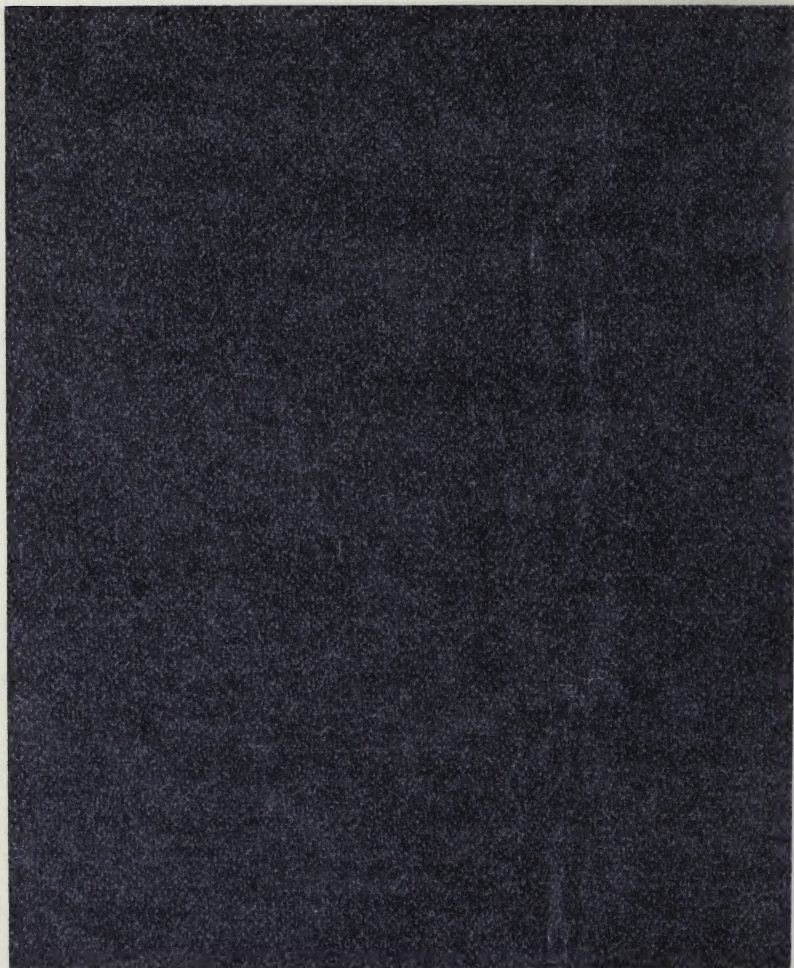

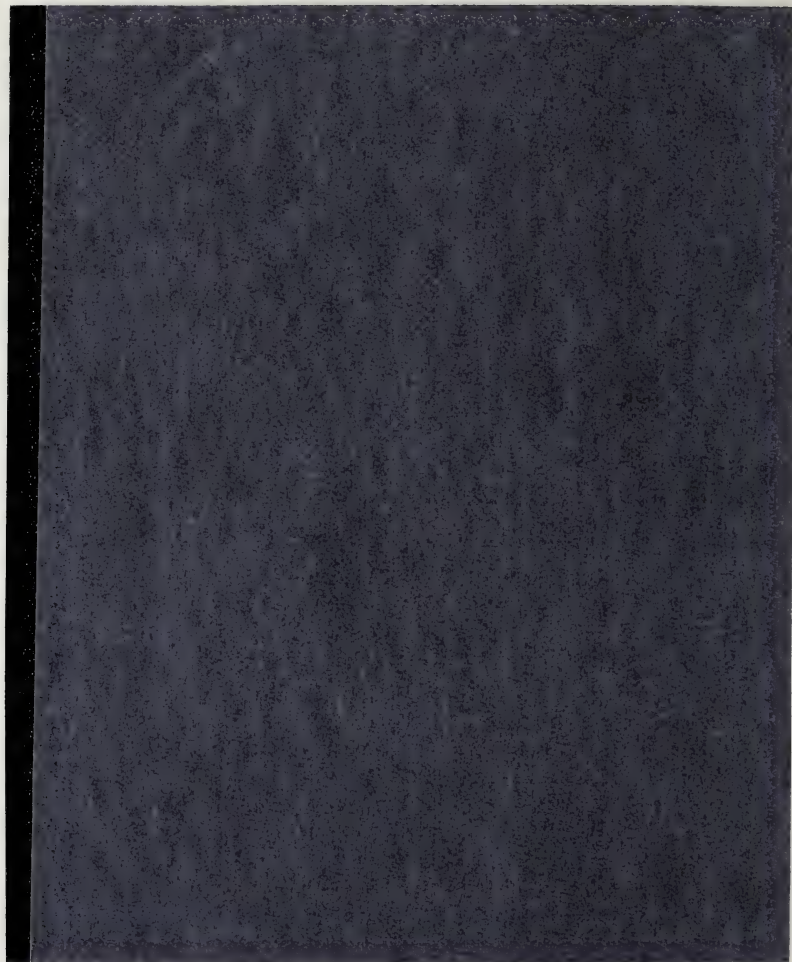

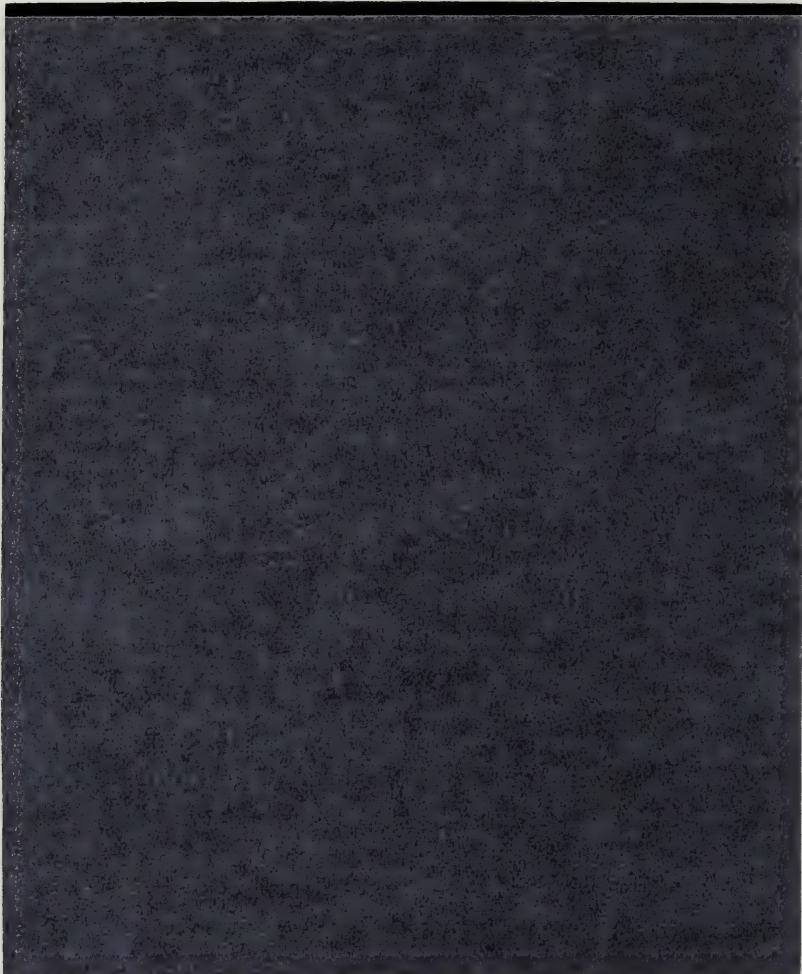

Psychological Distress and Posttraumatic Stress Disorder in Women with Intimate Partner Violence

Abstract: This study examined the relationship between intimate partner violence (IPV) and psychological distress and posttraumatic stress disorder (PTSD) in women.

Keywords: intimate partner violence, psychological distress, PTSD

Intimate partner violence (IPV) is a global public health problem that affects approximately 15% to 25% of women worldwide (World Health Organization, 2002).

IPV is associated with a range of psychological and physical health problems, including depression, anxiety, and PTSD (Finkelhor & Browne, 1985).

The purpose of this study was to examine the relationship between IPV and psychological distress and PTSD in women.

The study included 100 women who had experienced IPV in the past 12 months.

Results showed that women who experienced IPV had significantly higher levels of psychological distress and PTSD than women who had not experienced IPV.

The findings suggest that IPV is a significant risk factor for psychological distress and PTSD in women.

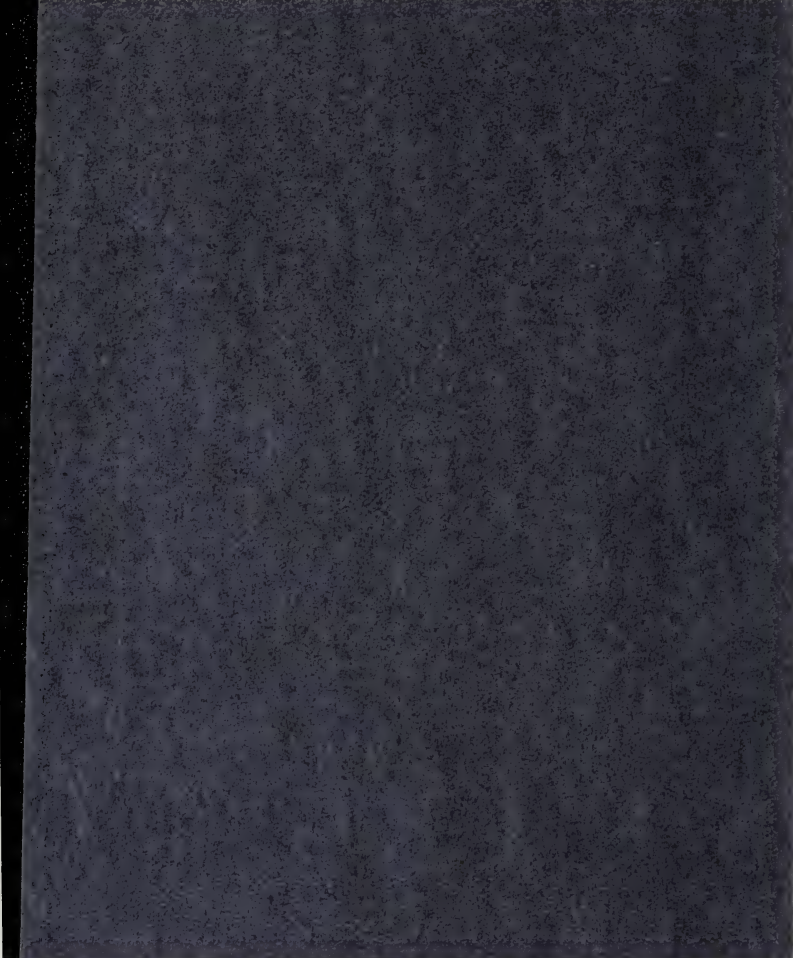

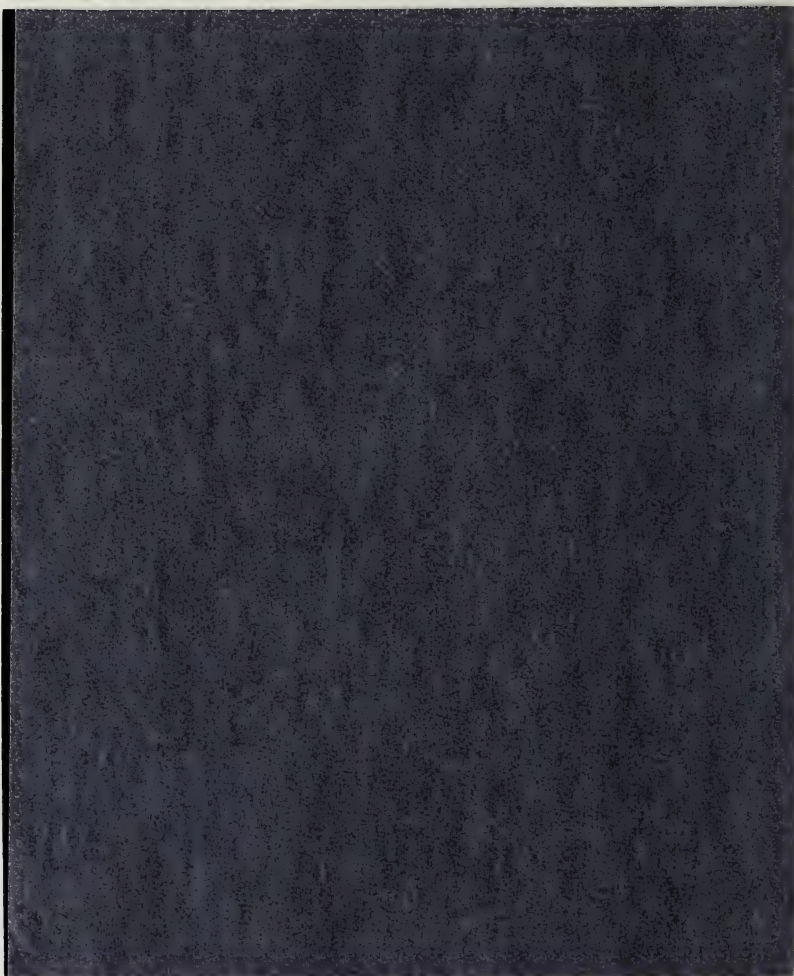
