

Lydia Chibane has two paintings for us. On page one, a painting of her son's home in Summit, NJ, done in acrylic on canvas board. Pictured here, "The McKenzie," is a painting of a church in Jersey City, which has been converted into condominiums, where another of Lydia's sons now lives. The painting was a housewarming gift. Lydia has also been painting tiles: "These are some of the porcelain tile trivets I made while adapting images from books and wallpaper, and my own compositions. When dry I bake them and apply felt backing."

From **Diana**:

"You see three different photos of my studio here in Munhall, PA (a tiny suburb of Pittsburgh). My studio includes several large bookcases, one of which is floor to ceiling, built-in, as well as my art table, FantasyLand (i.e. five dollhouses, including a general store), where Jillian and I play (and is the inspiration for a chapter book trilogy I'm writing), and a reading nook for Jillian. I

hang things from the ceiling, as well as on the walls. One photo shows a fish & lobster painting I'm playing with, along with some of my Safari brand models on the desk (note Octopus). One photo shows some dollhouse and Hanover the Houseplant in the window. Hanover is a philodendron, 46 years old, given to us by Hanover Square Dancers when we moved from Denville to Bridgewater 46 years ago. The third photo shows some of FantasyLand, the reading nook, paintings on the walls, and Jellyfish hanging from the ceiling.

The Museum of Early Trades and Crafts in Madison NJ has issued a "Call for Artists":

EXHIBITION DESCRIPTION:

The Museum of Early Trades & Crafts (METC) is inviting New Jersey artists to submit artwork for an exhibition held in the METC Education Annex in October 2021. Artists are invited to create original fine artwork on canvas material that will be provided. Each banner will be an original, one-of-a-kind work of art using any medium of the artist's choice reflecting the theme of "Hope." The canvas banners are 24' x 36' and will be on display in the Museum's Education Annex windows for a period of three months starting on October 27, 2021, and ending February 28, 2022. At the end of the exhibition, METC will host a reception where the banners will be sold and/or auctioned. METC selected 'Hope' as its first 2021 Artists' Showcase theme, recognizing that the COVID-19 crisis has touched the lives of every individual across the globe. Although the pandemic continues, we see the resiliency of people shining through even the darkest days toward better and safer times and this gives us all Hope. We invite artists to produce a work that reflects this theme.
