

### 1. Matters Arising

Tanya is finding out more about the military drill, which takes place every Friday at Nottingham High School. The idea is that we can then decide what sort of direct action, if any, is appropriate.

### 2. The Evening Post

We discussed a letter from John Birdsall of the NUJ. The letter expressed concern over our using the Evening Post for press ceverage. Paddy suggested that we boycott the Post from now on. A vote was taken, the result was 9 for the boycott, 1 against.

### 3. Street Theatre

On 21st May we will have the "Cruise Lorry" at our disposal. It is planned that we perform some street theatre outside the Scoop Shop and possibly at the Park and Ride bus stop. About 10 people are needed to perform and distribute leaflets, so a meeting will take place on Wednesday May 4th at 107 Foxhall Road at 8.00 pm for anyone who can help. Colin and Paddy will be writing a leaflet for this event.

## 4. The Royal Ordnance Factory

It was suggested that we picket the Royal Ordnance Factory on Wilford Road also that we picket Plessey. It was decided that at the moment we should concentrate on firms with specific links with nuclear armaments using Trade Unions and work associates.

## 5. Direct Action

The idea of stopping the traffic in Nottingham city centre and delivering leaflets was discussed. Obviously this is too big an exercise for a neighbourhood group so the idea was that we propose that NCND organise this event. However, some people expressed doubt about the idea and no conclusion was reached.

## 6. Neighbourhood Canvass

John, Colin and Annie will be meeting to formulate a guideline for street canvassers. The results will be discussed at the next meeting.

## 7. Fund Raising

It was decided to ask members to contribute sandwiches or cook for a stall which we will be having at the Queen's Walk Community Centre where a march will be finishing on May Day.

John is going to co-ordinate the writing of a newsletter to sell in the Forest Fields area.
