# The Cathedral

Joris-Karl HUYSMANS (1848 - 1907),  
translated by Clara BELL (1835 - 1927)

It is the third of Huysmans' books to feature the character Durtal, a thinly disguised portrait of the author. He had already featured the character of Durtal in *Là-bas* and *En route*, which recounted his conversion to Catholicism. *La Cathédrale* continues the story. After his retreat at a Trappist monastery, Durtal moves to the city of Chartres, renowned for its cathedral. Huysmans describes the building in great detail. - Summary by Wikipedia.

## FOLDING INSTRUCTIONS FOR SINGLE CD JEWEL CASE INSERTS

1. Print Page 2, Cut along outer black lines, fold Cover Art over the back side of Text area. Slip into front of jewel case, Cover Art up.
2. Print Page 3 if planning to insert into back of jewel case, cut along outer black lines, fold flaps to fit into sides of case. Disassemble jewel case, slide paper in. Reassemble.
