Subject: Selected Publications Relating to Oil and Gas Development and Environmental Problems Associated Therewith, [December 1972] (Supplement to August 1971 Technical Note on the same subject)

12. Wheeler and Whited, Oil - From Prospect to Pipeline, Second Edition, 1971, Gulf Publishing Company, \$5.50. An excellent primer-type book on oil - better than publication 1a, Primer of Oil and Gas Production previously described.
13. BLM, Final Environmental Statement, Proposed 1972 OCS Oil and Gas General Lease Sale, Offshore Eastern Louisiana, 1972. An excellent discussion of energy alternatives and environmental problems associated with the proposed sale. Until better ones are developed, this is recommended as a guide for the development of draft environmental statements involving oil and gas.
14. National Petroleum Council, Environmental Conservation - The Oil and Gas Industries, Volume I - A Summary, 1971, \$3.00, Volume II - The detailed report, 1972, \$10.00. Volume III contains a fairly complete discussion of environmental effects of oil and gas from exploration through the end use. It tends to emphasize actions by the industry to overcome problems.
15. Allen, D. R., "Environmental Aspects of Oil Producing Operations - Long Beach, California," Journal of Petroleum Technology, February 1972. An interesting discussion of use of camouflage to disguise oil operations in an urban recreation area.
16. BLM, Draft Environmental Statement, Proposed 1972 OCS Oil and Gas General Lease Sale, Offshore Louisiana. Similar to item 13 except that it contains a greater discussion of marine oil spills and their environmental effects and a more sophisticated matrix for analyzing environmental impacts.
