Long May It Wave Over Yer Condo!

President Bush has signed into law a bill that would bar condominium and homeowner associations from restricting how the American flag can be displayed. Sponsored by Rep. Roscoe Bartlett, R-Md., it would prohibit those groups from preventing residents from displaying an American flag on their own property. It was passed unanimously by both the House and the Senate.

"Americans have long flown our flag as an expression of their appreciation for our freedoms and their pride in our nation," Bush said in a statement. "As our brave men and women continue to fight to protect our country overseas, Congress has passed an important measure to protect our citizens' right to express their patriotism here at home without burdensome restrictions."

BOHICA: Another VA Computer Missing...

Hot on the heels of the safe recovery of the stolen laptop containing veterans' personal information, The Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) announced that a computer was missing from the "secure" Reston, Va., offices of the subcontractor Unisys Corporation, hired to assist in insurance collections for VA's medical centers in Pittsburgh and Philadelphia.

The VA's Inspector General, the FBI and local law enforcement are conducting a "thorough investigation of this matter," including just what information the computer may have held. VA believes the records involved are limited to people who received treatment at the two Pennsylvania medical centers during the past four years. It is believed the desktop computer may have contained patients' names, addresses, Social Security numbers, dates of birth, insurance carriers and billing information, dates of military service, and claims data that may include some medical information.

Initial estimates indicate the desktop contained information on approxi-

mately 5,000 patients treated at Philadelphia, approximately 11,000 patients treated at Pittsburgh, and approximately 2,000 deceased patients. VA is also investigating the possibility the computer may have contained information on approximately another 20,000 people who received care through the Pittsburgh medical center. 🕅



Hell House

Where Fallujah's Fanatics and Foreign Fighters Fought To The Finish, Part I

A l Fajr means "New Dawn" in Arabic. At Fallujah, Iraq in November of '04 it also meant death to more than 3,000 Iraqi insurgents and foreign fighters who dared take on the The saga of First Sergeant Brad Kasal and men of the Thundering Third was first told in the May, 2005 SOF. Now here's the rest of the story of heroism in that knock-down, drag-out battle that resulted in more than one participant receiving the Marine Corps' second-highest medal for valor.

Ist Marine Division in a toe-to-toe, no-quarter contest historians consider to be the fiercest battle the United States Marine Corps has fought since its epic struggle for Hue, South Vietnam in 1968. Central to that battle is the growing legend of "Hell House," the still-emerging story of an unlikely charnel house where three Marines fought together to carry the day.

The most famous of the trio at Fallujah on 13 November 2004 was 38-year old 1st Sergeant Bradley Kasal, an iconoclastic Marine thanks to a photographer named Lucian Read. Read caught him on film

being helped out of the infamous building still brandishing his M9 pistol, after being shredded by grenade fragments and shot full of holes saving other Marines. With him at the Hell House was a tightly wrapped



24-year-old former

Lance Corporal named Robert Joseph "R.J." Mitchell and former Lance Corporal Alex Nicoll, an absolutely irrepressible 22-year-old Marine who got his kicks walking point and engaging hajji up close and personal.

At Fallujah, Alex and R.J. were in

the same squad in 3rd Platoon, Kilo Company, Third Battalion, 1st Marines, generally known as the "Thundering Third." Kasal was the First Sergeant of Weapons Company, 3/1, a position that allowed him to be in the rear with the gear. That, however, was never Kasal's way. On 15 May 2006 Sergeant Major Kasal received the Navy Cross for his incredible heroism at Fallujah.

Despite Kasal's well-deserved fame, he was not the only hero of that fight, he says. He claims Mitchell, among many others, was the real hero at Hell House.

"I did what I had to do because it is called survival and the right thing to do. And I had no choice in the matter. Sergeant Mitchell, however, voluntarily ran through enemy fire and joined us in a room that was sealed off from rescue and covered by enemy fire, to try and help us. He is the true hero," Kasal insists.

The Marine Corps agreed. Before he left the Marine Corps, Mitchell was meritoriously promoted to Sergeant. On 28 July 2006, Mitchell received the Navy Cross at Camp Pendleton, California for his heroic actions in the same fight that Kasal earned his award. The lives of the three Marines are so intertwined that their stories are actually one brave tale, a remarkable

saga that one day will undoubtedly be a chapter in the Great Book of Marine Corps heroes, legends, and lore.

Their unique relationship was cemented in March, 2002 when Kilo Company, 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines was deployed to Iraq as part of "Operation Iraqi Freedom." Mitchell was a lance corporal and future squad leader of 2nd Squad, 3rd Platoon of Kilo Company and Nicoll was a wild young rifleman who would one day be in Mitchell's squad. At the time Kasal was the First Sergeant of Kilo Company and well known as a tough, uncompromising professional infantryman with 18 years humping rucks and pushing troops.



When Operation Iraqi Freedom kicked off, Kilo Company, 3/1 drove up Highway 8, helped open "Ambush Alley" during the vicious bridge fights at An Nasiriyah, ran the deadly roads to Baghdad, and concluded the war sitting it out in the capital city savoring the notion they were saviors and liberators. By the end of the first six-month combat deployment Kasal knew both men were particularly fine fighting Marines, he says.

Sixteen months later it was June, 2004 and 3/1 was on its second deployment to Iraq. A lot of things had changed, Mitchell says. Kasal was now the First Sergeant of Weapons Company, 3/1, Mitchell was a corporal and 2nd Squad leader in 3rd Platoon, and Nicoll was in his squad. For more than five months the Thundering Third was stuck in al Anbar Province, the epicenter of the Sunni rebellion where foreign fighters flocking into Iraq from Syria and Jordan were controlled. Before 3/1 was finished with its second deployment in March, 2005 it would fight foreign fighters from 18 countries in the bleak confines of al Anbar, Mitchell says.

Waiting for War

By all accounts al Anbar province is a tough place to be: 3/1's Marines would suffer more than 100 casualties in the five months before they at-




tacked Fallujah. It was an ugly war, Mitchell says.

3/1's Marines fought it out with the insurgents and always-dangerous foreign fighters in a daily grind of patrols, ambushes and guard duty. The occasional firefights were small, quick affairs, and the real terror came from Improvised Explosive Devices, mortars, rockets, suicide bombers, snipers, and diabolical ambushes that left the Marines punching empty air, Nicoll says.

In the 130-degree heat the Marines were getting down right hostile, Mitchell concluded. "They either wanted to go home or fight, but this stuff in [al] Anbar Province was getting everybody's morale down."

"I wanted to fight something," Nicoll added. "We all wanted to fight something. They gave us no rules of engagement in [An] Nasiriya and every dog, chicken, and moving object we saw was likely to be engaged."

To pump up morale for the upcoming fight, its dynamic battalion commander Lt. Col. Willie Buhl organized a festival of sorts two days before the looming battle to loosen the men up a bit, he said. The theme was Ben Hur and the showpiece entertainment was a chariot race using captured Iraqi horses. Nicoll was chosen by Buhl to dress up like a barbarian and stir up the crowd. Nicoll gave an impromptu speech he modeled after Mel Gibson's roaring tome of defiance in the movie Braveheart. It all came together when Nicoll raised his arms and displayed his tattoo urging "Bring the Violence"

that called out in giant black letters from across both his triceps. In one hand Nicoll held a massive war club made from an aluminum baseball bat and spikes and in the other was a huge sword cut from the armor of some unlucky doggie's Humvee. The

Marines went wild, Buhl says.

"Some Army guy was running around complaining he didn't have any armor on his Humvee," Nicoll remembered. "I needed it for my sword. I had to look good for the Marines. My guys worked hard getting my costume together. When we started out I just had a sheet."

All too soon the frivolity was over and it was time for war. On 7 November 2004, 3/1 joined about 22,000 Marines and soldiers attacking Fallujah, which before the conflict was

a predominantly Sunni city of almost 140,000 structures that needed to be cleared of al Qaeda, al Zarqawi and all the other murderous jihadists looking for martyrdom.

The attack officially began 7 November on so-called "D-Day," but 3/1 with a few exceptions sat it out on the north end of Fallujah waiting for the big play to start 36 hours later. For 24 hours Mitchell said he watched red phosphorus rain on the city like red sparklers turning everything beneath it the color of thin blood. It was an ominous, exciting beginning, he said.

"They were firing 120mm Army mortars, 155mm guns, eighty-ones, everything. They fired for 24 hours straight. They fired a lot of red phosphorous; it looked like red sparklers falling from the sky," Mitchell recalled.


Finally Getting It On

On D+3 the bulk of the Thundering Third finally moved out. It was 0500 and false dawn was upon the city. In the dim light of the waning darkness Kilo Company moved south into the city using lanes breached through Iraqi obstacles by Marine engineers. Behind them was the hulking Fallujah train station, captured the night before by 2nd Lt. Zachary Iscol and about 50 Weapons Company, 3/1 Marines advising a company of Iraqi National Guard troops chosen to make the attack. They were supported by Lima Co, 3/1, who stayed behind.

"I remember getting into the city with relative ease," Mitchell recalls. "Regardless of who was doing what or where, from the attack position it was one hell of a sound and light show," Mitchell says.

It was early morning on the 9th of November when Kilo crossed into the city proper. About 30 minutes later Mitchell's squad began taking fire from a bunker on a rooftop of a house to the west. Although one of Weapon's Company's Combined Armor Anti-tank Team sections (CAAT) teams was with their squad, the buildings were too densely spaced for them to take a shot with a TOW, Mitchell recalls.

"The CAAT squad with their heavy (.50 cal. M2) machine gun and TOW missile could not maneuver into a position to take out the bunker, which had the road intersection in front of



us covered by fire. That was when Lance Cpl. Steve Segura got killed. I still don't know exactly how it happened, but I guess his squad started flanking, but got hit from the flank as they did. From what I heard Steve got hit between his [SAPI] plates as he was trying to kill the fucker that shot him," Mitchell remembers.

"As soon as that happened we all started in earnest. No one cared from then on. If you were a military-aged male in the city, you were a threat, and threats don't live," Mitchell said.

"With me personally... these guys were trying to kill me, [so] I wanted to kill them."

Nicholl took it even more personally, he says. "Every sonofabitch I shot was standing right in front of me."

How they fought remained the same for the next four days, Mitchell says. During the day they cleared buildings and fought short duels with Iraqi insurgents who didn't have a lot of stomach for fighting Marines. Nobody surrendered; it wasn't in the cards, Nicoll agrees. Although Kasal was now in Weapons Company he was always close by, Mitchell says. The situation pleased 3rd Platoon, especially Third Platoon leader 1st Lt. Jesse Grapes, he says. Kasal had been his first sergeant for a long time and the two meshed the way true warriors will. Kasal didn't plan it that way, he said, but circumstances prevented him from linking up with his other CAAT sections.

No No-Knock Here!

The day before they encountered Hell House the fighting was particularly intense. The Marines took to firing their SMAWs (Shoulder-Launched Multipurpose Assault Weapon) with the new thermobaric warheads called the SMAW-NE for "Novel Explosive" to clear buildings before they went inside. They used a technique called "key holing" that began with a conventional SMAW to blow a hole in the thick walls of the target structure, then a SMAW-NE to incinerate anyone inside. It was part of Kilo's unofficial policy to never enter into a building without throwing in something that exploded, Grapes said.

"The day before we got hurt was probably crazier than the day we got hurt. Any time there would be something First Sergeant would be there," Nicoll says. "He was the only one [senior NCO] I ever saw out there. For the last two days we had been walking side by side. First Sergeant called me up and wanted me to go point for him."

That fight began when Mitchell, Kasal, Nicoll, Cpl. Francis Wolf, and Lance Cpl. Samuel Severtsgard teamed up to clear a house full of insurgents. It occupied a location that was impossible to approach without being seen. Mitchell was in charge, Nicoll said.

The Marines ended up pinned down. Mitchell took a round through the fleshy part of his right arm. Mitchell called it the "perfect wound" because it went through so fast it didn't even hurt and the heat cauterized it so it didn't bleed, Mitchell says. He *Continued on page 75*



...In Which A Perfectly Good Second Tour Is Compromised By A Couple Of Irish Hooligans And Topped By A Bunch of Cherries...

At the time of the Vietnam War, MACV-SOG (Military Assistance Command Vietnam – Studies and Observations Group), was one of the lesser-known of the many open secrets associated with that conflict. After an afternoon of in-processing, we are assigned a barracks and the time is ours. I am lying on the bunk in the transient barracks as Bernie comes bustling through the door with a pleased look on his face and a net bag full of tepid Ba Mi Ba beers in the heavy gauge 14 oz. glass bottles. You get an extra two ounces of beer with the added bonus that the bottle, empty or full, is the perfect tool for adjusting the headspace on the odd marine or sailor who wants to get froggy.

He plops down in the bunk opposite from me and grins that lopsided, wiseass grin that the Irish have perfected over the centuries. He pulls out two bottles from the bag, hands me one, then pulls out a CO2 fire extinguisher that is obviously missing from someone's wall bracket and sprays the beers liberally. Voila! Instant, chilled beer. I take a long slow pull, relishing the sharp tang of the beer and the ambience of brewing that uses formalde-

hyde in the aging process. It gives you a heady hangover, but it is still better than that swill, Black Label.

"I went over to see if we got orders yet," Bernie starts and then smiles. I smell the conspiracy coming. "The Infantry guys managed to poach a couple of the new kids and they had us on orders to go to the Big Red One."

I know tragedy hasn't overcome us because he is in a really good mood. The Big Red One is the 1st Infantry Division. With our ranks, had we been shanghaied, we would end up as platoon sergeants. The proud members of this division put the emphasis on the last word in their nickname; those of us who never want to set foot in it put the emphasis on the second word, "red." I'm waiting patiently for him to lay out the masterful stroke of wheedling and scheming that he has accomplished in order to save us from a fate worse than death.

NEVER VOLUNTEER

He takes a long pull on his beer, belches, and then continues. "I ran into one of the E-8s that run the admin section. He was in Germany with me in '58. I was his platoon sergeant and he was a Davy Crockett crewman.

"Anyway, he owes me a few favors, so he tells me that the only way to get up to Nha Trang, to Group Headquarters is either know God and have him protect you from the press gangs from the infantry or take a voluntary to an outfit called CCN."

I am beginning to feel queasy about this. For sure the guy he is talking to is another Mick and there is only one group that can outdo them in messing each other over and that's attorneys. And if I remember rightly, the Davy Crockett System was a jeep-mounted device that fired a huge projectile, like a foot in diameter, which was a nuclear warhead. I'm beginning to sweat because he says, "I got us both on orders to go up to Da Nang and," he pauses, "I was able to get all those cherries freed from their infantry assignment as well. They are going with us."

LIFE IS A BOWL FULL OF CHERRIES

Suddenly I am fully alarmed. My warning bells are ringing and my memory banks are starting to wind up. This is starting to smell like bad, bad news. It's obvious that this is an SF assignment, because anything that will get you away from the Division press gangs has to have some heavy priority on it. Add to that the fact that the cherries were able to get on the list, and the little voice in the back of my head is screaming, "Uh-oh," in big red letters.

Bernie is obviously pleased with himself and doesn't want to hear that if the assignment can spring guys right out of the infantry press gangs, it's got to have some major priority, With priority come bad operations, lots of people shooting at you, helicopters and jets falling out of the air, and lots of folks going home with missing parts or in body bags. This is not good. I reach over and liberate another beer from the bag and lower its body temperature with the fire extinguisher. Bernie is still rattling on about how lucky we are. This will be a real combat assignment, nothing but SF brothers, blah, blah, blah. I'm beginning to suspect that the O'Reilly in S-1 had some sort of grudge against Bernie. Maybe Bernie was slapping leather to the guy's wife in the distant past and now it was payback time. I

can see him grinning like a shark as he types up our orders. Hail Caesar, we who are about to die....

I come back from nightmare land with Bernie saying, "Geez, you look a little pale, brother. Maybe you need to take a cold shower, get acclimated..." I'm spinning in a vortex of bad vibes and suddenly realizing why the Irish end up in every front line outfit since King Henry beat the snot out of the French nobility at Agincourt. It's obviously a genetic thing that attracts them toward loud noises and screaming. They probably think it's a wake in progress, ergo plenty of free booze, so let's get involved.

It's so hot that I am starting to melt, but the beer is giving me a mellow feeling. Well, mellow enough that I don't throttle Bernie. I look at him and make sure I enunciate the words carefully.

NEVER, NEVER VOLUNTEER

"ARE YOU BLOODY CRAZY?" He looks at me with the hurt expression that only your family and ex-girlfriends who show up at your wedding seem to be able to pull off.

"What are you pissed about? We ain't going to some leg infantry outfit; I tried to call the number you gave me but no one answered. Then Kevin suggested that we could guarantee not going if we wanted to volunteer for this MACV-SOG thing."

I am trying to comprehend why my spine feels like I just pissed on an electric fence. Then it hits me, CCN, Chuckle Chuckle North, Command and Control North. Shiva, Destroyer of Worlds! Chaos! Oh yeah, now, I remember.

Bernie can't know what he is in for, so I smile my brightest scamming smile, finish my beer, pull another one out and frost it down. Then I lean back against the wall and fix him with my most sincere look.

"I'm sorry Bernie, I must still be affected by the drop in pressure from the long flight. Great! You got us a SF assignment. What the hell, I didn't want to go to the Mike Force. I would just as soon play this tour out in some cushy job. It's probably one of those show camps. You know, where all the bunkers are covered with cement and whitewashed, complete with a stencil of the unit crest on each one. Yes, that's it, probably right outside, where'd you say it was? Da Nang? Yeah, great place. All you do is let visiting Congressmen

and reporters and Donut Dollies fly in and you give them the grand tour of a real SF A Camp. Probably has its own laundry with starched tiger stripes for the uniform of the day. We'll probably be able to drive into Da Nang, every night we aren't being interviewed by Huntley and Brinkley, that is."

He is trying to get that Gaelic mush that he calls a brain around the fact that apparently I am no longer mad, but I can see that he is nervous about the flash of panic and terror that had been me a mere thirty seconds before. I stand under the spray reflecting on the situation and figuring out some sort of scheme to get out of it without demonstrating to all and sundry that I am more interested in breathing than in furthering the myth of *The Green Berets*. I already have all the medals I want. In fact, if I can give a couple back and pretend that I am in danger, that will be just fine with me.

The water is hot and the pressure blasts most of the angst from me so that by the time I emerge I am actually feeling quite smug and happy. What the Hell? I might as well have some fun. Saigon is one of those cities where it is a perpetual Friday night. With every possible vice you could imagine and thrills, good food, and ambience to boot. I'm in the place that has shaped my adulthood. The place grows on you.


Hardly the Great Wall of China

In May, President Bush announced that he was going to deploy 6,000 National Guard Troops to the U.S. Mexico border to help the undermanned, under equipped Border Patrol.

He made it clear that he was not going to militarize the border. His counterparts south of the border, from Mexico to the tip of South America were already outraged. Mexican President Vicente Fox called talk of a barrier, high-tech or otherwise "disgraceful and shameful" and his Foreign Secretary said Mexico would not allow a 'stupid' wall. Latin economies would be devastated by the loss of the approximately fifty billion U.S. dollars filtering down south.

Like a limp U.N. Peacekeeping force, the Guardsmen were to be armed only for self defense. The troops would man border surveillance and communication equipment, answer

telephones, and maintain Border Patrol vehicles. They would build roads, help erect a controversial fence, and provide intel and training in use of force and desert survival techniques.

Critics scoffed at the idea that a few thousand troops could even begin to control the mass illegal immigration across the border. Never mind the forty tunnels that illegals use to transport guns, drugs, and their human booty.

Kudos to the National Guard

The National Guard took their commission seriously, and to the surprise of probably even the administration, had their 6,000 troopers in place by the deadline, August 1, 2006

Illegal migrants were scared off and detentions were cut by nearly a quarter in the first part of June, when the first deployment of troops took their positions.

triple layering fence and 500 miles vehicle barriers to reinforce some dilapidated sections of fence already scattered along the border. Urban areas were to be protected for at least two miles on each side.

A small scale model was already in place. California had executed Operation Gatekeeper in the early 1990s, which sealed 14 miles of the San Diego border with ten foot steel reinforced fence.

Farnam's Gunslinger Diary

By John Farnam

News from a friend in the Federal Air Marshall (FAM) Program:

"We're had bad publicity lately, as you probably know. We FAMs desperately want to remain in deep cover, blending in seamlessly with the general, traveling public. SIG is now marketing a cocked-andlocked version of its 220! Featuring a two-position, manual safety lever, similar to the one found on the 1911, this version of the 220 is designed to be carried with the hammer cocked. For all practical purposes, my preference for a carry pistol is SIG's wonderful DAK trigger system. Manual decocking levers have fallen out of style, but SIG is now offering this additional option, at least on the 220. Interesting!

In its latest "study," the Pentagon has, once again, assured us of what they have been insisting all along: the 5.56mm M855 rifle round is adequate" for military purposes. This comical charade is the Pentagon's jittery response to chronic complaints from the field about the round's well-known lack of range, poor penetration, and second-rate fight-ending ability. They're trying to assure the latest generation of exasperated combat veterans that they're just "shooting too low," and maybe not often enough! We heard all this same sorry crap forty years ago!

The message is clear: "We want input from the field, so long as it makes us all look like geniuses. Bad news, on the other hand, will not be tolerated. When equipment doesn't work, it must be your imagination!"

The Pentagon's credibility receives yet another self-inflicted wound! I wonder whom they think they're kidding.

Chamber Problems

"John: I have been shooting a Colt Python .357 Mag revolver I recently picked up, used, but in nice condition. Unfortunately, the extractor rod cannot push spent casings out without a good deal of pounding. Casings (Winchester white-box .357 Mag) keep sticking in chambers. I love the pistol, but lack the confidence that I will be able to fire more than six rounds! Do you know what is causing this dilemma?" My Reply: The problem with your Python is probably the same one endemic to all .357 Mag revolvers that have had a lot of .38 Special rounds fired through them.

A revolver chambered for the .357 Magnum cartridge will also chamber and fire the shorter .38 Special cartridge. The same is true for .44 Magnum and .44 Special cartridges. This is claimed by many to be a great advantage of the .357 Magnum revolver, since .38 Special ammunition is less expensive than .357 Magnum ammunition. However, there are some problems with this practice. Hot gases associated with bullet launch eventually cause spalling on the walls of the chamber. The chamber will gradually be ringed with tiny spall marks where the bullet comes off the .38 Special case. When the longer .357 Magnums are then fired in the same chambers, the brass will expand into the spall ring, making rapid case extraction difficult and eventually impossible, as you noted.

What all this means is that shooting a lot of .38 Specials in a .357 Magnum revolver will eventually ruin the weapon for .357 Magnum rounds. As a solution to the problem you can do one of two things:

(1) Simply dedicate the weapon to .38 Special and do not bother with .357 Magnum rounds at all.

(2) Shoot only .357 Magnum rounds in it, both for practice and for duty, forsaking .38 Special ammunition altogether. This solution only applies, of course, to new guns.

With your revolver as it is, solution one will make the most sense. \Re

WA TROOPS

Return of the Renegade Rifle Shie Manta are compating the comes themes

> CAMP HABBANIYAH, Iraq -- Scout snipers from 3rd Battalion, 5th Marine Regiment killed an enemy sniper and recovered a Marine sniper rifle lost nearly two years ago during a mission near Habbaniyah on 16 June.

> The rifle was the one formerly used by four Marines of 2nd Battalion, 4th Marine Regiment who were killed on a rooftop in Ramadi 21 June 2004.

> Sniper Section Four was in a hide when the spotter observed a military-aged male inside a car parked nearby, videotaping a passing patrol of amphibious assault vehicles. The Marines saw a rifle stock by the insurgent's side.

> "We were in the right place at the right time," said Sgt. Kevin Homestead, an infantryman from K Gompany serving as a spotter for the sniper team that day.

> They first radioed the passing Marines and told them they were being watched by an enemy sniper and to stay low. The insurgent then sealed

his own fate by preparing the weapon. The 21-year-old Marine sniper, who declined to be interviewed, aimed in at the gunman's head behind the rearside window.

He recited a mantra in his head. "Breathe, relax, aim, squeeze, surprise."

The enemy sniper died with the gun in his lap.

They dialed K Company – or Samurai 6 – and reported the target was dead.

"We then saw another militaryaged male ... enter the passenger side door," said Homestead, 26, from Ontario, Ore, "He was surprised to see the other shooter was killed."

The second insurgent scurried around the car and jumped in the driver's seat. With the sniper now spotting for him, Homestead aimed in with his M4 carbine and put three rounds in the driver before he could start the car.

A squad of K Company Marines

came to the position and saw the sniper dead and the driver shot three times. The driver died as the squad arrived on scene.

They pulled out the sniper rifle and immediately recognized that it was an M40A1, the same used by the snipers of 2nd Battalion, 4th Marine Regiment in 2004.

The trunk of the car contained a pistol, a hand grenade, dozens of 7.62 mm rounds, multiple license plates and several camcorder tapes.

"When we saw the scope and stock, we knew what it was," Homestead said. The rifle was missing for nearly two years – almost to the day. Marines believed the insurgent they killed, or those closely associated with him, had it all along. It is unknown how many times it was used against U.S. and Iraqi forces.

"He was a very good sniper," Homestead said. "But he got cocky and slipped up and it was our time to catch that."

The weapon came full circle, having originally belonged to the Darkhorse battalion in Operation Iraqi Freedom I, who turned it over to the

"Magnificent Bastards" of 2nd Battalion, 4th Marine Regiment.

Coincidentally, a Darkhorse sniper killed the insurgent sniper, and a former Magnificent Bastard killed the spotter.

Darkhorse battalion has been dealing with sporadic sniper attacks since arriving in Iraq in January. Now, Marines have one less sniper to worry about.

"It's very rewarding to take them out the way we did," said Lt. Col. Patrick G. Looney, the battalion commander. "Doubly rewarding that it's a 2/4 sniper rifle, even though it won't bring back the four Marines who were killed that day."

Triple rewarding that it won't be used on another Marine or soldier, he added.

Credit Where Due

"The credit has to go to Sgt. Homestead and the Sniper Section leader who made the kill," said 1st Lt. J. H. Cusack, Sniper Platoon commander. "It was more than being in the right place at the right time.


"It was the culmination of all of the

training and planning the section leader had done up until that moment," Cusak noted. "Being absolutely alert and focused to detect a small clue during a period of apparent inactivity and a perfectly executed shot."

Darkhorse snipers have since removed the powder and primer from the last 7.62 mm round chambered in the recaptured rifle. They will mount it on a plaque and present it to the Magnificent Bastards' snipers to honor their lost Marines.

Looney said the ability to give some retribution for their loss makes the day a "grand-slam home run for sniper ops." He credited the snipers' professionalism and attitude in accomplishing the mission throughout their area of operations.

"I would say that the guys who shot are typical of the Darkhorse snipers," said Looney, 43, from Oceanside, Calif. "They're very proficient, very modest, very busy. They're out there almost daily doing great things in this AO and our old AO. The fact that they're taking a back seat and letting the battalion reap the benefits is typical of the kind of Marines they are." \Re

Former "Magnificent Bastards" React To Sniper Rifle Recovery

CAMP FALLUJAH, Iraq — Call it a little bit of justice. Marine snipers from 3rd Battalion, 5th Marine Regiment shot and killed an insurgent sniper and spotter preparing to shoot at passing Marines, June 16. And the insurgents were going to use a stolen Marine sniper rifle for the attack.

That rifle – an M40A1 – belonged to the "Magnificent Bastards" of 2nd Battalion, 4th Marine Regiment, a battalion within the Regimental Combat Team 5 family. It was taken by insurgents when a team of four Marines were killed in a rooftop outpost 21 June 2004, in Ramadi.

Nearly two years to the day, Sgt. Maj. James E. Booker, the Battalion's sergeant major during their tour in Ramadi, said the news "sends a chill down my spine."

"It makes me feel real good to know a brother sniper got final revenge," said Booker, in a phone interview from his post as the Marine detachment sergeant major at Fort Sill, Okla. "I really respect those young studs to do what they did."

Booker should know. Aside from

leading his Marines through Ramadi, he's a 20-year sniper himself, first acquiring the skill in 1986. He later led 1st Marine Division School's Scout-Sniper School.

And Booker knew the four Marines killed on the rooftop that day as well. Lance Cpl. Deshon Otey was the sole survivor of an ambush that killed his entire squad in April 2004. Lance Cpl. Juan Lopez was a combat replacement, pulled in to beef up the ranks.

Lance Cpl. Pedro Contreras "was a good doggone kid," Booker said. "He and I got in a gunfight together."

The final member was Cpl. Tommy Parker Jr., the team's only trained sniper.

"I can see it like the day I walked up there," said Booker, a 44-year-old from Waco, Texas. He said they believed the team was killed around 10:40 a.m. After missing radio checks, a quick reaction force was dispatched.

"We were there within an hour of [insurgents] filming it," he said. The video of the dead Marines was already

playing across Arabic-language news channels.

A lot of confusion has surrounded that day. What is known is radio checks were logged from the time the team left their forward operating base around 0100 hours until 0730 the next day, the last time indicated in the logbook found in Contreras' hand. They were found dead, blood pooled on the flat rooftop. A short wall surrounded the entire roof and a single staircase led to the top. They were found stripped of their weapons - two sniper rifles, four M-16A4s and a radio and thermal sight.

The rifle that was the extension of Parker was gone. He and his team were killed and there were no clear answers as to who killed them or what happened to their weapons.

"That's sacred, the relationship you have with that thing," Booker explained. "Parker shot thousands of rounds through that rifle."

Cpl. Angel S. Villalobos, a 23-yearold from Taft, Texas, with RCT-5's Personnel Security Detachment, was a Magnificent Bastard in Ramadi in 2004. He remembered the day clearly. It was the day before he himself was wounded.

Rifle: POW, or Turncoat?

"I wondered if it was this rifle that did it," Villalobos said. "We were going through Ramadi, knocking down every door trying to find it."

Navy Petty Officer 2nd Class Andrew R. Campanano, a 26-year-old from Allentown, Pa., is serving with RCT-5 and saw the four Marines often. They lined up - scout snipers and the aid station's hospital corpsmen - alongside each other in formations.

"The guys who got this back, they're great," Campanano said. "These are the guys fighting this war out here."

Villalobos held the rifle in his hands and fell silent. He held it low, cradling it and examined the chipped paint jobs applied by Marines over the years. The Unertl scope was missing, replaced by a Tasco, but otherwise, the rifle was in good working order.

"It means a lot knowing we got our rifle back because now they can't use it against us," Villalobos said. "I'm glad to know they got it back, but it brings up a lot of questions. It makes

you wonder if they're the ones who might have taken it."

The rifle's long journey back into the hands of Marines from 5th Marine Regiment wasn't forgotten by any of the former Magnificent Bastards, including Master Sgt. Rod B. Schlosser, the regiment's assistant operations chief. He was the company gunnery sergeant for Headquarters and Service Company, 2nd Battalion, 4th Marine Regiment in Ramadi.

The rifle was on his inventory and he cared for the four Marines. "It's bittersweet," said Schlosser, a 38-yearold from Steubenville, Ohio. "You're first thought is on the loss of the Marines. But you're reminded to be thankful for the skills of the Marines today to bring closure to this."

Schlosser said he often thought about the missing weapon, knowing the effect a sniper has on the battlefield. He also knew the insurgents had one of the finest rifles in their hands – and it was a Marine rifle, his Marines' rifle.

"It gets under your skin," he explained. "The most important thing is knowing it's not in the hands of the enemy. There's gratitude for the 3/5 Marines, for the lives they've saved taking it out of the enemy's hands."

Lt. Col. Paul J. Kennedy was the battalion's commander in Ramadi. He now serves at the Office of Legislative Affairs and was told right away about the rifle's recovery. "I was very pleased," Kennedy said by phone. "It's justice being carried out. The guys who perpetrated this crime should be rotting in hell and 3/5 allowed that to occur."

Kennedy has a hunch that the Darkhorse snipers of 3rd Battalion,



5th Marine Regiment got those who killed, or at least had a part in killing, his Marines.

"I don't believe that weapon passed hands," he said. "I think it was at least probably part of that cell. The very fact it was one of our snipers that killed theirs trying to use our rifle is poetic justice."

No Closure On Loss

Kennedy said the news wasn't so much closure on the loss of his four Marines. They can't be replaced and the rifle is never a replacement for the Marines. Still, it was fitting that another 5th Marine Regiment battalion recovered a rifle stolen from his Marines. It's

a family matter, one battalion supporting another from the same regiment.

What will happen to the rifle is a question still to be answered. Marines from RCT-5 are tracking down which unit should own it, according to how weapons sets were passed among deploying battalions. And the M40A1s are being phased out for M40A3s, a newer version used by Marines now.


Booker said he'd hate to see the weapon go back into use, knowing insurgents used it to try, and possibly did, kill Marines. "There are evil spirits on it," Booker said. Instead, he thinks it should be preserved.

"I would like to see it sit in a place of honor," he added.

Kennedy said his battalion never brought home any war trophies. There was a memorial service to honor their 35 killed in action, but no lasting memorial exists at the battalion's headquarters.

Kennedy said this rifle might be the appropriate memorial to all his Marines killed.

"Maybe if it was hung in the battalion area," he said, "it would be a fitting memory to those four and the rest." 🕅

On Asocial Criminal Behavior...

... the kind of violence you MUST know how

The M16 fought its way through the evolutionary process to become an excellent infantry rifle – a battle-proven design that will be well judged by history. But not all who do battle are infantry and even for infantry, their CQB needs may not be best served by a conventional rifle. On many SpecOps missions, for example, operators often carry MP5 submachine guns, for the compact size and controllable firepower.

But the undependable lethality of the 9mm NATO round has given rise to the phenomenon of the "Personal Defense Weapon" to fill the void between pistol and rifle, primarily for use by personnel whose primary mission may not be engaging the enemy in a small-arms contest, not unlike the bailout-weapon designs being investigated by the Air Force back in the early 70s. To increase the range and lethality of such a "pistol caliber" weapon, FN developed the 5.7 x 28mm round, and has even scaled it up to a civilian rifle version.

But the best work sometimes is continuing behind the scenes, by dynamic, newer companies. Having been out of the news while they shipped GI orders for 10,000 rail systems a month, Knight's Armament Company was recently awarded the contract for the new M110 sniper rifle, and that is news – but the *big* news for this innovative company is a whole new weapons system, the KAC PDW.

Colonel David A. Lutz, USMC (Ret.), Knight Armament Company's VP for military sales, invited me down to their expansive new facility for some trigger time on this new weapon with a new mission.

The KAC 6x35mm PDW (Personal Defense Weapon)

What has separated the Good Gun Companies from the Great Gun Com-

panies has always been the ability to anticipate the need, and be readywithaleadingedge

> product slightly before the need is realized. A good example is the KAC 6x35mm PDW, which has been an intense three-year developmental proj-

ect. Trying to make a new CQB weapon to replace the MP5 is no small task, but Knight has done it with a weapon that is lighter, smaller, more powerful, and with far greater range than the MP5. As a bonus, it has next to no recoil – it was like shooting a .22 rifle with a 30-round magazine.

With KAC front and rear removable sights, on four integral Mil-Std 1913 Picatinny Rails, the operator has the option to mount any accessory he will need (I highly recommend the VF-302 Crimson Trace front laser grip, because with it you know you will be spot-on target before you pull

With facile firepower one could wear in a holster like an M1A1 .30 carbine, Johnson found KAC's new Personal Defense Weapon fast to handle, accurate, and easy to control on rapid fire.

how smoothly this weapon/ammo combination fired. It was very easy to control on rapid fire, and keep your rounds on target.

Hornady Ammunition Company (www.hornady.com) designed the new 6x35mm cartridge.

Light, Handy, Deadly

The KAC PDW weighs in at 4.5 pounds empty – that's just a pound more then a Glock 17 with three loaded magazines. Overall length is 28" and a compact 19.5" with the stock folded. It is available in two barrel-lengths, 10" and 8". With the new round you can feel no difference in recoil when firing the KAC PDW with its stock folded. The muzzle velocity is the same as an M4 rifle at 2,425 fps, and this new round carries more kinetic energy with the 10" barrel than does an M4. The PDW can penetrate body armor at 300 meters with a 65-grain bullet. I was surprised at

I can see this new cartridge causing some major competition for any similar round. Having fired just about every weapon in the U.S. military's arsenal, to include the MP5, I can tell you that there is not another weapon like the KAC PDW. With its compact dimensions and extended range, this weapon will no doubt replace one or more existing weapons – in addition to being a new weapon of choice for operators with very specific missions.

The current situation at KAC is that of an innovative company that has been working two shifts for the past three years just to keep up with military contracts. Reed Knight took the entrepreneurial chance and moved his factory into a larger compound and ploughed millions of dollars of his own money back into the company (KAC is privately held). As a result, 98% of all weapon parts are made at Knight's own factory where he can control quality, and he has plans ultimately to make every part of every weapon and accessory with his name on it, in his own facility.

For those with a preference that their weapon or their accessory is made in the good old USA by American labor, then consider KAC/KMC. The new facilities still have a lot of room for KAC and KMC to expand, and before long Knight will be making his barrels as well. Now able to catch their breath a little, Reed and David would be pleased for interested parties to stop by and see them this year at the SHOT Show in Orlando, where KAC will have more associates available to answer any question.

There is not a civilian version yet, but KAC is looking into the best way to make one, whether it be going with a longer-barrel, civilian-legal rifle, or making it as a pistol – or both. We will just have to wait and see. For the folks out there who want all the cool accessories like rail systems and folding front and rear sights from Knight Manufacturing Company (KMC), but had a hard time finding it on the shelf of their local gun store, call KMC sales department at 1-321-607-9900 ext. 1330 (www.knightarmco.com). 🛪 Recently retired from 3/7th Cavalry after multiple tours in the sandbox, Dillard J. chael Chertoff nixed the idea of a fence along the entire 2000 mile border when he realized that the San Diego wall had cost four times more than estimated. At an estimate of a minimum of \$2 billion dollars for a partial fence, a total fence could well cost up to \$10 billion dollars.

Part of the barrier plan is to consist of a "virtual fence", components of which would include unmanned aerial vehicles (to add to the one Predator UAV

currently in service), radar equipped aircraft, motion and sound sensors, infrared cameras, and portable radars and sensors, among other sophisticated electronics.

The idea of a virtual fence is hardly




new. In the 1970s and 1980 cameras and electronic sensors were deployed. By the late 1990s, seismic and infrared motion and heat sensors were used.

Unfortunately only a small percentage of the border was covered and sensors—that did not know the difference between animals and humans—would prompt BP agents into chasing hairy, four-legged beasts. The pole mounted cameras were mostly on the fritz.





The Truth Behind the "Crime Emergency" in Washington, D.C.

July in our Nation's Capitol is known for hot, humid weather and beautiful fireworks. This July was also a month of murder and mayhem, with 14 murders in the first 11 days. Several high profile crimes against tourists led to Washington D.C. Police Chief Charles Ramsey declaring a "crime emergency." Robbery and murder rates are up and Washington D.C. is once again on its way to winning the title of "Murder Capital of America."

Why is the capital of the free world one of the most dangerous cities in America? According to the Washington Post, it's because the police aren't able to confiscate all the guns and knives in Washington D.C. and that the criminals released from prison into the community can't read well. Apparently if guns and knives disappeared tomorrow and hard time was replaced with Hooked on Phonics, the city's legions of criminals would turn away from mayhem and dedicate their time to reading the Washington Post.

The Post has no problem suggesting that citizens should be pro-active in fighting crime by reporting "suspi-cious people" to the police. Here's a crazy idea, how about giving the people of the District the means to protect themselves from those "suspicious people" when they are being raped, robbed or murdered in their own homes? And while the city's license plates complain of 'taxation without representation' - the 'crime emergency' is proof positive that the law abiding people of Washington D.C. need the Second Amendment a lot more than they need two more politicians. 🕱





stayed in the fight.

Next Kasal called in a TOW that punched a 12-inch hole in the wall without dislodging the insurgents. When that failed the Marines decided to enter the house through a heavy metal door in the back. To get there they had to cross an alley bordered by a high wall, Nicoll said. Nicoll and Kasal went first with Mitchell and Severtsgard on overwatch. The pair got about half way down the alley when automatic weapons fire and two grenades forced them to take cover. Both men jumped over an adjacent wall just in time to avoid the blasts.

"There was about two feet between the houses. We jumped over the fence. Kasal and me were the only ones who had gotten over. We were taking fire, we were wide open. I got shot in the shin, barely broke the skin," Nicoll says.

That ended the fight. The insurgents remained in control until the house was bulldozed and crushed with them inside. Until the trio was all severely wounded the next day it



Almost immediately after their intense personal duel, Kilo was ambushed from both the east and west flanks near a place called Phase Line Henry, by foreign fighters. It took multiple close-in air strikes from Marine Corps F/A-18s using 500-hundred pound bombs, and artillery and tank fire for Kilo to extricate itself, Buhl said.

That night Kilo holed up in a former government building. All night there was movement around their firm base. Kilo's Forward Air Controller coordinated 14 AC-130 "Spectre" aerial attacks on insurgents moving around Kilo's position. The activity promised November 13th was going to be a bad one. Despite the aerial activity, Mitchell remembers the night being relatively quiet.

About 0800 the next morning Kilo moved onto the street. Kasal, along with one CAAT vehicle, went with Mitchell's squad. Nicoll was up front on point. The air was smoky and stunk of old fires and old death.

About 1030 3rd Platoon halted in place when word came down that 1st




Platoon had discovered a huge arms cache. Nobody was to move until it could be destroyed. Mitchell was standing on the side of the street talking to Kasal while another squad from 3rd Platoon was searching a house when he got the word, he says.

Where the other squad was searching at the end of the block, several unarmored Humvees Kilo's Marines had rigged up with Mk-19s and machine guns were idling on overwatch. It was a typical hurry up and wait proposition, Mitchell says. At that instant Mitchell's attention shifted to a blast of automatic weapons fire where Kilo's Humvees were sitting, he says.

"Suddenly a hail of gunfire erupted out of nowhere, it erupted down the block. Kasal and the CAAT section were moving with us. I don't think we got that far when we ran into Staff Sgt. Chris Pruitt. He was wounded in the arm and leg," Mitchell recalls.

The insurgents had chosen a nondescript light yellow house on the corner to make their stand. It seemed innocuous enough, but that was a trick. As the Marines would soon discover, the house was a clever trap that used its novel design to turn it into an

Ironically, it was the smell of fresh human feces that was the first thing to alert Pruitt that hajji was nearby, he later said. He followed his nose to an outhouse guarding the home's walled courtyard and saw a fresh pile of crap on the floor by the hole that passed for a toilet.

"After I seen the crap I told [Lance Cpl. Ryan] Weemer there were insurgents in the house," Pruitt says.

After formulating a brief plan, Pruitt ordered his team to take them out. In the back of Pruitt's mind was the ROE. He didn't want his men simply shooting up everything and everybody in sight, he said.

The squad went into a three-man combat stack and burst inside. Pruitt was in the rear of the stack. Almost instantly the Marine in front encountered a jihadist and opened up on him with his 9mm pistol. The Marine shot him three times in the chest. The Marine behind the pistol shooter gave the crumpled insurgent another burst with his rifle, then another. The fight for Hell House was on.

"Then we moved through the next doorway that was directly in front of us," Pruitt says.

On the other side of the doorway was another jihadist. To his left was a third. Everyone in the room opened fire almost simultaneously, Pruitt says. \Re

Next month the incredible story of courage and tenacity continues as the Marines find themselves fighting it out toe-to-toe, while shot-up and trapped.





Continuing the Legacy

WASHINGTON, D.C. – If recent surveys of public opinion are correct, warweary Americans are already suffering "combat fatigue" from the most recent battle in the global war on terror – the fight between Israel and Hezbollah in southern Lebanon. Apparently the U.S. public doesn't believe this bloody engagement to have to do with us – thus, the waning interest. Those who believe that Hezbollah is simply an Israeli problem need to think again.

"Know your enemy" isn't just a hackneyed military slogan – it's an essential survival tool in this new world disorder of global Islamic terror. Hezbollah is – and has always been – America's enemy.

When Lebanon descended into civil war along sectarian and ethnic lines in 1975, nearly a half dozen rival factions with armed militias began a deadly struggle for power – Christian, Sunni, Shia, Druze and Palestinian. Into this chaos, and well before Israel invaded Lebanon in 1982, Ayatollah Khomeini began sending Pasdaran – Iranian Revolutionary Guards – to the Lebanese Biqa Valley to organize, train and equip the poorly armed, disparate Shia militias into an effective politico-military force. Hezbollah was the result – and almost immediately, Americans began to die.

From their bases in the Biqa, Hezbollah terrorists launched a series of spectacular attacks against Americans:

- April 18, 1983: A suicide bomber driving a pickup truck loaded with explosives rams into the U.S. Embassy in Beirut, killing 63 - including 17 Americans.

- Oct. 23, 1983: A suicide bomber detonates a truck full of explosives in the U.S. Marine barracks near Beirut International Airport, killing 241 U.S. servicemen.

- Dec. 12, 1983: Hezbollah operatives attack the U.S. Embassy in Kuwait. Near simultaneous attacks are carried out against the Emir of Kuwait, the French embassy, the airport, a major oil refinery and an American residential compound. In all, six people die; more than 80 are wounded.

-- April 2, 1986 -- a bomb aboard TWA Flight 840, en route from Athens to Rome Rome to Athens kills four members of the Kluge family from Annapolis, MD, an American family that included an infant girl.

- Feb. 17, 1988: U.S. Marine Col. William Higgins, assigned to the U.N. Peacekeeping Force for Lebanon, is kidnapped, tortured and murdered.

- June 14, 1985: TWA Flight 847 is hijacked and landed at Beirut International Airport. During the 17 day standoff, U.S. Navy Seabee Diver Robert Stethem is murdered aboard the aircraft and his body is dumped on the tarmac.

-- In a wave of kidnappings between 1982 and 1988. Hezbollah took more than 30 Westerners hostage in Lebanon, among them, CIA station chief William Buckley, American University of Beirut President David Dodge, AP reporter Terry Anderson, American University of Beirut librarian Peter Kilburn, American University Hospital Administrator David Jacobsen, Father Martin Jenco, a Roman Catholic Priest, and Rev. Benjamin Weir, a Presbyterian missionary. Though most survived captivity - Anderson was held 2,454 days -- some, like Buckley, were tortured to death.

- June 25, 1996, the Khobar Towers complex in Saudi Arabia is bombed, killing 19 U.S. Air Force personnel and wounding more than 400.

Though all of these terrorist attacks were perpetrated by Hezbollah operatives, the individuals carrying them out were trained, equipped and controlled by Iran. We have known that with absolute certainty since 1986, when I went secretly to Tehran seeking the release of Americans being held hostage in Beirut. Though the Reagan administration's covert overtures to Iran remain highly controversial, there is no doubt Tehran directed the capture – and eventually the release – of Weir, Jenco and Jacobsen.

For those who think this is all ancient history and that Hezbollah is no longer a threat to the United States, consider that just last week, Iranian Hezbollah spokesman Mojtaba Bigdeli issued a threat to dispatch 2,000 operatives "to every corner of the world to jeopardize Israel and America's interests." He continued: "If America wants to ignite World War III ... we welcome it."

Idle threat? Not to the FBI. Two months ago, before Hezbollah attacks on Israel precipitated the most recent round of hostilities, the New York Post reported the group "may be planning to activate sleeper cells in New York and other big cities to stage an attack as the nuclear showdown with Iran heats up." The threat seemed credible enough for the FBI to launch "urgent new probes in New York and other cities," including Detroit, Los Angeles and Boston. The effort, the Post reported, identified "about a dozen hard-core supporters of Hezbollah" in New York City alone.

President Bush has repeatedly warned the global war on terror will not be short, cost-free or without losses. We can reduce our losses by knowing our enemies and acting against them. Hezbollah is surely such an enemy. 🕱


