Manager of Sung Sing No. 9 Cotton Mill and son arrested by French Police at instance of Japanese Gendarmerie

At 2 a.m. July 27, officers of the French Police, accompanied by a party of Japanese Gendarmes, visited House 170 Rue Pershing, and arrested therein Woo Tseng Yue (吳增裕), manager of the Sung Sing No. 9 Cotton Mill, and his son Woo Ching Yih (吳中一). The arrested men are still detained in the French Police Station.

Reported arrest of Woo Kwung Sung, Manager of  
Sung Sing No. 9 Mill by Japanese Gendarmes in  
French Concession

Sir,

At 4 a.m. 27/7/41 Insp. White O. i/s Postee Road Station received a telephone message from Mr. Baker, director of the Sung Sing No. 9 Mill, stating that the manager of the factory Mr. Woo Kwung Sung ( *吳光榮* ) and his son Woo Tsoo Yih ( *吳子一* ) were in the custody of the French Police.

Enquiries show that at about 2.30 a.m. 27/7/41 a party of Japanese Gendarmes accompanied by Chinese went to the home of Woo Kwung Sung at 177 Route Ferguson and took out Woo Kwung Sung and his son Woo Tsoo Yih. Upon the entry of the party one of the servants pressed an alarm bell which resulted in a number of French Police attending and taking the whole party to Poste Mallet, they later went to Police Headquarters in Rue Stanislas Chevalier.

The Japanese allege that he was concerned in the murder of the late Special Deputy Commissioner Mr. C. Agazzi and wanted to take the two men to the Hangkew Headquarters of the Gendarmerie.
