diseases to humans, including Rocky Mountain Spotted Fever (which, despite its name, is actually more common east of the Mississippi River) and Lyme disease.




