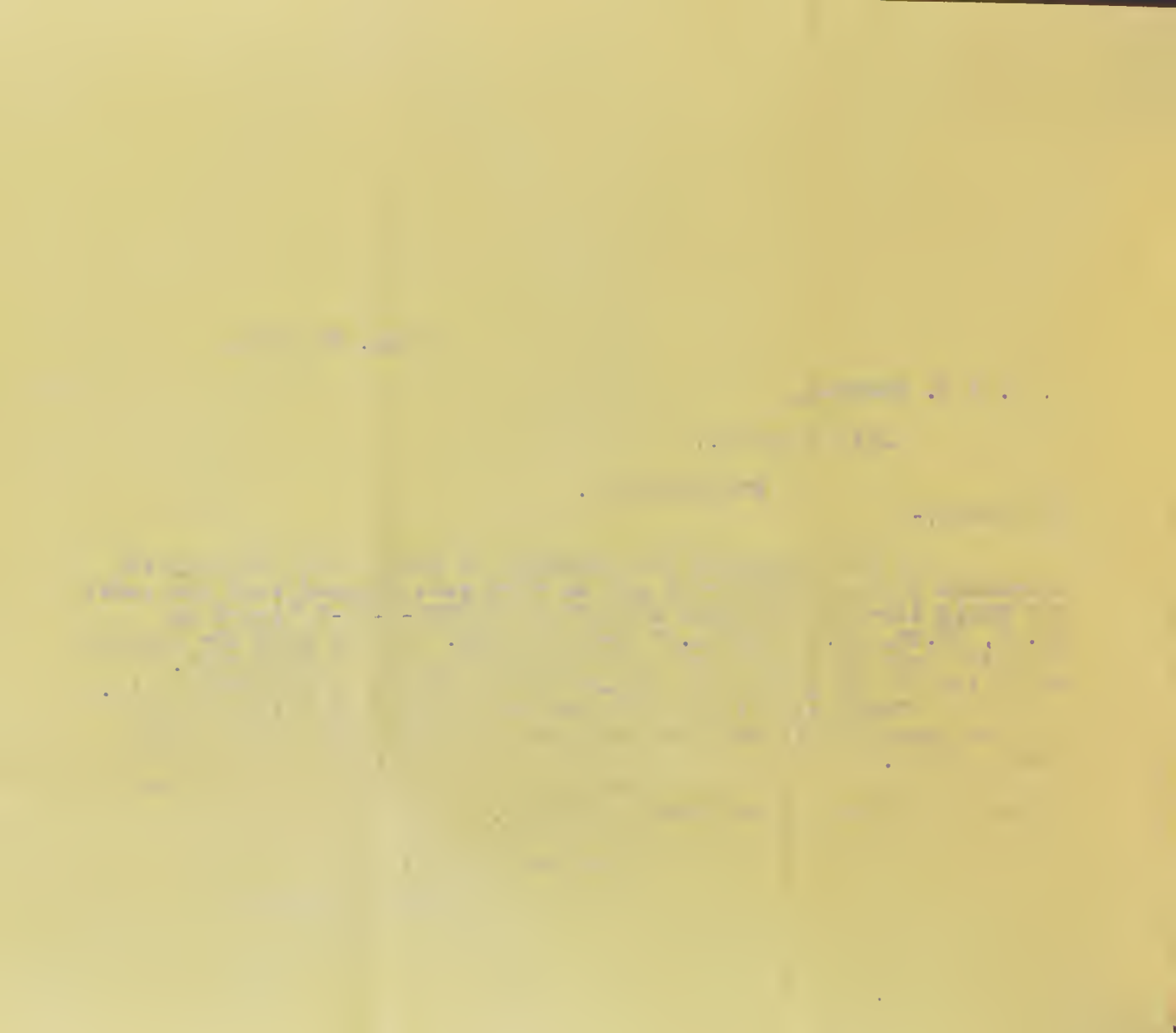
Gentlemen;-
