SOME DESCENDANTS OF WILLIAM SAWYER OF NEWBURY, MASS.

CORRECTED AND ENLARGED FROM THE NEW-ENGLAND HISTORICAL AND GENEALOGICAL
REGISTER FOR APRIL, 1874.

I HAVE undertaken to write the genealogy for four generations of the family founded at Newbury by WILLIAM SAWYER. It is by no means perfect, and I shall be glad to receive additional facts or corrections. WILLIAM SAWYER was born about 1613, as he called himself 65 when he took the oath of allegiance in 1678. I know of no evidence to connect him with other settlers in New England of the name of Sawyer. He does not appear in any position of prominence or importance, except as one of the founders of the Baptist Church at Newbury in 1682. He had a wife Ruth, and died in 1702 or 1703, administration on his estate being granted 1 March, 1703; no settlement was made, and he seems to have left no property. He probably lived in or near what is now West Newbury, where some of his descendants may still be found.

In the History of Wells, mention is made of a Captain Samuel Sawyer of the Revolutionary Army, killed in August, 1779. I do not identify him with certainty, but suppose he was son of William, 32. IV. He seems to have left a son Samuel, to whom administration on the father's estate was granted in 1793.

The wills of William Sawyer, (4. II.), and of Sarah, his widow, are printed in "MAINE WILLS, 1640-1760," published at Portland in 1887. At Salem are the wills of Samuel, (3. II.), and Stephen, (5. II.), and the administration on estate of John, (2. II.), as well as many later wills and administrations.
