TERRY FOX RUN

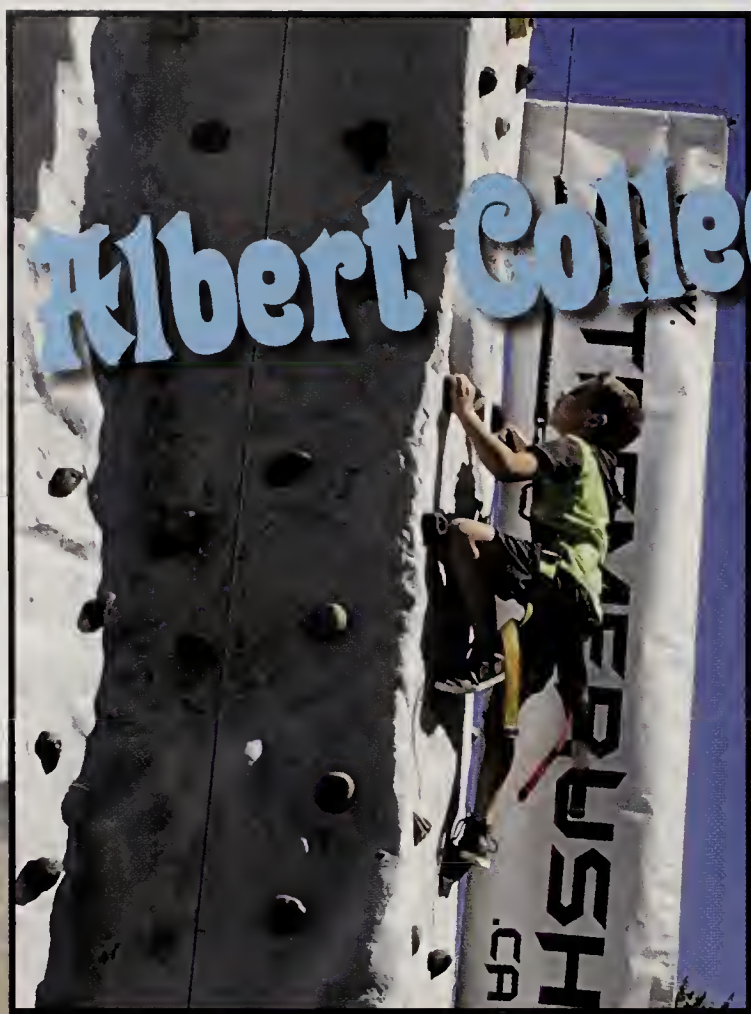

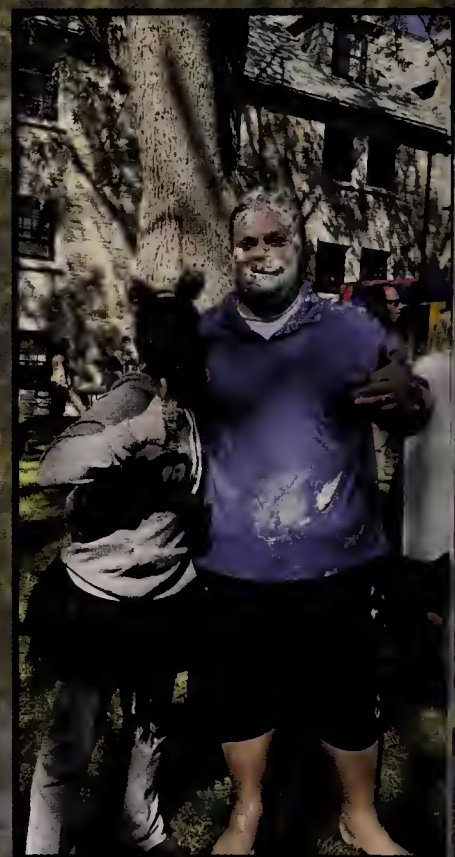

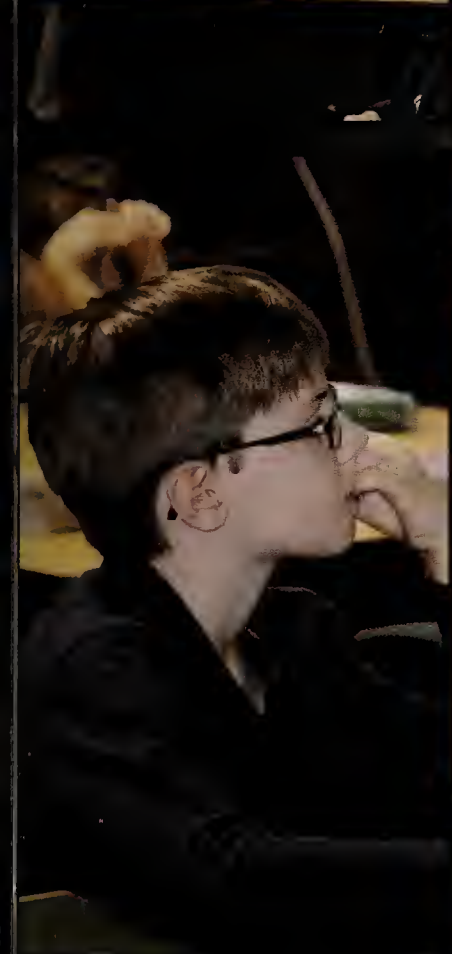

DUKE OF EDINBURGH FRONTENAC PARK

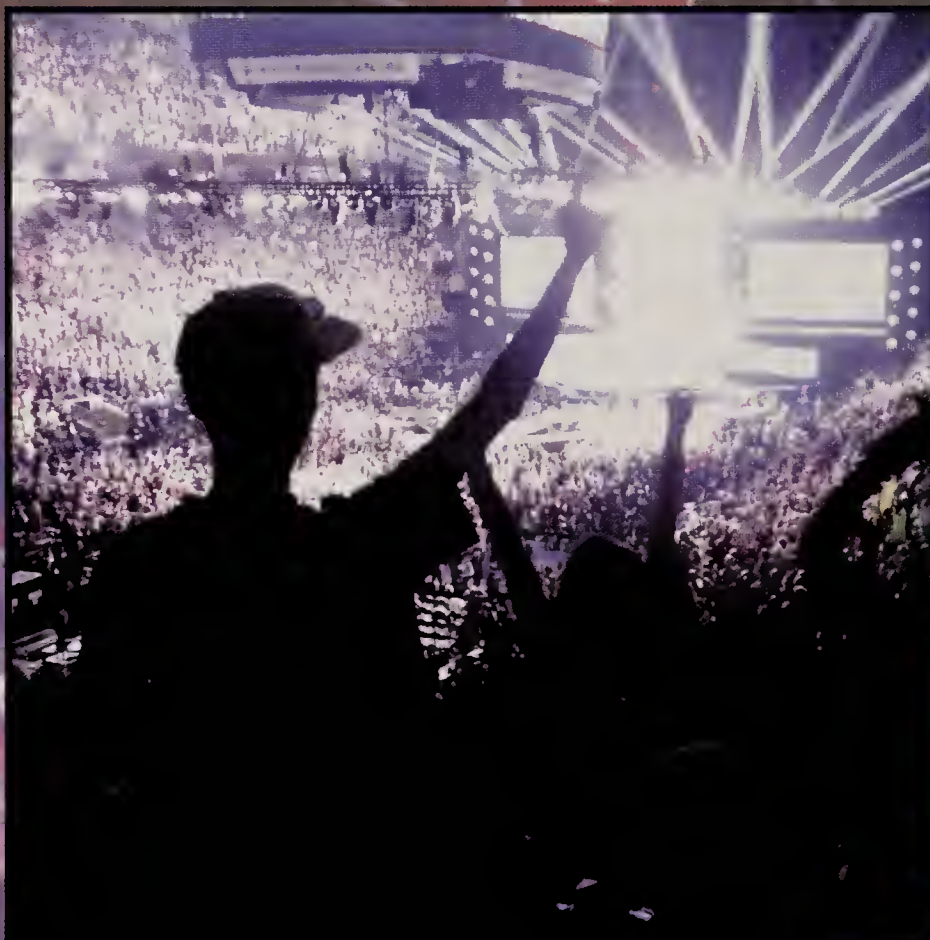
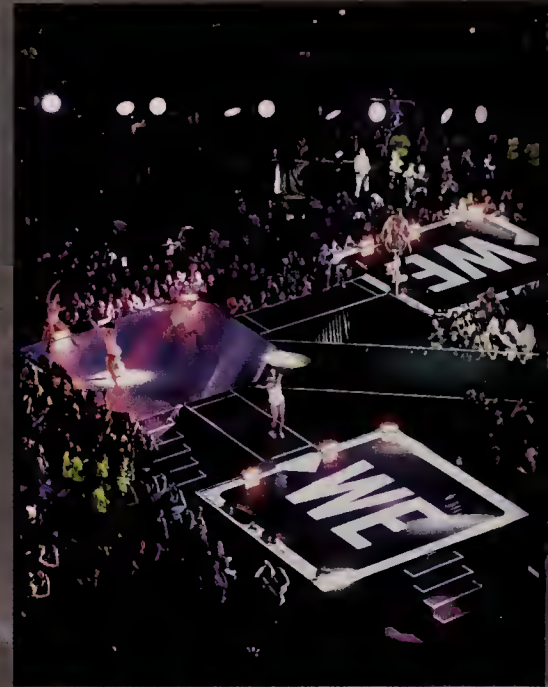

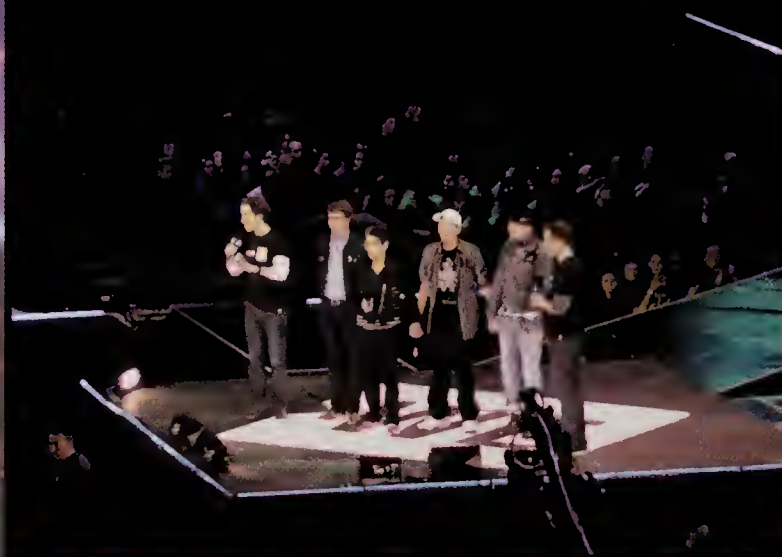


We Day

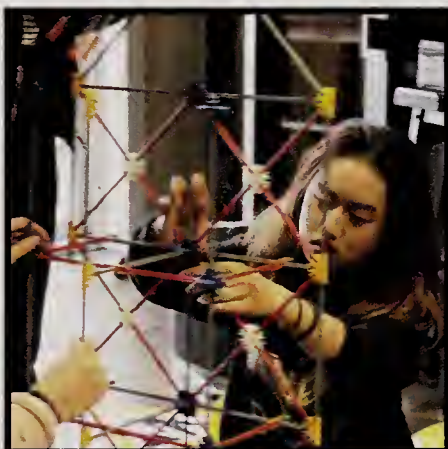
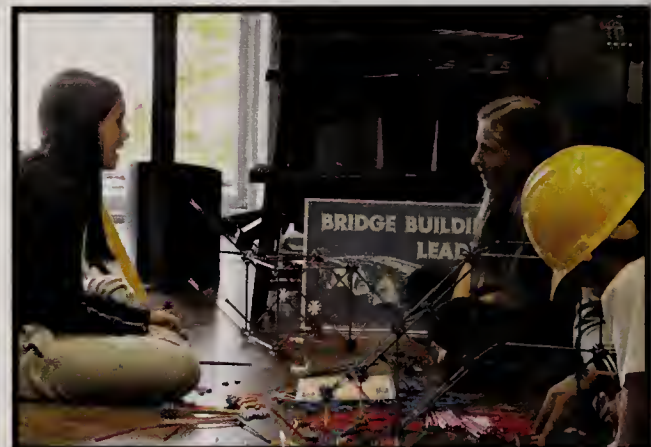
MUSKOKA WOODS
