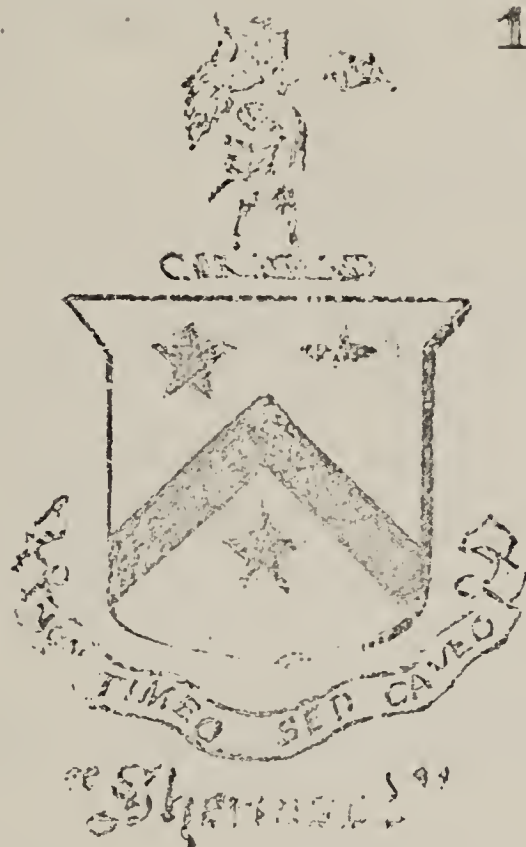


"SHERWOODIANA"

In this issue of "YOUR ANCESTORS" we are presenting the genealogy of the Sherwood Family of America as compiled by M. Beatrix Carlson and dedicated to Thomas¹ Sherwood, the Puritan Pioneer Ancestor and Progenitor of the family.

Research in England discloses the fact that this was one of the most interesting and colorful families in early English history and its connection with Sherwood Forest and the glorious tales of Robin Hood and his merry men.

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Sherwood Coat of Arms.--Argent, a chevron sable, between three mullets, gules. Crest: A dexter hand holding a branch of a rose tree, argent, slipped, leaved vert. The time and circumstances of its granting has not been found, but the name is included among the existing Armory at the second Visitation of the Heraldry in 1563. The Harleian Society's Mss. is somewhat confusing to consult as the several series deal with "Marriages" or "Wills", etc. but Foster's Pedigrees, founded on the "Visitations", may be found by the persevering Foster's Pedigrees, in Vol. xvi, of Harleian Society gives the Visitations of Yorkshire, 1563, and on page 233 gives Sir Edmond Nevil of Iversedge. The same volume, page 246, gives a Sherwood pedigree; Smith's "Old Yorkshire", Vol. iv, pp. 240-1-2, as well as Vol. iii, page 24, shows the complete Sherwood Nevil line. Papsworth's British Armorial, page 459, gives under "three mullets between", the Arms of Sherwood, of York, New Castle and Somerset. All are to be found in Burke's General Armory. Burke's illustrations, Plate lxxxvii, ed. 1844, illustrates the above blazon as used in the third quarter of Evans, of Baycount, County Dublin and Robinstowe, West Meath, Ireland.

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The rose is said to have been introduced into England by Crusaders, so brought it from Palestine, and the rose crest as natural is therefore said to indicate an origin in a Crusading ancestor, and is called "The Crusader's Rose". The Sherwood rose is the only white rose registered in Fairbairn. The motto "Fortitudo et Fidelitas", may be freely translated "Constant and True", as given by Fairbairn, who gives also, "Arma Spina Rosa", etc., i.e. "The thorn is the defence of the rose", and several other mottoes are used by bearers of the rose as natural.

"SHERWOODIANA"

1. THOMAS¹ Sherwood, the Puritan Pioneer Ancestor, born in Nottinghamshire, England, 1586, with his wife, Alice (Seabrooke) Sherwood, daughter of Robert and Alice (Goodspeed) (daughter of Nicholas and Alice Goodspeed) born in Wingrave, County Bucks, England, 1587, with their four children: Anne, or Hannah, aged 14; Rose, aged 11; Thomas 10 and Rebecca 9, sailed for America aboard the ship "Affraunces", Capt. John Cuttine, Master, from Ipswich, County Suffolk, England April 10, 1634. Thomas Sherwood and his family had evidently lived in London prior to this time, since his son Thomas was baptized at St. Bottolph's Church, London in October, 1630. They landed at Plymouth Rock, Cape Cod, Massachusetts during the month of July, 1634.

After a short stay at Boston and Concord, Massachusetts, they moved to Wethersfield and later to Fairfield, Connecticut, where Thomas became one of the most prominent citizens and a Deputy to the General Court of Connecticut at Hartford, from Fairfield. He was one of the original seventeen settlers of Fairfield, a landed proprietor there and a member of the expedition which exterminated the Pequot Indians at the "Great Swamp Fight" at Fairfield, July 13, 1637. He died at Fairfield between July 21 and September 7, 1655, the dates of the signing and the probate of his will. It is proposed to place a Memorial Monument to his memory in the Old Burying Ground at the rear of the Old Town Meeting Hall, in Fairfield, at the next annual Reunion of "Sherwood Kindred of America", during the month of August of the current year. A scroll, beautifully engraved with the names of the donors, will be presented to the Probate Court at that time.

Three of the children of Thomas and Alice (Seabrooke) Sherwood were evidently left in England, to come later. The names of their children, as given in his will, are:

Alice Seabrooke Sherwood died at the birth of her daughter Jane, 1639, at Fairfield, Connecticut.

1. Thomas¹ Sherwood married 2nd about 1640 Mary¹ Fitch, daughter of Thomas and Anne (Reve) (daughter of John Reve and Mary (Brock)) born about 1619 Bocking, County Essex, England, whose ancestry has been traced back to the time of the Norman Conquest and beyond. At the time of the trial of Good Dame Knapp, for witchcraft, in Fairfield, both Thomas Sherwood and Mary (Fitch) Sherwood were defense witnesses. Mary walked to the gallows with Good Dame Knapp and prevented the mob from desecrating her body. At this time both Thomas and his wife Mary were spoken of as "some of the most respectable persons in Connecticut". Their children (all born in Fairfield) were:

Mary² Fitch was the daughter of Gov. Thomas and Anne (Stacie). She was the niece of the first Mary Fitch who married Thomas¹ Sherwood. Some question arose as to whether father and son married each a Mary Fitch, but the truth of this statement is borne out in published records. The "Powers-Banks" Genealogy calls Thomas Sherwood's wife, at the trial of Good Dame Knapp, "MARY FITCH Sherwood".

Elizabeth Jackson was the daughter of John Jackson (one of the first patentees of Eastchester, Westchester County, New York) and Elizabeth (Smith), daughter of Henry Smith and Ann (Pyncheon) (daughter of Gov. William Pyncheon, founder of Springfield, Massachusetts and Ann (Andrews)). Isaac² Sherwood's age is determined by the fact that in 1672, at the age of 21, he signed a release to his step-father, John Banks.

The three sons of Thomas² Sherwood married three daughters of Benjamin Turney of Fairfield, Connecticut.

E R R A T A

The July issue of the American Genealogist contains an article by its editor which severely criticizes the data given in the opening pages of the Sherwood Genealogy which is being published in "Your Ancestors", and we quote: "In "Your Ancestors", March, 1949, Thomas Sherwood, Sr., b. Nottinghamshire, England --wives: Alice Seabrook, dau of Robert and Alice (Goodspeed) and Mary Fitch. A County Nottingham origin for Sherwood seems to be based on nothing more substantial than the fact that Sherwood Forest is located there. The only reason for concluding that any Thomas Sherwood married a daughter of Robert Seabrook is that deeds of children of Thomas Sherwood of Stratford refer to their grandfather Seabrook. Hence, any statement that Alice, wife of Thomas Sherwood of Fairfield was a Seabrook is based on a confusion between the two families. Alice was called 47 in the shipping list in 1634, hence born not far from 1596, some nine years after their alleged daughter was born."

It is also stated that there is no proof that the maiden name of Thomas' second wife was Fitch.

It becomes very obvious then, that some of the facts stated in the March 1949 issue cannot be accepted and, apparently, cannot be substantiated.

However, in justice to ourselves, it should be stated that the data as given in the first two installments was contributed. No further data was sent in for publication and the contributor withdrew it at this time. All subsequent data is the compilation of your editor, who has endeavored to make it authentic. It is possible that other errors may be discovered and, if so, we would be glad to have them reported.

Since starting publication of the genealogy of the descendants of Thomas Sherwood of Fairfield, Connecticut considerable confusion has arisen between them and those of the other Thomas Sherwood who settled in Stratford, Connecticut. It is not unlikely that these two men were related in some way as they were contemporary and both settled in the same county. However, this relationship, if any, doesn't appear to have been discovered. This confusion has resulted in what seems to be errors in source material.

We have depended mainly on the probate records of Fairfield County to straighten out this tangle and believe the records as published of Thomas Sherwood of Fairfield and the list of his children to be correct. It should be stated, however, that this portion of the genealogy, as published, was not the work of the editor of this magazine, but that of a contributor who asked that her work be published. She withdrew it soon after and subsequent compilation is the work of the editor.

It is realized that discrepancies may still exist and it has been decided to give herewith what has been gleaned by us concerning Thomas Sherwood of Stratford in the way of comparison and for criticism and even controversy, which is invited in the hope of clearing up these matters. We ask only that in sending in your criticism and corrections that you cite your authority for your statement.

70. Justus Sherwood came in 1774, and settled on the farm now owned (1867) by Judge Elias Bottum, and erected his dwelling-a log house-exactly where Judge Bottum's family graveyard is.

71. Among the early settlers, it is due that we should mention Justus Sherwood, although the finale of his life was anything but such as demands the acknowledgement of obligations from an American. As already mentioned, he settled in 1774, on the farm now owned by Judge Bottum on Lancsborough St. He was Proprietor's clerk, from the first meeting held in town, Oct. 1774, until probably the latter part of 1776, when he left on account of the war. He planted a nursery of apple trees. In 1776 Mr. Sherwood returned as far as Shaftsbury. On a visit to Bennington-being not man to disguise his sentiments, he gave utterance to remarks that denoted sympathy with the royal cause at which the Whigs of that place taking offense, tried him before Judge Lynch and sentenced him to a punishment, of the precise character of which I am not informed, but which according to the account before me, was common to that place and time, in respect to a certain class of political offender, and much more amusing to the spectators, and wounding to the feelings of the culprit than to the body. Exasperated at this treatment, he raised a company of royalists and conducted them to Canada, and entered the British service. He was one of the agents employed by the English to conduct negotiations with the leading men of Vermont respecting its reannexation to Great Britain. After the war he received a pension of a crown a day during life, and the grant of 1200 acres of land in Upper Canada, opposite Ogdensburgh, N. Y.

IRA ALLEN, FOUNDER OF VERMONT-Wilbur

191. On August 12, 1780, Justus Sherwood transmitted to Gen. Powell the information that Vermont had made demands on Congress and added that he had "long been acquainted with Ethan Allen and most of the leading men in that country" and he would be "exceedingly happy" if he could help bring those "de-luded people to their right senses"... "which I think, may be done by buying their leaders."

192. On August 25, 1780, in answer to Gov. Chittenden's request for the exchange of prisoners, Gen. Haldimand decided to send a trusted agent to meet Gen. Ethan Allen, commander of the Vermont Militia. He selected a former Vermonter, an avowed Loyalist, Capt. Justus Sherwood, who when the war with England was declared, raised a company of royalists and joined the British forces in Canada. He had resided for many years in the Grants and knew Ethan Allen intimately. He was a man of char-

acter, educated beyond the average of those times, brave and trustworthy. It will be noted that he visited Vermont while the Legislature was in session at Bennington. Haldimand had trusted him with a more important negotiation than the exchange of the prisoners. He left Canada October 26th., with the intention of conferring with Ethan Allen in command at Castleton. Justus Sherwood returned on November 31st. to St. John.

"Capt. Justus Sherwood served in the 3rd. Company of the Royal Rangers. He was of Newtown, Conn. He took up land grants along the St. Lawrence River in Grenville County, Ontario, Canada. W. H. Leavitt, in his history of Leeds and Grenville Counties, states on page 53 "below Maitland previous to 1799, there were two schools in the neighborhood, one taught by the late Sheriff Sherwood, for the children of half-pay officers, and the other conducted by Price French for the poor settlers (children of private soldiers)."

ERRATA

On page 340 of the April 1949 issue of "Your Ancestors", it is stated that Elizabeth Jackson who married Isaac² Sherwood was the daughter of John Jackson and Elizabeth (Smith) who was daughter of Henry Smith and Ann (Pynchon), daughter of Gov. William Pynchon.

The latter part of this statement is erroneous as will be shown hereafter. First, a word of explanation concerning this greivous error.

The data contained in the issues of March and April 1949 was sent in by a contributor whose work we had agreed to publish. Immediately thereafter, it was withdrawn and data published since that time is the compilation of the editor. This early data was accepted at the time without question but so much doubt has arisen in our minds over the above statements that a check has been made to verify or disprove.

The main trouble with the Pynchon-Smith connections is due to the absence of dates and to the mix-up of Elizabeth Smith and Elizabeth Jackson who is called Elizabeth Jackson in her father's will.

To clarify this matter we give below the lineages of the various families involved with proofs:

However, "The First Century of the History of Springfield, Mass." by Henry Burt, 1899, volume II pp 637-8 gives 12 children including Elizabeth born 10-22-1644 (no more on her). The authority is Henry Smith's will dated 8-1-1681 which mentions inter alia "To my dau. Elizabeth Smith, not yet disposed of in marriage, I do give fifty pounds, to be paid at the time of her marriage, if she survived after her mother".

Elizabeth is also named inter alia in the will of her maternal grandfather, William Pynchon of Wrasbury, County Bucks, England, dated 10-4-1662: " To Elizabeth, Mary and Rebecca Smith, daughters of my son Master Henry Smith.." (See New England Hist. & Gen. Reg. for 1894, vol. 48 p. 255)

Therefore, it will be seen that Elizabeth Smith who married John Jackson was a daughter of Giles and that Elizabeth Smith, dau. of Henry was ' not yet disposed of in marriage" August 1, 1681 as shown in her father's will.
