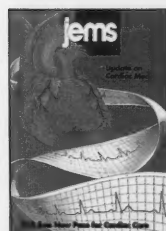
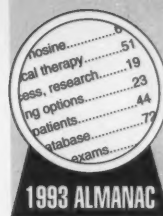

Bylined columns are listed alphabetically by column name. They are then listed alphabetically by name under each column name. All articles in this section are cross-referenced by topic in Section I.

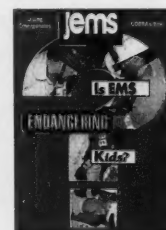
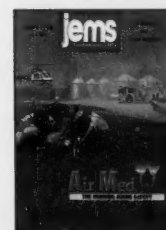
