




and confusion lend a ready ear to the dire temptations of relinquishment and vilify our action.



Following is a letter that Maj. Gen. Vern Lewis, USA (Ret'd), asked be passed on:

I gathered some 16 of my old military friends who agreed to sponsor a movement for Veterans to salute rather than place their hands over their heart when honoring the flag, fallen comrades, and/or the country. I have some from each of the four principal services. Three of them were former Vice Chiefs or Assistant Commandants of their services, and several were former CINC's.

We refer to saluting when we do the pledge to the flag, when the National Colors pass or are presented, when the National Anthem or honors are played, or when taps are played and firing squads or guns render honors. We got MOAA magazine to ask veterans what they preferred, hand over the heart or saluting: [respondents] voted 81% favor of the salute... Obviously an overwhelming majority of the veterans

Hanoi Jane Not Honored by Georgia Legislature

Sen. Steen Miles, D-Decatur, proposed a resolution honoring actress Jane Fonda, an Atlanta resident, for her work as founder of the Georgia Campaign for Adolescent Pregnancy Prevention, donations to Atlanta-area universities and charities and role as goodwill ambassador with the United Nations. The measure, which Miles said is one of several she promoted honoring Georgia women during Women's History Month, had cruised through the Senate before some members noticed it in a lot of mostly non-controversial resolutions approved because no one objected to them.

Sen. John Douglas, R-Social Circle, later asked that the vote be reconsidered. "I can think of no living American who is less worthy of this honor," Douglas, chairman of the chamber's Veterans and Military Affairs committee, said Thursday. "She is as guilty of treason as Benedict Arnold and Tokyo Rose."

The Senate voted 38-1 to reconsider the measure - a necessary procedure before Miles could withdraw it, but when the time came for her to officially withdraw the resolution, a member of the Senate's Republican majority objected, forcing a vote wherein the resolution lost 38-1.

Salar Ban, Afghanistan -- Moments after Marines discovered a "safe house" that stored more than a thousand pounds of explosives - plus an additional thousand pounds or so of fuses and components useful in the manufacture of IEDs, Lance Cpl. Brandon Benz-Marrs saw the back-blast from an RPG and watched the flying bomb head straight for them. "I dived down and thought, 'This is it. We're dead.' Then, somehow, it ended up landing about 15 meters from us. None of us were hit. We didn't have time to count our luck. We immediately started sending rounds down range," recalled the Wailuku, Maui native.

In conjunction with soldiers from the Afghan National Army, Marines from Charlie Company, 1st Battalion, 3rd Marine Regiment, based out of Marine Corps Base Hawaii, Kaneohe Bay, recently conducted a week-long, company-wide operation led by Charlie Company Commander Capt. Jared Spurlock in the Shuryak Valley of Kunar Province in eastern Afghanistan. It was immediately followed by another weeklong mission manning an observation post along the Pech River Road in the often-hostile area between Camp Blessing in Nangalam, and Camp Wright in Asadabad.

"All told, Marines from Charlie Company's 3rd Platoon spent 15 days in the field, and along with the rest of the company, engaged in numerous firefights with the enemy during the company operation, while also placing 11 suspected Anti-Coalition Militia and ACM collaborators in the status of personnel under control," noted 1st Lt. Kevin Frost, platoon commander, 3rd Platoon, Charlie Company, 1/3.

The most significant of these battles, according to Spurlock, occurred near the remote mountain village of Salar Ban in the Shuryak Valley, moments after Marines discovered the

Bomb-Building Insurgents' Costly Lesson Don't Mess With The Marines

Search and Destroy

"Our mission on this company operation was simple – to close with and destroy the enemy," said Spurlock, a native of Pocatello, Idaho. "The Shuryak Valley is a known enemy stronghold in our area of operations. We knew the enemy was out there, we just didn't know exactly where." The Marines of Charlie Company would find out soon enough.

"During our reconnaissance in force we searched numerous villages in the area, looking for Anti-Coalition Militia members and collaborators, as well as for weapons, and to gather intelligence," said Spurlock. "We had reports that there were enemy in the vicinity of Salar Ban, so we went to that village to talk to local residents and village leaders to get a feeling of enemy activity in the area." What the Marines found was a ghost town.

"The insurgents are like ghosts," said Gunnery Sgt. Paul Davis, company gunnery sergeant for Charlie Company, 1/3, and a native of Laurens, S.C. "They just disappear into the mountains and sometimes you see them and sometimes you don't."

"I knew there was something wrong when we rolled up and the village was basically deserted," said Sgt. Nathan Zechman, 2nd squad leader, 3rd Platoon, Charlie Company, 1/3. "There was no one really in the village. I had a feeling something was going to go down," recalled the Hershey, Pa., native.

As it turned out, Zechman's gut feeling was right on the money.

"During our search of a home in Salar Ban, we discovered roughly 1,000 pounds of explosives with an additional 1,000 pounds of time fuses and other accessories used to detonate explosives," said Spurlock.

During the search, the explosives were discovered by two combat engineers attached to Charlie Company – Lance Cpl. Jordan Mills, from Louisville, Ky., and Lance Cpl. Daniel Johnson, from Salt Lake City.

"Almost as soon as we got the word that the explosives were found, I saw a back-blast from an RPG (rocket propelled grenade) and saw the RPG headed straight for us," said Lance Cpl. Brandon Benz-Marrs, assaultman, 3rd Platoon, Charlie Company, 1/3.

Punch-Up in Suryak Valley

What ensued over the next 30 minutes was a ferocious firefight between Marines from Charlie Company and the ACM, the likes of which Charlie Company Marines hadn't seen since the battle of Fallujah in Iraq in November of 2004, noted Sgt. Michael Chambers, platoon sergeant, 3rd Platoon, Charlie Company, 1/3. "The Marines who hadn't seen combat before got their wish today," said Chambers, a Purple Heart and Bronze Star with combat distinguishing device medal recipient from Lexington, S.C. "The enemy had the terrain advantage. The potential was there for them to put a hurting on us, but the Marines did what they were trained to do and in the end, we crushed them."

Indeed, according to Spurlock, later reports estimated that upwards of 20 insurgents were killed in the firefight and in the artillery bombardment and air support that followed.

"All told, including the initial firefight, the battle lasted over an hour, but once the big guns and air support came in there was nothing the enemy could do," said Chambers. "I heard we killed 20 of them. I wish it were 21. There is always room for one more dead Taliban who is trying to kill Marines, our ANA brothers and innocent Afghans."

Many Lava Dogs from Charlie Company called it a miracle that there were no Marine casualties during the exchange. "I think it was a combination of a miracle by God and Marine Corps training that none of us were killed or wounded at Salar Ban," said Lance Cpl. Jose Romero, 1st Fire Team Leader, 3rd Squad, 3rd Platoon, Charlie Company, 1/3. "For a minute there I thought I was going to die, but I never felt fear. All I felt was the Marine



Corps training kicking in. It seemed like we were in one firefight or another every day on this operation, but Salar Ban was definitely the worst, or, if you think about it, the best."

Others were a little less spiritual in their outlook on the battle at Salar Ban. "Yeah, I'm surprised none of us died at Salar Ban," said Cpl. David Gordon, 3rd Squad Leader, 3rd Platoon, Charlie Company, 1/3. "There were a lot of close calls," continued the Bowling Springs, S.C., native. "It just came down to they missed and we didn't"

"It was luck no Marines got killed," said Mills. "Pure and simple good oldfashioned luck. The Marines are good. But I'd rather be lucky than good any day."

"They shot crooked and we shot straight," added Frost in his summation of the firefight.

Others chalked up the decisive Marine Corps victory at Salar Ban to neither divine intervention nor luck, but rather to the superiority of Marine Corps training and the fighting spirit of the individual Marines. "To have RPG's and AK-47's shot at you, you would think that the reasonableman theory would kick in and you'd start spazzing the heck out and dive in a ditch or something," said Davis. "These guys didn't do that at all. They held their positions and immediately put lead back toward the enemy. The Marines did good. No, they did better than good. They were awesome."

Marine, Ready-To-Eat

Some would say none more so than Davis himself. "Years from now probably most of the Marines who were at Salar Ban won't remember how Gunny Davis steadfastly checked on the safety of his Marines or that he advanced on the enemy, but rather that it was he who first broke the tension of combat by cracking open an MRE immediately after the initial firing stopped and said to a group of Marines in his nonchalant way, 'Combat makes me hungry,'' recalled Chambers. "That's the stuff of legends."

Countless other Marines distinguished themselves during the battle, according to Davis, but it was Frost that most Lava Dogs seemed to be talking about following the victory.

"He's not the type of Marine leader who is yelling instructions from a distance," said Cpl. William Graves, 1st Fire Team Leader, 1st Squad, 3rd Platoon, Charlie Company, 1/3. "He's gonna be right there beside his grunts on the frontlines of the fight, like just like he was at Salar Ban," observed the Bowling Green, Ky., native.

"It's just basic human instinct that when you are getting shot at you take cover," said Romero, a native of La Mirada, Calif. "It is even how we are trained in the Marine Corps – take cover and then return fire. I never saw Lieutenant Frost take cover. We were under fire and he was walking around barking orders making sure his Marines were OK and that they were doing the right things tactically. He was like an action hero from the movies. I never thought I'd see something like that in real life. His example inspired us and gave us all confidence."

Frost, who was previously wounded in action during a firefight on 25 January by an AK-47 round, was quick to downplay any heroism on his part during the events at Salar Ban.

"All that stuff about me not taking cover, that's not exactly true," said Frost, a native of Zeeland, Mich. "I took cover just like everyone else when the first barrage hit, but once I figured out where the rounds were coming from I felt good enough about my location to walk around in certain areas. It might have appeared like I was just walking around like a madman, but that's not exactly how it went down. I was just doing my job, finding my squad leaders, making sure they were good to go and ensuring that we had combined arms fire going down range."

"During the fight I never felt fear and I never saw fear on the faces of my Marines," continued Frost. "It's only after the fact when you have some time to think about it when you go, 'Man, I really could have gotten killed today."

For most of the Lava Dogs who served at Salar Ban, it was more than just a little coincidence that the enemy attacked soon after the explosives were discovered. "As soon as we found the explosives they pretty much instantly opened up on us," said Chambers. "It doesn't take a rocket-scientist to know they weren't happy about us finding a stash of explosives that they had easy access to and could pretty much dip into any time they wanted. They knew the explosives were there - no question about it."

Lives Saved

According to Lance Cpl. Anthony Mitchell, an intelligence specialist from Burlington, Colo., attached to Charlie Company, 1/3, it was the largest such explosive cache find since coalition forces first came to Afghanistan in 2001. "There is a big problem having a thousand pounds of explosives right in the backyard of the insurgents," said Frost, "where there is one bad guy for every pound of explosives we found. It's a huge security risk having that much material potentially in the hands of the enemy."

"The significance of this company operation was the recovery of the explosives that I believe will directly result in lives being saved – not just Marines but other coalition members and ANA and ANP (Afghan National Police) forces," said Spurlock. "When we can take away the enemy's access to explosives we are also taking away their ability to put those explosives on the roads in the form of IEDs and that directly results in the lives of coalition forces being saved. Anytime we can take explosives out of the reach of the bad guys it is a victory." X

Well, if you believe everything you hear on the news then you may not want to read this, because the plain truth about what is going on in Iraq just might make you reconsider where you get your news.

This was my 3^{rd} trip to Iraq, starting with the ground war. I believe even more in what we are doing there – no change of heart here. From what I have observed myself, I still feel that the Iraqi people are better off now than before.

For those who have lost a loved one winning freedom for the Iraqis, I am truly sorry and I hope that you are not bitter about it. There is a very good chance that he or she has changed someone's life for the better; Your loved one has done the greatest thing any human can do in their lifetime.

Life in Iraq has changed since I was there last. Now back home, on the news every night I see the reports of everything bad that has happened in Baghdad - all the car bombs and IEDs. But what is not so obvious is that the reports are just videotapes of what has happened today. Where are the reporters? You can see them on TV, but just where are they? Usually they can be found in very safe places. As a small boy I would watch the news and see the reporters in Vietnam and later in Ireland. In Desert Storm and the OIF 1, they would be with us on the road, but not now. They hide inside the Green Zone and tell you what they think is going on - and that is just not good enough. Your loved ones and the American people need to hear the truth, which is that the U.S. Forces are doing the just and right thing over there.

There are so many ways GIs have come up with to make their vehicles and gear better, it would take a year to write them all down. Before I came over to Iraq this last time, I did a product review for SOF on gear that was good to go. I know that most companies test their gear but I took my product test to the next level. Thanks to the insurgents over in Iraq, all the gear from my last report has been tested under fire. My Point Blank body armor has taken a hit from IEDs and small arms fire and has saved my life more than once.

When I returned from Iraq along with the rest of my Division, the 3rd Infantry, although it was great to step off the plane at Hunter Army Air Field in Savannah, we brought with us a sadness, as 3rd

In March 2005 I told you the gear that I would be taking back to Iraq with me. Now if you don't mind listening to some war stories, I would like to tell you how all that gear held up.

I can remember telling my soldiers how we were going to find the IEDs and get the SOBs that had emplaced them. I was told by the battle-hardened Platoon Sergeant I was replacing not to worry about finding the IEDs - they would find us. No truer words have ever been spoken.

On 2 April 2005 my platoon had two Bradley's on an escort mission of four thin-skinned vehicles. SSG David Miller was in the lead Bradley and I was in the trailing one. We moved ahead of the other vehicles so we could take out any threat that might lie ahead. It was almost 1800 hours and we had been out in 100+ degree temperatures for the past 12 hours. With no contact and less then two miles to base I was glad my day was almost over. SGT Sean Cochran, my gunner, asked if he could stand up and get some air. I told SGT Cochran Continued on page 32



The sweltering tropic heat of the day quickly fades in the chilly mountain dusk. I can just make out the shadowy eucalyptus trees that reminded me of my Australian home. I feel every mosquito bite, silently cursing myself for not taking any of the anti-malarial drugs I had smuggled in. The eight East Timorese resistance fighters sharing my ambush position seem to have been swallowed up by the earth. In a paranoid moment I wonder if I have fallen asleep and been left alone in this foreign war zone. As I feel another bug crawling inside my trouser leg, I recheck my watch for the hundredth time that hour. I am close to praying that someone will wander into our ambush site just for the opportunity to get up, move around and scratch a few layers of itchy skin from my body.

From the ravine just a couple of hundred meters up the track that we are watching, breaks the deafening sound of automatic-weapons fire. The silence

of the last three hours is broken by the roar of what sounds like a counter-ambush drill in progress, and the nervous sounds of Indonesian NCOs issuing commands. Experiencing the most all-consuming fear of my life, throttling the FMPmade G3 rifle in my hands, I stare into surrounding the scrub, desperately hoping to see the familiar, reassuring smile of José as he tells me what's happening – and if I should be shooting, attacking or running away. Bloody hell! It sounds like serious battle a just over the ridge

Local Wars That Followed World War II

Back in 1942, the Australian 2/2 Independent Company commandos were sent to Portuguese Timor in a preemptory, desperate bid to stem the tide of Japanese aggression and buy time to defend the Australian coastline. These 400 Aussie "diggers" were the Western-Australian-based forefathers of today's Australian SAS. The island of Timor is Australia's closest neighbor, long ago colonized in the West by the Dutch and in the East by the Portuguese. In the 12 months following deployment, the handful of Aussie Commandos, with close cooperation and support from the East Timorese natives, succeed in engaging and pinning down 20,000 Japanese troops - ultimately inflicting over 1,500 casualties upon the Japanese military occupation force.

The East Timorese have always been fiercely Western and Christian in

outlook, unlike the Dutch half of the island. In this desperate war, a strong bond of brotherhood was forged between the Australian soldiers and their East Timorese allies. For several months following the invasion, the Australian Army command had assumed the men from the 2/2 were dead or captured, like their 1100 Australian colleagues to the West who had been forced to surrender after four days of fierce fighting. In contrast to Portuguese East Timor, native collaboration with the Japanese was com-

in the mon in West Timor.

The following year Canberra reas-

sessed the strategic landscape and gave priority to the battle for New Guinea, abandoning Timor. As the Australian commandos were withdrawn by submarine, Australian bombers dropped the now infamous leaflet over East Timor, which states in English and Portuguese: "Your Friends Will Not Forget You." Japanese retribution, slave-labor gangs and famine accounted for the lives of between 40,000 and 60,000 East Timorese over the following two years.

This was not the end of the East Timorese people's suffering or fierce struggle for freedom. In 1975 the Portuguese began withdrawing from their colonial possessions in the wake of

the fall of the Salazar regime in Lisbon, and the African brushwars in Mozambique and Angola. Meanwhile, the former Dutch colony of Indonesia saw an opportunity to strike a vulnerable target and consolidate its hold upon the vast island archipelago. Indonesia (population 240 million), the world's most populous Muslim nation, invaded the tiny half-island of East Timor from air, sea and land on 12 December 1975. With East Timor's (population 600,000) small geographic size, absence of a formal army in the wake of the Portuguese withdrawal, and a government and economy in disarray, the Indonesian invaders expected a quick victory. What the Indonesian dictator, General Suharto, had not anticipated was a resilient warrior culture, a stubborn refusal to integrate into Muslim-dominated, Eastward looking Indonesian culture, and a

"They're All Murderous Bastards, You Know"

Trying to Find Some Good Guys in the Balkan War – Part Two

Last month, the author arrived in the Balkans and became acclimated to a war zone where it was brother against brother, with quarter seldom asked and almost never given. This month he pursues the quest for understanding by spending time on the ground with the men at the sharp – or was it the wrong – end of the spear.

The Finnish captain assigned to cooperate with me hooked me up with a British mercenary named Kevin Carter. Carter said he was a deserter from the British Army. Carter had an ugly head wound and a dilemma. The young Brit claimed he couldn't go home because he was wanted for desertion and war crimes in Great Britain. Equally unfortunate, he couldn't stay in Croatia because the government had unexpectedly enforced its rule against foreigners in the army by discharging him. He thought it had something to do with war crimes but he wasn't yet sure. He was living on 80 German Deutschmarks a month, handouts, and what he could scrounge from guys like me passing through the Zadar Hotel bar on the way to the war. He had already been told he had 60 days to clear out, or the Croatians were going to show him the door. In the meantime, he was still on duty although it had a different meaning in HOS than normal military units. Most of the time Kevin hung around the Zadar Hotel scrounging drinks and talking to the E.C. monitors he hated.

Kevin claimed he had been in Croatia for almost a year when I met him. For the last three months he had been recovering from a nasty-looking head wound he had suffered near Skabrnje, a little village near Zadar and quite forgettable had it not been the site of a massacre two years before. Kevin bragged he had fought in several vicious battles and owned a barroom reputation for being tough and resourceful.

Kevin said he came to Croatia by way of the British Army of the Rhine, from which he deserted, after a tour in Northern Ireland that he loved and several years "square bashing" at posts in Germany and Great Britain that he hated. To look at him Kevin Carter didn't seem like warrior. He was rather slim, of average height, had dark hair, a long face, and a quizzical smile that made him appear either amused or confused by whatever was going on around him. Before Kevin was wounded he lived in a blown-up house on the first line near Nadin, another tiny village neasr Skabrnje.

One More Massacre

The year before Kevin arrived in HOS, Serbs had massacred 43 civil-

ians at Skabrnje and Nadin, shooting and then driving over them with tanks and committing other atrocities. Since then feelings there had run high, and the antagonists who survived murdered each other with as much energy as they could muster.

Because Skabrnje is so close to Zadar and held such emotional significance, 1.4 Brigade HOS was ordered to take it back during the Croat's successful 1993 offensive. The brigade's reputation as a fire-eating unit of mercenaries from all over Europe was due to the abilities of its former Canadian Army commander, a fellow who took the name of Col. McKenzie. Though it was designated a brigade, Kevin said it never had more than 400 men in it. It was not enough men to take Skabrnje in conjunction with the Croatian's attempt to recover the Maslenica Bridge, a massive structure that had been dropped into the Adriatic Sea almost two years before. As a result the Serbs and Croats skirmished there almost every day.

Several nights after I arrived, Kevin's reconnaissance platoon was ordered to discover where the Serbs were, which meant in Kevin's words, "Snooping about until we got shot at."

M - L - XL (2XL - 3XL Add \$2) Unnoticed until they attacked, the patrol seized the house and captured its occupants before they could sound an alarm. This was not an abnormal situation on the first line, Kevin explained in contumacious Slavic logic, because both sides frequently have parties and forget to post guards.

All went well for the rest of the night, with Kevin and his comrades tying up and gagging the Serbs before drinking their liquor until dawn. By daylight they were very drunk and in a foul mood. Then the Finn shot the Serb commander between the eyes with his own pistol. The next morning when I arrived the dead Serb was still laying in the doorway of his house wearing a quizzical smile. Kevin thought it was a hilarious story and repeated it several times. Some weeks later the Finn would give me a play-by-play account. Then he deserted.

Soon after dawn broke the Croatians moved in force into the area around the house and Kevin and his comrades were ordered to take the prisoners, there were now four of them, back to Zadar, he said. While they were preparing to do so the European Community monitors showed up in their white Toyota Land Cruisers to negotiate a cease-fire and try to compel the Croatians to give the captured ground back. The so-called "E.C." officers had little real authority because they were unarmed, but they knew how to ask questions and take names that would one-day cause quite a bit of concern. This, Kevin later said, made him even angrier.

The E.C. monitors were led by a Danish colonel of considerable refinement, who guarded the Danish Queen's palace when he wasn't brokering the war. He was with a French major who liked to talk about chasing the natives across Djibouti in a Jeep, a Canadian Air Force captain who was soon to make major, and a Belgian major who detested the Yugoslavians of every stripe. He liked to say their hobby was murder. He wasn't too far wrong that day.

Moments after the E.C. observers appeared Kevin began marching the bound prisoners toward a truck parked behind the captured house. He hated the monitors, whom he called ice cream vendors because of their all-white uniforms, and he thought the E.C. monitors hated HOS because of its politics. He was convinced they disregarded Serbian and Bosnian atrocities at the expense of the suffering Croatians. The thought angered him and he got all riled up.

On the way to the truck, still quite

drunk, he began interrogating the tiedup Serbian prisoners about the massacre at Skabrnje, asking them in English how they could do such a thing.

Kevin claims one of the prisoners answered in English that he "didn't give a fuck." Kevin, "very calmly" as he described his subsequent actions, responded that he didn't "give a fuck either," and shot all four of them in the head with his pistol, leaving their bodies in a heap behind the house. Unknown to him at the time the Belgian major, whom I would soon meet, watched him do it. Some days later I was wined and dined at lunch in the Zadar Hotel by the E.C. monitors while they interrogated me about what I knew.

"HOS are all murderous bastards," the Danish colonel confided. "After the war they are all going to be imprisoned."

A few weeks later Kevin was severely wounded when a Serb sniper fired a bullet that ignited a 64mm M-80 *Zolja* anti-tank rocket strapped on his back. When the rocket roared out of the tube a fin ripped open his scalp and the fiery engine cauterized the wound in a millisecond. Kevin spent several weeks in the hospital in Zadar before moving in with a Croatian nurse and her husband while he waited for what was to come. He hadn't lost his testy disposition or his need for drink in the meantime, and regularly made his way to the Zadar Hotel.

A "Hero's" "Reward"

Several weeks later, while having a routine chat with his Mum on the telephone, Kevin was informed that British police had been to his house inquiring about him. Kevin's mother told them he was away "on holiday." Kevin claimed the police told her they were holding four murder-warrants for killing the Serbs and one for desertion from the British Army. It was the first time she knew Kevin had deserted.

Kevin claimed she thought he was on a secret mission. His "Mum" said the police asked her to let them know when Kevin got in touch. About the same time Kevin was informed he was being discharged from HOS. He had until the end of March to turn in his uniforms, collect his miserable 80DM monthly pay, and leave Croatia. In return for his service the government gave him a nicely printed letter that detailed his devotion to duty. It would also incriminate him in Great Britain. Somehow it was a fitting memento from the war.

He was supposed to carry the letter

in lieu of identification papers until he left the country. When he was ready to leave, his British passport would be returned to him. Kevin drunkenly claimed the Croatians discharged him as an example to the other mercenaries still fighting. Eventually Kevin and another Brit nicknamed "Mad Dog" – a big, rowdy, loud-mouthed fellow – stole a car and disappeared.

Several months later I was recounting the story of Kevin and 1.4 HOS to Glavis. I was in his office to find out whether it was true his policemen had machined-gunned an elderly Serb couple who didn't want to leave their home. Their bodies were laying out in the yard of their home when I went into his office. Glavis said he didn't know anything about the elderly Serbs.

"Not," he said, "bad things happen in war."

Glavis got in a better mood when I told him about HOS. He laughed heartily at the story of Kevin and the Serbs, assuring me they had deserved no less.

"The Brits are all murderous bastards you know," Glavis said. ▼

to go ahead, we were almost home. Then everything went black. When the smoke had cleared, Cochran told me he had a guy running into the building to our right. I tried to call SSG Miller on the radio but the IED had knocked out my turret power. I was yelling at SGT Cochran to shoot that guy. I looked down into the turret to see what was taking him so long to fire. That was when I saw smoke coming out of the turret floor and SGT Cochran doing just as he had been trained: Cochran was putting the 25mm gun into manual operation so he could fire up the guy that set off the IED on my Bradley.

SSG Miller, being the good Bradley Commander he is, checked his 6 when he heard the IED go off and was turning around to help me out. SGT Cochran fired seven 25mm rounds in manual mode with the hand crank. With no working radio and the thinskinned vehicles we were escorting coming up fast, I had to break off the attack and warn them of the danger ahead. I then had SSG Miller find a

Photos: courtesy Blackhawk bypass for the vehicle we were escorting. Miller and his gunner SSG Kennedy then moved up in support of my Bradley and the rest of the thin-skinned vehicles by putting his Bradley between the IED site and the bypass route. With the help of the USMC and some very talented Marines I had my Bradley up and running in no time at all.

Eyes Have It

That's how I got Purple Heart number 3. I had a cut on my face. If it had not been for the Blackhawk tactical goggles I would have lost my eyesight. The goggles took most of the blast, saving my eyes. I also had on Point Blank body armor and Blackhawk's light assault gloves. The body armor had been hit with most of the shell fragments. I was hit in my right arm and wrist. The Blackhawk gloves protected my hand from the sharp metal with only three pieces going into my right wrist. We later found out that the IED was a 155mm artillery round. That was the first, but not the biggest nor the last, IED that my Bradley would take. After OIF, no one had to tell me that the Bradley is a great combat vehicle — In all, my Bradley had been hit with more than 14 RPGs. I had a lot of faith in my vehicle and the gear that the Army had issued to me, and it would be put to the test less then two months later.

On a night in June I had one section of Bradleys from my platoon on an escort mission. The route would be long but easy, being on blacktop the whole way. We would be on a drop off mission, where we would thinbe escorting skinnød vehicles to another base and then return back to the same base we had left.

The trip would take three hours to get there, and after refueling, another three hours to get back. We were almost half way there when a huge IED went off. The IED had detonated more then 100 meters behind my vehicle. The explosions could be felt by SSG Sowby's Bradley that was a mile ahead of me. Not seeing any insurgents, we kept on our escort-

> ing mission to ensure that we got the job done. After making it to the refuel site I checked out my Bradley and found out that the suspension had been hit hard, and had a lot of oil leaks. The two crews went to work using the Battle Damage Repair Kit (BDRK) that our Troop XO Bret Chastain had gotten for us before we left for Iraq. In less than an hour we had the Bradley up and running. On our way back to our base camp we came upon a USMC Hummer that had been hit in an ambush. The vehicle was still on fire when we got there but it looked like the Marines had made it out

OK. After waiting to see if there were any good guys left around, we took anything we could save off the Hummer and then we watched it burn to the ground so the Insurgent's would not be able to get any pictures to show on the Internet of their night's work.

> Just as dawn was breaking we pulled inside the last gate to our base. Following a quick afterops, we got some much needed sleep. Later that day we did some more repairs and then we took my Bradley out on a test drive. That's when I saw the damage that the IED had done: The left front drive sprocket broke off

and fell on the ground. We later found out that the IED had been made from two 500-pound aircraft bombs. The 38 tons of Bradley had almost given up its life to save my crew. We got the new parts, and with the help of a Marine and his forklift we had her up and running in less then 72 hours.

Iraqis Pulling Their Weight

In late July 2005, I was part of a two-Bradley escort on a resupply run in Baghdad. Less then two miles from our supply point I saw a lot of black smoke up ahead on an overpass. As I got a closer I could see some Humvees set up in over watch of another burning Humvee. If you want to believe that the Iraqis are not helping us in Iraq then just skip down to the next paragraph because you don't want to read this: In less then five minutes Iraqi police officers had the road blocked and a big red fire truck full of Iraqis was on site. The Iraqi firemen had pulled up and were trying to get to the burning truck. The Humvee had been hit by an IED and two of the crew had been lightly injured. With all the firepower on the Humvee, there were a lot of secondary explosions inside the burning truck.

SSG John Williams started moving his Bradley up to the burning truck, slowly so the fire fighters could get close enough to the gun truck to put out the fire. This is just one of many times I saw the Iraqis enthusiastically come out and help U.S. soldiers. In September my platoon started using Humvees. The M1114 is an up-armored gun truck that can be fitted with a Mk 19 40mm grenade launcher, .50 cal machine gun, 240B machine gun or a M249 SAW.

With the change of vehicles, my platoon started working on the east side of Baghdad. My platoon would be working with the 3rd POB (Public Order Brigade). In late October I had my platoon set up in two over watch positions on the river. I had SSG Sowby and SSG Craig set up to the south on top of an old pool house. Gilbert, my Iraqi interpreter, told me about a big old house that I could use that would let me see the other side of the river. After setting up on the roof, my new guy, PFC Trunbull, told me he had movement on the other side of the river. Then we heard a mortar being fired from the other side of the river, at the 3rd POB headquarters. I could see they were firing from behind a wall in some trees. I called my commander for air support and was told it would be a little bit before they could get there.

Po' Boy Artillery

I used my Bushnell laser range finder to get the range — it was over 500 meters. Along with two other soldiers, we each set out four 40mm HE rounds for our M203s. I then told them to aim like I was. I told them to shoot after me in one-second intervals. I fired the first round, then PFC Turnbull fired the second round and then I had SPC Gilspie, better known as Gummy Bear, shoot the last round. In all we would shoot 12 40mm HE rounds.

It's always better to be on the sending end of HE rounds instead of the receiving end. I watched the first round hit almost on top of the mortar team and then every second another HE round hit in the same area. By the time the Apaches got there the mortar was silent. The aircraft could see hot spots on the ground, but could not tell if we had killed any of the insurgents. It would be almost a week before we found out that we had taken out an enemy 81mm mortar team with our M203s, killing three insurgents. Later that night on our way back to base camp, we got a call over the radio to look for a white car that might have emplaced an IED. I had hopped into my Humvee and was heading north looking for the white car. As we were doing this, I heard something hitting the bottom of my truck. I was yelling at my crew, telling them to check their gear.

They still heard something dragging after they told me they were good. I put my hand down to check my pistol and felt an empty holster. I yelled at my driver to stop. Now, having been in the 82nd Airborne, I know how important a good holster and lanyard are. The holster I was using was the Blackhawk special operations holster and coiled lanyard. To say I felt like a jackass is an understatement. I had to go the arms room to get the slide fixed on my M9 Beretta. I also had a Crimson Trace laser on my Beretta. It was knocked all to hell after being dragged under my gun truck for over a mile at 50 mph - but to my surprise, it still worked just like new.

With the IEDs and rocket attacks happening in another part of the squadron's sector, my platoon was moved there to help out. We would set up sniper positions along the route, waiting for the bad guys to emplace IEDs.

PART II: Next time, the battle against insurgents continues. How can a first-class field knife save your butt in a sniper duel? Stay tuned.

They're always the one being choked.

in order to protect the civilian population from Indonesian atrocities. With a cadre of former Portuguese Army NCO's – some of whom had fought the Communist insurgents in Africa, the scratch army of FALINTIL had seized the old Mausers, G3's, HK21's and light mortars left by the Portuguese army.

For two years, the half-millionstrong Indonesian armed forces or ABRI (Angkatan Bersenjata Republik Indonesia – consisting of the Indonesian Army, Navy, Air Force and Police – all of which maintained infantry in East Timor) failed miserably to gain control of the FALINTIL-defended mountainous interior to which the population had fled. With an armed force of over half-a-million men, ABRI forces still struggled to maintain a toehold on the coastal plains for several years. Frequent atrocities against civilians only fortified the resolve of East Timorese

freedom fighters, who maintained control of the interior, to which the East Timorese civilians fled.

After three years, Indonesia's weight of numbers and supporting arms eventually won out. The last brave remnants of

FALINTIL, under the leadership on Nicholau Lobato, were encircled and destroyed on 1 January 1979 – after a six-hour gun battle to the last man, on the blood-drenched mountain of Matabian that came to symbolize the East Timorese' unflinching resistance to terror and oppression.

A Resistance Rises from Oppression

The following year, the FALINTIL survivors and new recruits were reorganized into a highly mobile guerilla strike force, under the leadership of the young charismatic, former seminarian, Alexander "Xanana" Gusmão. Without any foreign aid or military assistance, they became increasingly reliant upon captured Indonesian ammunition and weapons -- Soviet SKSs, AK47s, plus FNCs and M16s. Without any heavy weapons, the East Timorese resistance remained vulnerable to Skyhawk bombers, and helicopter and OV10F Bronco attacks. The few squad automatic weapons they had were carried with fewer than 50 rounds – the only other supporting weapons I saw were a few M203s which lacked ammo.

More than 200,000 East Timorese, or a third of the pre-invasion population, died as a direct result of the Indonesian occupation in the many massacres of civilians, and deliberate starvation in the concentration camps. ABRI used the East Timorese civilians in a massive human shield to flush out the resistance forces in two "Fence of Legs" operations. With the assistance of the

civilian "clandestine" networks – often based around local Catholic church congregations, FALINTIL dug in for a multi-generational war that would last for 25 years, living up to one of their favored war-cries, *A Luta Continua!* (the struggle continues!).

I made my first trip to East Timor in 1995, returning to Australia from a trip home to the U.S., to investigate the truth of the accusations made by East Timorese refugees and their Australian ex-commando supporters. I was living in Perth, Western Australia where I met several 2/2 Commando veterans who spoke vehemently in their support for former comrades now engaged in their own struggle. These veterans were bitterly disappointed by what they saw as a betrayal of their promise to not forget their allies and, though mostly in their late 70s, they spoke of their willingness to take up their Lee Enfields in the cause of East Timorese freedom. What I saw on that first visit shocked me to the core, stirring visions of Nazi and Sovietoccupied Europe. I just could not frame this as anything but a struggle of good versus evil. What sickened me most was the complicity of the Australian Labor Party in this genocide -- putting trade, a fearful "security" policy, and regional politics ahead of principal and soldiers' honor.

I met Ezequiel "Zequito" Fernandes de Oliveira out in the war-ravaged Eastern peninsula. Zequito was the son of a FALINTIL commander and a leader of the local clandestine resistance movement, providing intelligence and support for regional FALINTIL troops led by Commander Lere Anan Timor. This was the FALINTIL unit renowned for the most aggressive military campaigns and audacious raids on Indonesian occupation forces. In hushed discussions with Zequito, constantly looking over our shoulders, on alert for informers and the plain-clothes Kopassus (ABRI's elite red-beret Special Forces unit) that took increasing interest in me, I learned that the East Timorese freedom fighters most needed medicines and medical treatment, communications equipment, and money that could be used to buy black market ammunition from Indonesian conscripts. The son of a U.S. Marine Vietnam Veteran living in Australia, my thoughts turned to military logistics rather than the peace parades and letters of protest typical of most Australians unhappy with their government's betrayal of a former ally. I was also intrigued to learn that their Portuguese G3's, the mainstay of the FALINTIL forces for so long, were mostly cached due to minor breakages and wear. In whatever small way that I could, I wanted to honor that promise of remembering our allies when they need us.

To Fight Another Day


I returned to Australia determined to provide some sort of help to Zequito and his people, with the model of SOF's Refugee Relief International in mind [RRI was sponsored by SOF during the 80s, sending volunteer medical teams and medical supplies to Central America, Afghanistan, Burma and elsewhere.] However, before I could get too far into this daunting project, I learnt that Zequito was on the run, hiding with student friends on the Indonesian island of Bali, targeted by the all-pervasive ABRI death squads. I flew there within days to work up a plan to smuggle him out to safety. At that time, the ruling Australian Labour Party government in Australia was in a bind of their own hypocrisy: While they could not deny that almost any East Timorese citizen that escaped to safety easily met their criteria as a war refugee, they were afraid of offending General Suharto and his ABRI cronies. So, the best I could do for Zequito was to get him into Hong Kong, where he could make his way to the Portuguese colony of Macau and then to Portugal - which was one of East Timor's few staunch supporters in UN and diplomatic circles. The time in Bali, away from the oppressive military scrutiny of occupied East Timor, gave us the opportunity, to develop some plans to give Commander Lere some outside support.

At around this time, we also met Chris, an English rogue-adventurer who claimed to have had his last year of med school interrupted after suffering spinal injuries while aboard the Exocet-struck HMS Sheffield. Though I suspected a fair degree of BS mixed with Chris's true tales of adventure, the opportunity was too good to ignore. We recruited him to provide urgently needed medical aid to the FALINTIL troops

and gave him a clandestine resistance contact in the East Timorese capital of Dili. I was pleased to later read about Chris's successful combat surgery in several syndicated Australian and international broadsheets. Rather than wait for our contact to organize the difficult logistics of infiltrating him into the Eastern region of Los Palos, Chris had tagged along with Australian war correspondent, John Martinkus, who was traveling to interview Commander David Alex and the FALINTIL troops, of the central region outside the sprawling ABRI and Kopassus base at Baucau. Chris successfully completed several operations, mostly involving bullets lodged in troops for many years, in the rough jungle camp. I had hoped to try again to get him into the East, to treat Lere's soldiers.

For Want of a Nail? Here Are Nails

The following year I returned to occupied East Timor. This time, hidden within my luggage, were several small G3 parts kits (firing pins, hammers, extractors, springs, rollers, etc.), communications equipment, cash and medical supplies. My cover story was wearing very thin. I was fortunate that the beautiful daughter of the lodging-




house owner in Dili gave me a quick word in East Timorese to indicate that the guy hanging in the lobby was not a run-of-the-mill keystone Polri cop but an undercover Kopassus soldier. To her horror, I made a beeline to the special forces trooper and, enthusiastically making a new friend, fed him my flimsy cover. Before long, we were exchanging unit badges and professing the eternal brotherhood of the Australian and Indonesian people. Unfortunately in the following weeks my new friend returned several times with his barracks comrades, intent on proving to them that not all Australians despised ABRI and their murderous rape of East Timor.

After a sleepless night hidden in a church outbuilding with the help of the local Salesian priests in Los Palos, I was driven on a winding mountain road while hiding under baskets of putridsmelling fish. We stopped suddenly at an inconspicuous mountain village, where I was hurried out of the minivan, to be met by José – now employed in the Resistance role previously held by Zequito. We quickly moved into the surrounding bush and hiked up a slope better suited to the rugged little Timor-ponies ridden by local farmers.

When we suddenly broke into a clearing under a dense jungle canopy, we were met by Deputy Commander Aluc Descartes and a squad of his veteran fighters. Like most FALINTIL leaders, Aluc (a nom de guerre) is a Timorese veteran of the Portuguese army. He and Lere had both been fighting their enemy continuously for 20 years - always surrounded, and with no safe-havens to fall back to. When I later asked Lere what he would do after victory, he told me that it's more likely it will be his grandchildren's generation who march down Avenue de Lobato in the victory parade. I later drew out of him that he is looking forward to sleeping on a mattress - a luxury of which he has 20-yearold-memories. For now, the weathered veterans and younger recruits sleep in a temporary campsite with their meager possessions in their packs.

Many Hands... Few Arms

Commander Lere explained that every week he was flooded by messages smuggled from the East Timorese youth in the towns and villages, pleading to be allowed to join his guerilla fighters. However, FALINTIL tactics had adapted to the circumstances of the day. There weren't enough rifles for the 200 hundred troops already under his Eastern command. In addition, the resistance leadership council, CNRM, believed that military victory against the ABRI colossus was not the goal. Rather, FALINTIL had become the living symbol of the people's resistance, while the urban clandestine cells had played an increasingly important role in documenting Indonesian atrocities and communicating with the outside world. It is for this reason that Lere flared when I use the term guerilla – which he saw as synonymous with illegitimate, undisciplined and ragged revolutionary bandits. With a veteran's pride in his men, he patiently explained that FALINTIL was the East Timorese national army, supported by the people and answerable to the democratically elected political leaders and that the United Nations did not recognize Indonesia's sovereignty in occupied East Timor.

Keen to experience the life of a FALINTIL fighter, I left the meager shelter of the campsite to join Aluc and his best squad on an extended series of patrols and night ambushes. I was given one of the Portuguese G3's, recently uncached and repaired with the small parts I had smuggled in. I was fortunate that my magazine had 16 rounds in it - many of the troops with Mausers and SKS's have only two or three cartridges. Our daytime patrols are looking for any signs that the red-beret Kopassus hunter-killer patrols were operating in the area. Aluc showed a healthy respect for these elite ABRI troops, preferring not to engage them unless it was unavoidable. Our night ambushes were targeting the small patrols conducted by BRIMOB police militia. A quick and bloody ambush of a BRIMOB patrol returning to the Polri station could net a dozen desperately needed rifles, ammunition, webbing, cleaning equipment, camouflage uniforms, boots, intelligence and other military equipment. I later learned that we were operating on intelligence supplied by an East Timorese clandestine resistance member who had infiltrated the local police battalion.

Laying in the ambush position, clutching the worn G3 and listening to Armageddon erupt around me, I was desperately looking for some sign of my FALINTIL mates who I could only pray were still alongside me. After an apparent eternity, José emerged from nowhere, crawling towards me to tell me to prepare to fall back. I asked a thousand questions at once - all in my sketchy East Timorese, while trying to hide the fear in my voice. José didn't seem to know much more than I, though I was reassured by his implacable faith in the older FALINTIL veterans. Suddenly we were falling back, silently and swiftly. As best we could guess, the enemy column had not detected us, rather that they were either shooting at shadows or experimenting with a new anti-ambush drill. Aluc and the others also insisted that the enemy was around a kilometer away - 10 times the distance I had estimated.

"War Comrades" Who Made A Difference

Back in Australia, I set up The Funu-Maluk Fund. The title comes from a name I heard José using increasingly in reference to me, which literally translates to "war-comrade." With the help of one of the Los Palos priests at the sharp end, and a series of bank-account transfers, I had a secure and verifiable means of getting money into Lere's hands from Australia. I began to carefully advertise the war fund through word-of-mouth among sympathetic groups like the Returned Servicemen's League (RSL) - the Australian equivalent of the VFW. I was also increasingly aware that, if the Australian government chose to, I could be accused of arms smuggling, aiding a foreign military (the odious "mercenary" law) and

identity fraud. At the same time, I worried about the degree of cooperation between Australian and Indonesian spooks.

I had secured a semi-legitimate, alternate identity in Australia to cover some of my activities from ABRI Intel services, but this wouldn't stand-up to the most cursory investigation by Australian authorities. However, I was reassured when I started receiving anonymous tip-off calls providing specific intelligence about Indonesian maneuver battalions, ABRI's strategic planning and the wide-spread support for the East Timorese cause among Australian service-

men and women and the civil service. I suspected that my "deep throat" was a serving member of the Australian SAS, the heirs to the 2/2 Commando's legacy and reluctant allies of Kopassus. While the United States had enacted a total ban on military aid or training to ABRI forces following the 1991 Dili massacre of over 300 mourners in the Santa Cruz cemetery, Australia, under the Labour Party, continued to arm and train the Indonesian military.




And Victory

Following 25 years of struggle, victorious East Timor is now the youngest nation in the UN – thanks in large part to belated 1999 political and military intervention from Australia, under a new conservative government, and the intervention of the United States. Xanana Gusmão was elected in UN-supervised landslide victory, as the first civilian President of free and democratic

East Timor. FALINTIL has been disbanded, replaced by an Australian, Portuguese and American-trained East Timorese Defense Force. The first battalion of the new defense force, armed with U.S.-donated M16A2's and stiffened by FALINTIL cadre, was given to Colonel Lere - who is keen to lead his troops in support of the international War on Terror. With 25 years experience fighting a popular struggle against a dictatorial Islamic oppressor, these loyal allies of the West have proved they can and will stand by us to the bloody end.

Friends will not be forgotten.

2. CHINA ELECTRONIC SPY WAR with Taiwan. Taiwanese surf the web, chat rooms and other electronic means to "spy" on the Chinese Government.

3, INDONESIA FORTY TIME BOMBS found in graveyard.

4. UNITED STATES CONTINGENCY BOMBING CAMPAIGN

planned against Iran, Bunker-buster nuclear bombs such as the B61-11 to destroy a key Iranian suspected nuclear weapons facility are in the plan, according to Seymour Hersh in The New Yorker magazine. SILENT WELCOMING MAT for Chinese President Hu Jintaw ordered. New Scope Proves Worth with Darkhorse Snipers

CAMP MERCURY, Iraq (March 9, 2006) – Marine snipers here put the Corps' latest sniper optic to the test and it proved to be spot-on. Proof is one less bad guy planting roadside bombs.

Snipers of 3rd Battalion, 5th Marine Regiment proved the 3x12 variable-powered Schmidt & Bender M-8541 Scout-Sniper Day Scope's usefulness in January when they killed an insurgent planting improvised explosive devices near Fallujah. It was the first recorded combat kill with the new optic.

"It was kind of a big deal with the sniper community to get the first kill with the new scope," said Gunnery Sgt. Paul Starner, platoon sergeant for the battalion's Scout-Sniper Platoon, who squeezed off the shot. "After the kill, we did a picture-perfect extraction. They didn't even know we were there."

The scope's ability to allow Marines to target insurgents wasn't a one-time stint, though. Marines in the platoon reaffirmed the scope's combat utility seven times since then, according to Starner.

The new scope came into service in November 2005, but the battalion's snipers didn't get them until December, giving the platoon just one month to learn how to use it before the battalion deployed in January. The Schmidt & Bender scope replaced the aging fixed 10x Unertl scope Marines have used for decades.

"Right away, they said to learn on it, train with it, then deploy," said Starner, 33, from Kansas City, Mo.

He said snipers in the Marine Corps had been asking for a variable scope for years, and the new scope was selected from a number of different models through field-testing by Marine sniper instructors in Quantico, Va., last summer.

Not every scout-sniper was initially impressed with the scope. Most of the shooters are tried-and-true gun nuts and convincing these Marines to part with proven products of the past was tough. Still, after seeing it in action, they have a new love.

"I was opposed to this scope for the simple fact that it's metric and most Americans are used to yards," Starner said. "But now that we've got it, launched it and used it, it's an outstanding scope."

He said snipers got around the difference in measurement standards by using a simple formula to convert yards to meters.

"I carry a calculator with me everywhere I go," Starner said. "It's hard to teach an old dog new tricks."

The new Schmidt & Bender allows better positive target identification, according to 2nd Lt. Jake Cusack, Sniper Platoon commander. The Schmidt & Bender scope has a greater Schmidt & Bender joins the Marines!

Schmidt & Bender has agreed with the United States Marine Corps to supply all Scout Rifle Day Scopes for use on the Corps' sniper weapons. A modified version of the Schmidt & Bender 3-12 x 50 Police Marksman LP II scope will become standard equipment on all .308 and .50 caliber USMC sniper rifles.

The Schmidt & Bender scope was selected from products submitted by 25 different companies as the only riflescope to meet or exceed all of the USMC's rigorous specifications.

The Schmidt & Bender scope will include an elevation dial made to USMC specifications. Especially attractive to the Marine Corps is the fact that the 3-12 x 50 PMII LP can be used on both .308 and .50 caliber weapons, with changes only in windage and elevation dials.


While the modified USMC version of the 3-12 x 50 PMII LP is not available to the public, a similar model, including the Gen 2 mil-dot reticle, will be offered in the near future. Many scopes can be retrofitted with the Gen 2, as well.

light-gathering capability, boasting a 50 mm objective lens and illuminated mil-dot reticle pattern, better adapted to drop insurgents at a distance in low light conditions as well as daylight.

"The scope allows them to make more precise adjustments," Cusak explained. "The variable power lets you look at multiple targets or moving targets and pick one then zoom in."

The new scope is more durable than its predecessor, as well. It handles better in the field. Marines are rough on their gear and need equipment that can stand up to bumps and bruises expected in tough combat environments. So far, the new scope demonstrated less risk of losing sight alignment. It held a battle-sight zero through a variety of combat applications.

"With the old scopes, you'd lose the zero if you bumped it," Starner said. "I haven't had any problems with this one keeping its BZO."

"It gives them more confidence in the placement of their shots, even if they've been out operating for a month or so," Cusack said.

That confidence will aid the Marines' mission, providing overwatch for patrols and interrupting IED emplacement in the area.

"On the battlefield we're in right now, the sniper and his rifle is the most precise weapon system available to the commander," said Cusack, 23, from Detroit. "With all of our concerns with rules of engagement, discrimination and engaging targets, the sniper can guarantee that he's applying one 7.62 mm bullet to one very specific target." "We're here to find the enemy and kill him, and that's what we're doing," Starner said. "Any time you make them think twice about what they're doing, you're doing your job. I want it in their heads that we're watching them."

Every Marine in the platoon has at least one deployment under their belts, and all but two are formallytrained snipers.

The match of superior weapons, optics and highly-trained professionals is proving to be a boon for the battalion.

"It's almost unheard of," Starner said. "We're the only platoon in the country with that many schooltrained snipers. I've got numerous honor graduates, Instructor's Choice, all quality Marines, hand-picked."

They are veterans with cool-nerves of steel and practical experience behind their weapons. That spells nothing short of a death sentence for insurgents.

"Tm confident this is one of the most veteran and trained sniper platoons in the country right now," Cusack said. X





In 1935, Harry Carey starred in a Western movie along with Hoot Gibson, Gwinn "Big Boy" Williams and Bob Steele. The movie was called *Powder Smoke Range* and also starred Tom Tyler, as bad guy "Sundown" Saunders. "Sundown" got his moniker because he was nearsighted, and always waited to stage his gunfights at sunset, in order to pull the wool over his opponent's eyes with the light equally dim for both of them. In the movie, Carey and the good guys won.

In 2004, the "sunset" clause of the so-called "assault rifle ban" was allowed to go into effect to the howling and whining of the leftists in Congress. A decade earlier the passage of the ban prohibited such firearm accessories as high-capacity magazines on firearms, flash hiders, threaded muzzles, folding stocks and the "deadly" bayonet lug. In some cases even vertical foregrips were outlawed.

Although not all of these forbidden

fruits of shooting were important, some were. For example, private citizens, who almost never have backup in a crisis incident, were limited to 10-round magazines, while law enforcement officers, who almost always have backup, could purchase high-capacity magazines often holding 20 to 30 or more rounds.

Because of the flash retardants used in modern gunpowder, flash hiders were expendable, but they also served as muzzle protectors. Since the ban prohibited threaded muzzles. more useful muzzle brakes were difficult to install. In reality, folding stocks are of little use, except for transporting shoulder arms, but there was a pitfall. All stocks, which were retractable - whether folding or telescoping - were lumped into this category, but all retractable stocks are not equal.

The retract-

able stock used on the AR-15 Carbine does not fully retract, but has up to six positions used to adjust length of pull. The excellent SOCOM-16 retractable stock from ACE has similar adjustments, as do those from VLTOR, Lewis Tool & Machine and others. Such adjustments are important for those of different builds, to provide for better eye relief, or to allow for thick clothing and heavy body armor sometimes worn by law-enforcement officers. Sure, law-enforcement officers could purchase "pre-ban" style carbines with

signed letter from their chief or sheriff, but many administrators refused to sign such letters, seeing no need for their officers to own such politically incorrect weapons. As you'll see, these feelings did not sunset along with the ban.

Ah, the bayonet lug. For some reason unknown to all reasonable men and women, the bayonet lug was one of the main targets of the assault rifle ban. Since I was 12 years old, I have owned hundreds of rifles with bayonet lugs and many with bayonets to go with them. The only time I attached a bayonet to a rifle was to show a friend, take a picture of it for a story or, on rare occasions, attempt to demonstrate how it was used in extremely close combat. Otherwise, this appendage was and remains useless, except as a normal part of a collector's item.

Yet, the bayonet lug seems to have boiled the blood of gun-hating politicians. The truth is that, except during a running charge, or to repel one, a knife on the end of a rifle is useless. In fact, on a 16-inch barrel AR-15 Carbine it is all but impossible to even mount a bayonet. As with past antigun laws, it was just another grain of sand washed from the foundation of the Constitution.

To the chagrin of the leftists and the joy of free Americans, sunset has fallen on the assault rifle ban. Now we are again allowed to purchase and own high-capacity magazines, folding stocks, flash hiders, threaded muzzles and bayonet lugs. Well, almost.

Not long ago I was asked to help

locate a Colt AR-15 Carbine for a SWAT cop from the Denver Police Department. It seems that the department mandated that all its SWAT cops MUST "have" such a carbine for on-duty use, but did not have the money to purchase them, so made this make and model a condition of assignment. The officer in question also informed me that the carbine could NOT have a bayonet lug. Totally puzzled by this, I said that the model required only came WITH a bayonet lug. He then checked and told me that it

would have to be removed.

I asked the officer why such a rule was in place and he informed me that the Denver Chief of Police would not allow the stigma of any of his officers to use a carbine equipped with such a device. I then asked if he had a vise and a hacksaw. He did, so told him the problem was solved. However, why all the fuss? The chief, probably not in possession of a full compliment of gray matter, wants to remain "politically correct" (people, can't we all just get along?).

So the poor cop who shelled out well over \$2,000 for his carbine, just cut several hundred dollars off its value should he ever sell it. Why? Because Colt wants to be politically correct too, and sunset or no sunset, it will no longer sell pre-ban style carbines or high-capacity magazines to private citizens, nor will Ruger. Thus, while other post-sunset AR-15 style carbines and rifles will again be affordable, original pre-ban Colt guns have become collector's items.

Rock River to the Rescue

the law. One of these is Rock River Arms, with its excellent 100% MilSpec Government Model Carbine and accessories, which are pictured here with the new GripPod vertical foregrip/bipod. Other such firearms companies include Armalite, Bushmaster, DPMS, Knight, LMT, Les Bear, Stag Arms and others.

All of these companies also offer 20- and 30-round AR-15 style magazines, and DPMS just announced its new 40-round magazine, but there's more. Remember the pre-ban 90rounder AR-15 magazine? Well, its back, re-engineered, and better than ever from MWG Co., of Florida. Oh, and don't forget the many autopistol companies again offering magazines holding more than 10-rounds. This means that most of us are free to own them all whether or not we want or need them, and this is the root of it. It matters not whether we ever want to own a semi-automatic carbine with a high capacity magazine, muzzle brake, vertical foregrip and a bayonet lug. What matters is that we want and continue to have the RIGHT to own one!

> Aside from manufacturer bias is that of individual states, such as California and New Jersey, whose gun-hating views rival those of the most totalitarian nations. Even some toy and model guns are prohibited in these states, not to mention virtually all semi-automatic variants of the AR-15, M1A, AK-47 and SKS to name just a few. Then there is the insane prohibition of .50 BMG caliber rifles – even single shot types - that is spreading across the U.S. in the wake of the California ban. Yes, even if the







Are We Defending Our Sovereinty – Or Pulling Up The Ladder?

I was in Paris last November reporting on the alarming immigrant riots and mass demonstrations. I hardly imagined that within a few months we would be witnessing illegal immigrants and their supporters staging the largest demonstrations in U.S. history. 500,000 marchers jammed the streets in Los Angeles, 350,000 to 500,000 in Dallas 3-500,000 in Chicago, just to name a few cities.

Frenchmen in Paris said they had been warning that the lid was going to explode off of the immigration problem that has been building up since the early 1960s when the Algerians, Moroccans, and other citizens of the former French colonies migrated in waves to France. The largest number of immigrants there, legal or illegal, are Muslims.

Americans with whom I spoke while researching an illegal immigration series, including several border patrol agents, were giving the same warnings—that there would be an inevitable uprising of the illegal immigration population if something was not done. Former Governor Richard Lamm of Colorado in an interview went as far as to warn of the destruction of America, largely due to unassimilated immigrants if the problem is not resolved. But I'm not sure anyone expected the eruption so soon, or on such a colossal scale.

Most of the country was stunned by the magnitude of the well-planned turnout. Who were the orchestrators? And how did the situation get so out of hand, that the protestors felt that they could bully U.S. politicians and citizens into getting their way?



Jerry Seper of the Washington Times reports that leaders of one of the key organizers of the protests, Act Now to Stop War and End Racism (ANSWER) formed after 9-11, are tied to the hard core Workers World Party, a Marxist organization that "expressed support for dictators Kim Jong-il of North Korea and Saddam Hussein of Iraq."

Our former law enforcement source confirmed that Marxist literature was displayed openly and being sold during a demonstration in Utah.

The protests are "supported by all the major Mexican organizations including League of United American Citizens (LULAC), National Council of LaRaza (NCLR), and Mexican American Legal Defense and Education Fund (MALDEF)," Team America.org reports. "These groups get funding from corporations and American taxpayers. Elected officials attend their events and accept their awards."

U.S. Patriots Outraged and Offended

The protestors here may not be torching hundreds of cars like they do in France, but protestors were desecrating the U.S. flag in the first cycle of the



demonstrations. To many Americans, those were acts of equal violence.

"Flying OUR FLAG upside-down under the flag of another country is DEPLORABLE!" one outraged retired Lt. Colonel wrote on Newsmax.com

"I watched the 'act of horror and disgust as illegal aliens victoriously waved tens of thousands of Mexican flags, shouted anti-American slogans," he wrote. The protestors put up the Mexican flag over the American flag flying upside down at Montebello High."

Others were threatening to take the U.S. territory back "from the Europeans" or wearing tee shirts that said "Stolen Lands" and carrying signs that said, "You stole it and you know it!!" Some cursed the Alamo.

Outraged citizens bombarded their Senator's offices with faxes and letters demanding blocking amnesty to the illegal population. Grassroots Americans from Pennsylvania, in just one example, reported flooding state senators offices with hundred of faxes and Senate offices in Washington D.C. with more than 130,000 faxes, and countless phone calls before the Easter Recess.

U.S. citizens expressed outrage at the media clips of the brazen show of the Mexican Flag and the desecration of the U.S. Flag. Conservative talking heads broadcast their messages.

The organizers of the pro-illegal immigration protest felt the angry pulse of the American people after the first round of protests at the end of March. "These guys had the demonstrations well planned," a retired Utah Law Enforcement agent who attended two rounds of protests a few days apart at the end of March told us.

"In the second phase of the demonstrations, I saw a truck handing out dozens of flags to the protestors, so we could see American flags that were waved outnumber the Mexican or other country flags."

"A few hours later, the trash cans were filled with discarded American flags," he said.

The volcano had been building up for years, as the streams of illegal migrants turned into a flood. They came by the hundreds of thousands until even official counts, if those mean much, exceeded 11 million. Non-official credible estimates reach 15-18 million. 1.2 million illegal immigrants were apprehended by the border patrol just in the last year and estimates are that the same number made it through.

The year before over one million were arrested, a 25% increase over the year before that.

The mass migration continued in spite of the fact that border patrol agents were increased to over 12,000 from 7,000 after 9-11

Over the last few decades, the problem magnified and took on such an enormous complexity that the immigrant issue may be impossible to fix.


A Tangled Web

One major complication is that thousands of pregnant women sneak across the border to give birth to children on U.S. territory. Therefore, the children automatically become U.S.



citizens. Intermarriage with U.S. citizens became commonplace. In 2005, the Pew Center calculated that in 6.6 million families here, one of the parents was an illegal immigrant. Two thirds of their children, over 3 million, were born as U.S. citizens.

380,000 children are born to illegal parents per year, according to Numbers U.S.A.: "Thousands of pregnant women ready to deliver come to the United States each year from countries as far away as South Korea and as near as Mexico so that they can give birth on U.S. soil. Some come legally as temporary visitors; others enter illegally. Once the child is born, they get a U.S. birth certificate and passport for the child, and their future link to this country is established and irreversible."

Another snag is that countless reckless U.S. companies who have to account to no one really, rely on the cheap labor. Wages as low as \$2 an hour, often paid in cash, enable businesses owners to fatten their own bank accounts.

"Your average illegal immigrant doesn't pay taxes or social security," one law enforcement agent told us. They get paid in cash and the employer doesn't have to pay taxes on their cash earnings. He just writes it off as casual labor. Federal law does not require reporting of income less than \$600 so a lot of these guys get paid as day labor. They come in the next day with a different name or one guy will hire a bunch of other day laborers to help with the job he is hired for. The employer pays cash to the recruiter without knowing the identity of the laborers. No one recognizes these guys as they work the circuit. They also can go buy phony Social Security cards and other forms of ID. They don't pay taxes with those phony cards."

"Dependence on Cheap Labor"

These companies, as well as landlords and other businesses that profit from the illegal immigrants are unwilling to give up the cheap illegal immigrant labor. Ten million illegal aliens are on their payrolls in one form

or another each year. The owners of the companies lobby and contribute to politicians who waffle when any crises to address the illegal immigrant problem arises.

The level of abuse of illegal immigration reaches the obscene. The complicity of public and law enforcement officials is often subtle.

Take the case that National Public Radio reported in April of a few Japanese restaurants owned by Chinese and Taiwanese U.S. citizens in Baltimore, for example. The owners drove Mercedes and lived in up scale houses in the suburbs. They could have hired U.S. citizens, but they imported poor Indonesians, Chinese, El Savadoreans, put them in small seedy rooms on dirty mattresses and paid them \$2 an hour.

The illegal immigrants "weren't in a position to complain," according to prosecutors.

The Mayor of Baltimore, his wife and the former police commissioner frequented the restaurants.

The problem according to the Prosecutor? U.S. dependence on cheap labor.

In Fear of the Activists

The Bush 41, Clinton and Bush 43 administrations as well as agencies and legislators under their guard didn't dare take action for fear of loosing financial and political backing.

Fed up, frustrated citizens on both sides of the debate have taken matters

into their own hands.

The Minutemen who organized informal patrols at the border were splashed all over the news since they started operating.

Their opponents joined them to 'monitor' obstruct or berate them.

As the illegal immigration debate got hotter and hotter, the Congress was finally forced to act. Their proposals were all over the place, do we give amnesty? Do we build a wall? Do we send all the illegal immigrants back? Of course all of those proposals had to be filtered through the poll barometers.

A former border patrol chief told us that the 1986 amnesty which legitimized three million illegals, had not only failed, it was an invitation for Illegal immigrants to come over and if they hung on long enough, some other administration would cave. The threats authorities made to prosecute those hiring illegal immigrants were hollow according to the agent.

Last year, the House passed a bill proposing a 700-mile fence along one third of the Southern border. Illegal aliens would be classified as felons and those smuggling them in or trafficking illegal immigrants could face felony charges. Non Mexican illegal immigrants would be automatically detained when entering the United States. Those who trafficked them in would be put in jail. Carried to an extreme, those who aided them would also face felony charges. Employers would have to access a Social Security database within six years or face prosecution

Opponents to the bill began to mobilize.

Leaders of the Roman Catholic Church, including Cardinal Roger M. Mahony, archbishop of Los Angeles joined the loud protestors. The Church leaders could be faced with felony charges.

Cash Cow Expats

A panicked Mexican President Fox called the proposal to build a fence everything from "stupid" "disgraceful" and "shameful," to a violation of human and labor rights. He made it clear that the illegal migrant 'heroes' would find ways to cross the border. He had been helping them all along, allowing flyers guiding the migrants to circulate in Mexico.

In 2005, legal and illegal immigrants from Latin America and the Caribbean sent home \$45 billion in remittances, \$17 billion of that to Mexico.

Illegal Immigrants Flood a Marine Corps Base By Dr. Martin Brass

SOF was in Yuma Arizona on the Marine Corps Air base and in San Diego when some of the largest demonstrations in U.S. history, including 500,000 demonstrators in Los Angeles and Chicago, erupted.

"In my opinion, the illegal immigrants stream through the Marine bases and jeopardize the security here. Some could die accidentally when they wander onto the shooting ranges during live fire exersizes or simply from the horrible heat and no water," a Marine Sergeant told us as we gazed over the vast barren desert to the Mexican border in April.

Marines Loose Over Six Months Training in One Year

Marines lost over 1,100 hours of training time in 2004 because illegal immigrants wandered onto a bombing test range in Arizona Col James J. Cooney, the base's commanding officer told the *Boston Globe*.

"That's equivalent to almost 46 days of training. We're getting overrun here," he said in an interview. "Any moment we take away from a Marine's experience base could cost him his life in combat."

Marines intercepted more than 1,500 undocumented immigrants on the training range in 2004, and more than 1,100 the first three months of 2005.

The Marines told us that they worry about the safety of the illegal aliens.

Col. Clooney told the *Globe* "We just don't want them to come here, because we're firing lasers, we're shooting machine guns, we're shooting 209-millimeter cannons, and we're dropping practice bombs, and we don't want to hurt anyone."

Illegal Trespassers Could Cost Life Saving Training Time

"My overall concern is that we'd have an unfortunate incident out there where we'd inadvertently harm an illegal entrant that we did not spot or see, and that in turn would cause a moratorium on training until we sorted out what exactly happened," Cooney told the paper.

The street protests became front page news in all the local journals and a major topic of conversation for the locals. Arizona and California have been hit hard by the illegal immigration problem.

The financing for the border officials, jails, other law enforcement and health care triggered a financial crisis for the border counties, USA Today reports.

Federal reimbursement, including an increase of federal detention cells from 18,000 to 20,000 doesn't even begin to pay the cost to the states.

Arizona's four border counties asked the federal government for \$23.2 million last year to cover the cost of jailing thousands of illegal immigrants. They were reimbursed \$731,000.

State officials under enormous pressure from their constituency had to act while politicians were wringing their hands over the last few years as illegal immigrants flooded their states. The governors of California and Arizona declared emergencies and ordered more National Guardsmen to patrol the border.

Congress did approve a fence for San Diego County in 1996. San Diego residents told us that they thought that the

fence had done some good, but so many Mexicans had already streamed in that they didn't notice too much difference.

Although the fence did reduce the trafficking of migrants and drugs, the smuggling and migrating simply shifted to Texas and other border states. How surprising.

In San Diego in 2005 126,910 illegal immigrants were apprehended in this sector, according to the border patrol, compared with a peak of 629,650 in 1986, according to USA Today.


Still, San Diego County, California spends \$50 million a year to arrest, jail, prosecute and defend illegal immigrants, and is reimbursed about \$2 million, Supervisor Greg Cox, president of the Border Counties Coalition told USA Today. That is a \$48 million dollar hit that takes funds from libraries, parks and public safety.

Border Patrol agents have doubled to over 600 in the last few years. Border Patrol stations are prevalent on the highway from San Diego to Yuma and the surrounding area.

But the illegal immigrants keep on streaming through the vast unmanned desert border. \Re

Interesting, coming from a president whose policy is to put Mexico's illegal immigrants into a detention center then fly them back home.


He invited officials from Belize, Guatemala, El Salvador, Honduras, Nicaragua, Costa Rica, and Panama as well as Colombia, Ecuador, and the Dominican Republic to meet on three occasions to figure out how they could bully the United States if the House bill proposing a fence passed in the Senate.

They met in Mexico City, in Guatemala and Colombia From January to mid-March, trying to figure out which US politicians and senators they could pressure.

Loud, massive, relentless demonstrations were in the works.

In the meantime, politicians facing reelection noticed polls such as Zogby that showed over 60% of Americans want stricter immigration laws and enforcement.

A Bipartisan Senate Judiciary Committee proposed granting work permits and a road to citizenship to the millions of illegal immigrants. Those

who lived here for over five years would have a good chance at citizenship and supposedly those who have lived here for less than two years don't have much of a chance.

A guest worker program for a million and a half farm workers was proposed.


The Pro illegal immigration crowds cheered.

The convoluted Senate Judiciary Committee proposal included:

• 7-8 million illegal immigrants who have been here more than five years would receive a renewable work visa. They would have to pass a criminal background check, pay two \$1,000 fines and be required to learn English before they could apply for citizenship.

• The approximately three million illegal immigrants who have been here for two to five years could go back across the border and apply for one of the 450,000 green cards issued yearly.

• The unskilled laborers are the lucky ones because they would get 300,000 of the green cards. The rest of the unlucky illegal immigrants, that number approximately two million *Continued on page 74*

Utah Hit Hard By Illegal Immigration

By Dr. Martin Brass

"This is our continent, not yours! This is stolen land!" Illegal Immigrant's T-shirts blatantly defied their host countrymen.

"Take it back! Yes we can! You guys are Europeans, we're the original owners," these illegal immigrant protestors were taunting us during the largest public demonstration in Utah history, held at the Salt Lake City County building at the end of March," a retired law enforcement agent told us.

"When I asked what their chant, 'take it back' meant, they laughed at me," he said. "I'm not sure what it means, but it seems to me that

it means that they are talking about America.

"The mass demonstration was extremely well organized and controlled. The spontaneous demonstration—the first one here—blocked the streets for hours and angered many residents because 90% plus of the flags displayed were Mexican flags and those of other countries.

"They were waving their Mexican Flags in our faces. I was watching Mexicans by the thousands waving Mexican flags in front of the Utah courthouse."

The pro-immigration crowd has learned from their mistakes. One speaker was calling for people to come forward to register to vote. She belatedly added that only U.S. citizens should do so.

Oops, Sorry You Oidn't Like What We Really Wanted To Do

"But during the second demonstration a few days later, the organizers were handing out American flags left and right. I guess they heard about how outraged we were when they carried the Mexican Flag during the first protest.

"They were just manipulating the press. A few hours later I saw hundreds of flags thrown in the trash," he said.



The largest public demonstration in Utah history was held at the Salt Lake City County building. The anti-illegal protestors were outnumbered 100-1. 250 protested against illegal immigration while 25,000 demonstrated for open borders.

Illegal Immigrants Welcomed to Vote

"I saw her, I heard her," he said," this woman was recruiting the protestors to sign up for voter registration. There must have been 10,000 that signed up.

"They say that there has never been a case of any undocumented worker voting in the United States. I called a federal agent friend who said they have had hundreds of them,"

We called the same agent who requested anonymity.

"Salt Lake County auditors were performing cursory audits on motor voter registrations at the Department for Motor Vehicles. They screened out people with bad SS numbers, 9,000 individuals in all who had false ID numbers for voting. Those didn't get to

vote because the clerk's office detected the fraud.

"That information is not available to the general public," he said. "But some of it is. Go to the Utah State Auditor's page on the internet. Two years ago they audited 100,000 drivers licenses and found fifteen that registered to vote when they applied for an Individual Tax Payer ID number to pay their taxes. They use that ID to apply for drivers licenses and bank accounts because it is a valid national ID.

They Stream Into Utah by the Thousands

"I spoke with a high federal law enforcement official," the retired official said. "There are five to ten times more than normal illegal immigrants streaming across the border as we speak.

"They all have receipts and documents that say they have been here for five to ten years-motel receipts, rent receipts, other receipts phonied up. They *Continued on page 79*



who have been here for less than two years would have to leave.

"Right. As if anyone could figure how long an illegal immigrant had been here," a law enforcement agent in Georgia told us.


'These guys get hotel receipts, rent receipts, and all sorts of other forged receipts proving they had been here for a long time," he said.

We Want It All

But the pro immigration folks didn't like the part of the proposal that calls for securing the border from future masses of illegal migrants.

They especially didn't like the proposal to hire 12, 000 more border patrol agents, doubling the current numbers and the proposition to build a "virtual fence" with high tech unmanned aerial vehicles, sensors and cameras. The requirement for foolproof identification that could not be forged or doctored up was also unacceptable.

Illegal immigrant employers especially didn't like the part of the plan that would require them to request legitimate documents or they would face



penalties.

Critics, including outspoken Colorado Republican Congressman Tom Tancredo decried the "miserable", totally impractical, convoluted policy an administrative nightmare.

Throughout the Congressional and Senate drama and theatrics, hundreds of thousands of illegal immigrants and their supporters who are not going to settle for anything less than citizenship, work permits, and open borders, were setting the stage for action.

At the end of March they took to the streets in hordes. They hit the pavements again in April.

The Congress is on recess at the time of this writing. Nothing has been resolved.

No telling how long the series of demonstrations is going to last, or how violent they will become. Gov. Lamm's warnings of how an uncontrolled illegal immigration policy with tens of millions of unassimilated, undocumented immigrants could lead to the destruction of America have taken on a sense of urgency. \aleph



come up with anything they think will meet the standards of the latest proposal that if they can prove that they have been here for five years, they can apply for citizenship."

"I've worked with lots of Border Patrolmen," the former law enforcement agent said. "I've got supreme respect for nearly all of them. They do a great job when allowed to, but they are frustrated.

"Several years ago in a joint task force briefing, a border patrolman asked what they should do if a car ran their roadblock.

"Just let them go," the supervisor stated.

"They are overworked and understaffed. The week after 9-11, I put on a briefing for several law enforcement agencies on the New Mexico/Mexico border. I asked the Border Patrol station chief how many agents, cops, deputies, or state police officers were within twenty miles of the 86-mile long border at that moment. The answer was—two.

"The newest Border Patrol policy is deterrence. Stay in one highly visible place, let them see you, save gas!

"Four years ago, 82% of the homicides commited in Salt Lake City were committed by illegal aliens. This used to be a pretty calm place. COMMON SENSE

Looking For Leadership

BUCHAREST, Romania – We came here to film a World War II documentary for FOX News and came away with a lesson in leadership.

This capital was once at the far edge of the Roman Empire. After "The Great War," it was known as the "Paris of the East." During World War II, the city was hit by both American and German bombs – and abandoned behind the "Iron Curtain" at war's end.

For nearly five decades, Romanians endured Stalinist repression. Bullet holes in buildings at city-center attest to the fury of their 1989 revolution, which bought freedom with blood. Today, the metropolis is teeming with sky cranes, heavy-duty investors, upscale hotels, classy boutiques, car dealerships and glistening new shopping malls with full parking lots. Yet, for all the modern appurtenances, it is also a city that bears the scars of what can happen when great powers fail to act greatly.

Romania's deposed monarch, King Michael – the sole surviving head of state from World War II – kindly granted us a lengthy interview for our "War Stories" series. What he and his people endured in the last century should serve to remind today's leaders of the horrific price paid when despots bent on tyranny go unchecked.

On Tuesday, when Mahmoud Ahmadinejad – the wild-eyed, anti-Western, genocidal zealot who runs Iran – announced that the Islamic Revolutionary Republic had successfully enriched uranium, people here in Romania began asking us, "What will America do to keep Iran from building a bomb?"

It's an understandable question in this East-West crossroads, where history has been such a tough teacher. For more than three years before Adolf Hitler plunged Europe into world war, no one did anything that mattered to prevent it. Winston Churchill's warnings went unheeded by Great Britain, France and the United States. Cases of Japanese, Italian and German aggression were referred to the League of Nations – which dithered and did nothing. When the bloodletting began in earnest, Romanian dictator Ion Antonescu allied his country with the Axis because he believed Hitler would win. It was a disastrous decision.

By the summer of 1944, hundreds of thousands of Romanians were dead, wounded or prisoners of the Red Army. In August, young King Michael organized a coup, overthrew the fascists and joined the Allied cause. He begged for British or American help to save his country from the Soviets – only to learn that President Franklin Roosevelt had already decided not to oppose Stalin's plans for invasion and occupation.

Historians ought to be loathe to play "what if" with the facts of the past. But present day events beg the questions: What might have happened if the United States, Britain and France had stood together in 1936 and insisted that Hitler cease rearming? In March of 1938, would the Fuhrer have desisted from his Austrian Anschluss if the United States had stood in opposition? Could Romania, now a NATO ally, have been spared a half-century of repression? King Michael put it this way: "If only Roosevelt had told Stalin 'no' – we would have been spared."

Like the events of the 1930s and '40s, Ahmadinejad's quest for nuclear weapons is a situation that cries out for resolute American leadership. Last week's announcement was made in front of a full bank of television cameras and the world media. The Iranian leader portrayed it as an achievement – a source of national pride – and went on to warn that any attempt to prevent their nuclear progress would "cause an everlasting hatred in the hearts of Iranians."

The next day, Ahmadinejad said: "Our answer to those who are angry about Iran achieving the full nuclear fuel cycle is just one phrase. We say: Be angry at us and die of this anger."

Until now, the United States has punted the question of Iranian nukes to the United Nations and the Europeans. They have failed. For three years, the British, French and Germans have tried negotiations. But in January, the Iranians walked away from the talks. In the aftermath of Ahmadinejad's chest-thumping, Secretary of State Condoleezza Rice said that "the Security Council will need to take into consideration this move by Iran ... to make certain that we maintain the credibility of the international community on this issue." She is wrong. The international community has no credibility on this issue.

The U.N. Security Council has given Iran a deadline of April 28 to halt its enrichment process. But International Atomic Energy

Agency chief Mohamed El Baradei, speaking in Tehran last week, said that there is "no great urgency in this new development." When America's U.N. Ambassador John Bolton suggested a Security Council resolution under Chapter 7 of the organization's charter, Russian ambassador Andrei Denisov said, "There is no reason for punitive measures yet."

How close is Iran to actually building a nuclear weapon? Stephen Rademaker, the assistant secretary of state for international security and nonproliferation, said it could take as little as 16 days. Other analysts believe it could take as long as 10 years. Assuming that the longer estimate is correct is both irresponsible and arrogant. India, Pakistan and North Korea all built bombs before anyone believed they could.

We can no longer afford to deal with Tehran through intermediaries and third parties. The United States must open direct, frank discussions with the Iranians – to convince them, like Libya, that it is not in their interest to continue the pursuit of nuclear weapons. The United States has a full quiver of diplomatic, financial, trade and military options. Carefully and quietly articulating these to Iran is a high-risk strategy – but not as dangerous as hoping that others will do what needs to be done. \Re




