AIRCRAFT STATES

The following are now the agreed Categories of serviceability and their interpretation of aircraft shown on states for overseas Commands, issued by W.O.7.

- A - Aircraft operationally serviceable or under inspection in units, and aircraft operationally serviceable complete with war equipment ready for issue to operational units.

Interpretation - Aircraft at flying units serviceable or undergoing minor and major inspection, and aircraft serviceable ready for operations at A.D.U's etc. Inspections at Repair Units will be classified in Cats.B or D as applicable.

- B - Aircraft which will become operationally serviceable within 14 days.

Interpretation - Aircraft undergoing repair inspection or erection which will be operationally serviceable within 14 days.

- C - All new aircraft either boxed or flight delivered which will not pass into Cat. A or B for at least 14 days.

Interpretation - Boxed aircraft awaiting uncrating and erection not expected to be completed within 14 days.

- D - Aircraft anticipated will be actually repaired and made operationally serviceable within a period of 2 months,

Interpretation - Aircraft anticipated will pass into Category 'A' within 2 months.

The aircraft will be shown in above categories in the following lines:-

- (a) Squadrons
- (b) Training Units
- (c) Other flying units
- (d) Depots, Parks, Storage and Repair Units, those in transit within the Command, i.e. those not shown in a, b or c.

Line (d) will thus show the aircraft in reserve against a, b and c.
