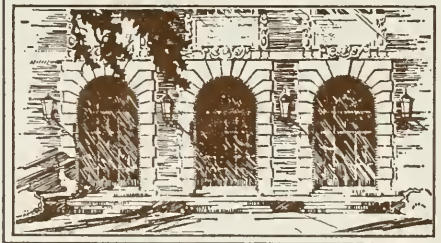




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PREFACE

The task of refuse disposal confronts every municipality in the United States. The proper storage, collection, and disposal of solid waste has long been considered a major problem. With the increase in urbanization and the steady rise in per capita production of solid wastes, more and more people are recognizing the need for properly engineered, effective, and economic solid waste disposal facilities. Sanitary landfill is one basic and effective community method for disposing of all types of refuse. It is a planned, systematic method that differs from ordinary dumping in that waste material is placed in a trench or prepared area, adequately compacted, and covered with earth at the end of the working day. Sanitary landfill is not only an efficient method of refuse disposal, but reclaims waste land for useful purposes as well.

This bibliography is a collection of recent material on the various aspects of establishing and operating a sanitary landfill. The emphasis is on current information, and nothing published before 1960 has been included. For information appearing prior to 1960, the following source should be consulted. It is organized chronologically by year and covers the period 1925 - 1968.

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
