GENERAL DER NACHRICHTEN AUFKLÄRUNG  
(ARMY INTERCEPT SERVICE)

PROFILE

1. PW A is a Protestant pastor of German nationality, born in BESSARABIA, who went to GERMANY in 1930 and settled near OBERKORN. After an interpreter's course in Russian in 1941 he joined a German Level Staff which was to undertake the occupation of HUNGARY. In Mar 42 he was transferred to OKM/Chi and with a party from that Dept proceeded to Horchleitstelle (Ost) 10722 in Apr 42, to work as a cryptographer. He does not appear to have been very successful in crypto-analytical work; after specializing on NKVD traffic he took over the NKVD card index which was kept by Horchleitstelle (Ost) and later by Gen der Nachr Aufkl, Gruppe IV, Ref 3a. He is cooperative and has a reasonably good memory.
2. PW B is an electrician from OBERKORN. He served as an intercept operator with Class 7 at OKM in 1942 and in Jun 43 was transferred to Horchleitstelle (Ost). He was released from the Army for a short time to work as a technician with Firma ILMERS, and then rejoined the Army in Oct 43, Gruppe VI, Ref 1c, when he was assigned to the technical maintenance of intercept equipment. He is cooperative, but has only a limited field of knowledge.

3. PW D is the nephew of Fritz LÖBZEL, the New York correspondent, and before the war worked as a technician for Firma LÖBZEL. Since 1941 he has been employed as a technician looking after special intercept equipment, originally with Horchleitstelle (Ost), latterly with Gen der Nachr Aufkl Gruppe VI, Ref 1c. PW is cooperative, technically very able and exceedingly well-informed on intercept matters.
4. PW D was born in POLJAWA, RUSSIA, in 1911; he is the son of a German manufacturer. He was educated in the USSR and settled in GERMANY in 1930. After studying music at the Conservatoire in BERLIN he became a piano teacher. He was called up in 1941 and, being fluent Russian, was employed as a signals interpreter with forward intercept units until 1942. From 1942 until Aug 44 he was senior Russian instructor in 2nd Coy of Nachr Dolmetscher Ers u Ausb Abt. In autumn 44 he took a cryptographic course in JÜTTERBOG and then joined Gen der Nachr Aufkl Gruppe IV, Ref 1c. Here he was employed as a cryptographer on enciphered Baudot traffic and was attached to Gruppe VI, Ref 1c. PW is somewhat vain but nevertheless exceedingly brilliant. He has a phenomenal memory and his statements are quite reliable.
5. PW E is a student from DÜSSELDORF. In 1941/42 he was employed as an intercept operator with forward "Y" units. In Dec 42 he joined the Horchleitstelle (Ost) LÖTZEN and was absorbed into Gen der Nachr Aufkl, Gruppe IV, Ref 1c as an intercept operator for Baudot traffic. PW is intelligent and is well informed on intercept matters.
6. PW F was a student in BERLIN before the war. From 1941 he served as an intercept operator with forward "Y" units. He joined the Horchleitstelle (Ost) LÖTZEN in 1941 and has specialised as an intercept operator in Soviet inter-state traffic and in Baudot traffic. He was last employed in Gen der Nachr Aufkl, Gruppe VI, Ref 1c. PW is very cooperative and exceedingly well informed on Russian signals procedure.

7. The following were the main agencies responsible for Signals Intelligence in the German Army:
  - Forward "Y" units (Gen der Nachr Aufkl), who were administratively and operationally subordinated to the Chief Sign Officer of the local formation in the field, but who passed their material over to the Nachr Abteilung for further treatment.
  - Leitstelle 2 Nachr Aufkl (West). This unit was located at ZÜRSE and acted as the final signal centre for all Western European traffic. It was not informed on the cryptographic details of this unit, which has, however, already been dealt with in ref 130j.
  - Horchleitstelle (Ost), latterly until Oct 44 in LÖTZEN, which acted as the central cryptographic agency for Eastern front traffic and also for special tactical purposes under the cryptographic cover necessary for that sector. See para 130k.

OKI In 7/VI, latterly known as In 7/Wehr Aufkl, which, though in the Reserve Army, acted as the central cryptographic agency for the Army in respect of all traffic other than Russian. It has no special knowledge on this subject, which has already been covered in CIR 1535 and 1704.

8. General

In view of the reorganisation and rationalisation of the German Army Intercept Service which took place in Oct 44 and of the establishment of a centralised control under Gen d Wehr Aufkl, it is considered appropriate at this stage to discuss the organisation of Horchleitstelle (Ost) before that date in order to understand the changes that occurred.

Historical

9. Horchleitstelle (Ost) originally assembled in BERLIN in summer 41, moved to LÖTZEN as Gruppe VI of OKI/Chf HEW (Chief Sigs Officer of the Army). The Comd of this unit was Obstlt i G KETTLER, latterly Obst KETTLER and head of OKW/Chi; his successor in 1942 was Obst Baron von der OSTEN-SACKEN, who committed suicide after 20 Jul 44.
10. In summer 42 Gruppe VI Chf HEW moved to VLINITSA in the UKRAINE where it was expanded and reorganised as the Horchleitstelle (Ost). In Oct 42 the Horchleitstelle returned to LÖTZEN where it remained until the summer of 44, when it retired to ZOSEN.

11. Organisation

Horchleitstelle (Ost) was divided into the following Referate:

Referat 2: Personnel problems

Referat 1: Various duties including supply of equipment, maintenance, evaluation of captured documents and general research into wireless procedure, frequencies, etc.

Referat 2: Evaluation, compilation of intercept situation report, Wehr Aufkl through Ost.

Referat 3: Russian cryptographic section. This consisted of a nucleus of cryptographers, drafted to the unit at various stages, as well as of the cryptographers from the Russian Referat of In 7/VI under Inspector DITTMER who, it is believed, joined the unit in the autumn of 41. Additional cryptographers under the leadership of Prof SEVORUSOVICH of OKW/Chi joined the unit in spring 42 with the special task of investigating the Russian 5-figure Code. Prof SEVORUSOVICH returned to BERLIN in the autumn of 43, but his cryptographers were absorbed into the unit. As far as is known, all cryptographers in Referat 3 were absorbed into the unit, whatever their final destination may have been.

Referat 4: Specialised in the picking up of inter-Soviet State traffic, in the monitoring of the Russian wireless and the monitoring of RIASTER and TASS News Agency broadcasts. In the winter of 1942/43 Referat 4 also acquired the Braudot Reception Station which had moved from WINSTA.

12. Special Intercept Stations

The Horchleitstelle also controlled the Posto Horchstelle 11, otherwise known as FNAST 11, which picked up high grade Red Army traffic. The station was originally at WINNITSA and latterly in KIEV.

FOUNDATION

General

13. In Oct 44 the Gen d Nachr Aufkl was set up under the control of Obst ROEMMEL, who was directly subordinated to Chief HEW. The object of the organisation was to ensure centralised control of intercept policy and administration, and to rationalise in the use of man power.
14. The organisation of Gen d Nachr Aufkl is shown on Appendix 1 and described in detail in paras 16 et seq below. The changes which took place in the German Army intercept structure between Sep and Oct 44 are shown in Appendix 2. The process of cannibalisation is described in para 15 below.
15. Details of Cannibalisation Process

- (a) Forward "V" units, Kdr d Nachr Aufkl. These were not greatly affected by the change-over. They came under closer centralised control in matters of administration and signals intelligence policy and were no longer the exclusive concern of the Local Chief Sigs Officer. To improve the intercept service in the West, Höherer Kdr d Nachr Aufkl beim OB West (Obst KOPF), was set up to control the Western front intercept units.
- (b) Leitstelle d Nachr Aufkl (West) at ZOSSEN. This unit was absorbed virtually intact into Gruppe II of the Gen d Nachr Aufkl. Those sections dealing with personnel problems were absorbed into Gruppe Z, and those dealing with wireless and news agency monitoring into Gruppe I.
- (c) AG N/Nachr Aufkl (OMG In 7/VL). Appears with some slight depletion of personnel to have been absorbed completely into Gruppe IV (the Cryptographic Group) of Gen d Nachr Aufkl.
- (d) Horchleitstelle (OST) was cannibalised as follows:
- Referat Z to Gruppe Z
  - Referat 1 (Miscellaneous) to Gruppe V (Miscellaneous).
  - Referat 2 (Eastern Front Evaluation) to Gruppe III (Eastern Front Evaluation).
  - Referat 3 (Russian Cryptographic Section) to Gruppe IV (Cryptographic Section).
  - Referat 4 (Intercept Service on Soviet Traffic) to Gruppe II. Wireless and News Agency Monitoring to Gruppe I.

- (a) Recruitment. An increase in the number of British and American shipping traffic was detected from GROUP 3 to GROUP VI.

15. The HQ of General der Infanterie Aufkl consisted of three main sections:

Stab	Comm: Obstlt ANDRE
Unterstab	Comm: Oblt KÖBE
Gruppe Z	Comm: Maj HÜNER

Stab

DETAILS  
OF HQ

17. This component controlled the signals intelligence work of the HQ units of General der Infanterie Aufkl. These particular units were known as Gruppen I to VI. The control of Obstlt ANDRE also extended to the two special intercept stations, Fest. Hochstellen 6 and 11, which were directly subordinated to General der Infanterie Aufkl.

18. The authority of the Stab was exclusively in matters of intelligence policy and did not extend direct to intercept units in the field. It could however liaise with those through the Unterstab. The final responsibility for policy, issue of intercept reports and allocation of work within the Gruppen lay with the Stab.

Unterstab

19. This nucleus was created shortly after the foundation of General der Infanterie Aufkl in order to enable the Stab to co-ordinate in the internal work of the Directorate. The Unterstab was responsible for the intelligence control of the "Group Y" units on behalf of Capt BOETZEL, General der Infanterie Aufkl.

20. The intelligence control of the "Group Y" units was exercised direct in the case of KA 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 and via the Höherer Infanterie Aufkl from OB West in the case of KA 6(?) 5 and 6.

Gruppe Z.

21. This section was responsible for the general administrative control of all departments within General der Infanterie Aufkl. This included the Stab, the Unterstab, the various Gruppen in the Directorate, the "Group Y" units and the fixed intercept stations.

22. The control of Gruppe Z can be considered under the following four headings:

- (1) Personnel Matters: A central personnel office was set up at all times and reported to General der Infanterie Aufkl in addition to its normal functions. Gruppe Z was responsible for all transfers, in the Unter-Depotements, or outside the Unter-Depotement.

22. (cont'd)

- (ii) Registry Office (Registrar) This office registered all incoming and outgoing correspondence and was responsible for all courier work between the General d Nachr Aufkl and its outlying sub-units. For local couriers the Registrar and its own runners, but over long distances the courier services of the OAH were used. In addition the Registrar duplicated some reports for the individual Gruppen.
- (iii) Paymaster This section was responsible for paying all personnel of the HQ.
- (iv) Drawing Section In this department situation maps and WT networks were reproduced. A certain amount of photostat and book-binding activity was also carried on.

GRUPPE I

23. General

This section, directed by Anton FODENMÜLLER, was responsible for two main tasks;

- (a) the maintenance of comms between the units of General d Nachr Aufkl.  
(b) routine wireless monitoring duties.

Internal Comms

24. The signals officer of the Gruppe, Insp STRALENDORF, was in charge of a wireless centre and a teleprinter control centre which were centres of a network connecting the outlying units to the HQ. Teleprinter was the favoured method of comms until, in the final debacle, wireless took the most prominent place.
25. In the middle of Apr 45 a plan was evolved for setting up wireless stations in occupied parts of GERMANY for intercept purposes. Comms with these stations was to be maintained by the wireless centre of General d Nachr Aufkl. The plan was abandoned through the unfavourable development of the war.
26. Personnel employed by the comms services were almost exclusively women.
27. Monitoring Service

This section, known as Ic Rundfunkaufnahmestelle, was commanded by the RAUFERBERGER and had the following sub-sections:

- (i) Rundfunküberwachung; OST  
Owing to personnel shortage its efforts were restricted to monitoring the REDCOM wireless. Later on a certain amount of BLACK monitoring was initiated, particularly the TRUCKER and RUMELIN.
- (ii) Rundfunküberwachung; WEST  
Owing to personnel shortage this section dealt only with the monitoring of the BBC LORAIN service.
- (iii) Radio Agency  
This sub-section was responsible for News Agency intercepts. Owing to the manpower shortage, the intercept activities were concentrated on the REUTER Agency.

27. (contd)

(iv) Evaluation

The Evaluation sub-section was responsible for collating all information received from the three above-mentioned sub-sections and consolidating them into reports. Collated reports were issued, divided into several parts for political, economic or military news. These reports were circulated within various departments of the OMI. Frequently, owing to the political nature of the information, the reports were marked G. I. I. (Top Secret) although they were obtained largely from monitoring news wireless news. Special news flashes on items of current importance were also issued.

GRUPPE II

28. This section was known as Endauswertung WEST and was commanded by Hptm FIEHL. Formerly Gruppe II was known as Leitstelle der Nachrichten Aufklärung (.WEST) and was located at LOSSEN. In Oct 44 it was taken over intact, less its cryptographic sections, into Gruppe II, where it continued to carry out the same functions. As all six EW worked on the Eastern leg of German intercept, they are all-informed on the activities of this Department, save that it was organised on a similar basis to Gruppe III.

GRUPPE III

Office Organisation

29. This section, known as Endauswertung OSU and commanded by Hptm CORZOLLA, was responsible for the evaluation of all intercept and cryptographic work emanating from Eastern European traffic.

30. With the HQ of Gruppe III there was a special receiving office through which all messages emanating from the forward intercept units and fixed stations were passed. At the reception office the unit originating the message was identified by means of the call signs used. Unciphered messages were thence passed immediately to Gruppe IV for deciphering and messages which were already in clear were passed to the special evaluation sub-sections according to the nature of the traffic. In addition, deciphered messages were passed back from Gruppe IV through the reception office for evaluation. The head office of Gruppe III kept a Central Card Index in which call signs, cipher indicator groups and contents of messages were registered.

31. The Department was sub-divided into the following sections:

- Traffic Sorting Office
- Northern Sector Evaluation
- Central " " "
- South-in " " "
- MIWD Evaluation
- Partisan traffic Evaluation
- Swedish traffic evaluation.

Source of Information

32. The source of information for the evaluators were call signs, cipher indicator groups and OS numbers. On the basis of these it was possible to establish a detailed and accurate enemy order of battle and to glean valuable information of his movements and intentions.

33. Surveys were made daily and the subject of intelligence since they were most very successful in providing traffic details with precision and accuracy. Surveys show the work of major work over-increase and were frequently a source of identification.
34. The regulation of radio traffic was carefully watched, and reinforcements and movements of GVD formations normally indicated similar developments with the Field Div. They also gave a good picture of lines of communication activity. Interception of Partisan traffic sometimes enabled the German authorities to take precautionary measures in time.
35. Reports

(a) Consolidated

O/Ins ZIMMEL (assistant to FORZOLLI) was responsible for publishing the consolidated situation report, known as Nachrichten Aufklärungs Lage OST, of which 30 copies were produced. Nachrichten Aufklärungs Lage OST was compiled from a number of Funk Lage Berichte, which the special sections within Gruppe III produced. These sections each provided a part of the final report.

(b) Sector Reports

Each sector report was divided into two main parts. The first part consisted of a WI network which sketched the Order of Battle from Div upwards and indicated all signs and cipher indicator groups in use, as well as the location of wireless stations. The DF-ing of stations within the areas of the forward "I" units was done by the forward "I" units themselves. Information on other stations was passed back to Gen Der Nachr Aufkl, who were responsible for the necessary evaluation. The second part of each sector report consisted of the decoded text of intercepted traffic, above the level of Div, which had been either decoded at Gen Der Nachr Aufkl or already dealt with by the forward "I" units.

GRUPPE IV

General

36. This Department, commanded by Maj HENZE, was responsible for all cryptographic work at General Der Nachrichten Aufklärung. It covered the work of the Eastern and Western fronts.
37. Gruppe IV was built up from the following three sources: The 3rd Function 1/2 of the Aufklärung (formerly in 1/VI) and the Cryptographic Sections of Aufklärung für Nachrichten Aufklärung (West) ZOSSA, and the Nachrichten (OST) formerly at LÜZEL.
38. Gruppe IV was divided into separate Reports according to the width of the sector. Material dealt with in Gruppe IV consisted of traffic which the form of intercept units had picked up and had been used in the decision. A certain amount of aerial traffic was also picked up by the fixed intercept stations attached to the General Der Nachrichten Aufklärung. (See para 39 to 41).

38. Referat 1

Referat 1a

Included in this section, which is entitled Personnel, are the names of the various divisions of the railway. Further details are known to SW.

Referat 1b

Personnel section, including English and French speaking personnel and of the various divisions. Further details are known to SW.

39. Referat 2

This section deals with the direction of traffic in European traffic and also includes Belgian, Dutch and Italian citizens. Further details are known to SW.

40. Referat 3

East in front of neighboring.

Referat 3a

Dealt exclusively with SSWD traffic. A small section was devoted to research on reconstructing the railway and a larger section dealt on signaling work.

Referat 3b

Sub-section specializing in SSWD traffic.

Referat 3c

Responsible for signaling of partial traffic.

Referat 3 (Analytical section)

Carried out research on SSWD with an object in general.

41. Referat 4

It was the main program of this department. It consisted of the main work on the railway and on signaling work in particular.

42. Referat 5

43. Referat 6

This sub-section, organized as SSWD traffic, was a fairly small section and was divided into two parts, SSWD and SSWD traffic.

45. Referat 1 - Fern-Abhörschaltung

This section, under the direction of Lt. Colonel ZIMMER, was engaged in reconstructing Russian, British and American call signs and systems, and in those of Cuban units referred to. Other subjects covered included the general wireless procedures, frequencies, codes and abbreviations used by enemy wireless; allocation of wavelengths was also studied by this section. It has not a thorough knowledge of this section, but states that considerable success was achieved in reconstructing enemy wireless networks from research along the lines indicated.

46. Referat 2 - Beutenauswertung OST

This department was controlled by Lt. Colonel LOUK, the head of Gruppe V, in person. It was responsible for the exploitation of captured Russian documents of signs interest; capture manuals were translated and similarly descriptions of Russian equipment and standing instructions for Russian signals procedure were examined. At the end of the war Referat 2 had completed an up-to-date booklet on Russian abbreviations, which was ready for publication. This book was to have been made available to all forward intercept units.

47. Referat 3

This section had two tasks, that of supplying the forward intercept units with the necessary equipment and that of maintaining a workshop to service the needs of the General der Nachrichten Aufklärung.

GRUPPE VI

48. General

This dept, directed by Hptm RÖDER, was responsible for intercepting and evaluating special high-grade machine cipher.

49. Ref 1 A

This section dealt with the evaluation of Russian Inter-Soviet traffic picked up on Baudot networks. On the basis of this the Wehrwirtschaftsnachricht (WWT) were compiled. These bulletins gave a detailed summary of the Russian economic situation, particularly in the areas of MOSCOW, BIRMINGHAM, and included production figures and details of currency and labour situations. About 50 copies of this report were issued. Detailed card indexes of the economic nature were kept; they included names and locations of factories and production therein.

50. Ref 1 B

Operators of the cryptologic base who undertook research into the cipher machine employed for Baudot traffic carriers of the USSR. They also assisted Ref 1 C in preliminary evaluation.

51. Ref 1 C

This section dealt with Inter-Soviet and Inter-Army Baudot traffic and dealt with the preliminary evaluation of Red Army Baudot traffic. This traffic was in Russian cipher. On the

Since an analysis of this traffic interception report was brought out, giving the Order of Battle, German Situation, Frequencies, call signs and cipher keys for groups used in this traffic. This was passed to Group III for full evaluation. The preliminary evaluation was carried out jointly with Ref set 1 B.

52. Ref 2

This post, under Inspector WILM, coordinated special intercept work for Western European traffic.

53. Ref 2 A

Undertook preliminary evaluation of British and American MT teleprinter and automatic Morse traffic. PU cannot recall any further details of this activity except that some of it was directed at picking up multi-channel carrier frequency MT traffic.

54. Ref 2 B

This section comprised the technicians who picked up the traffic evaluated in Ref 2 A.

FIXED  
WIRELESS  
STATIONS

55. General

The following two fixed intercept stations were attached to General der Nachrichten Aufklärung. Both were subordinated to the Stab of General der Nachrichten Aufklärung for intelligence purposes and to Gruppe Z for administrative purposes.

56. Poste Hochstelle 5

This intercept station was subordinated to Hochleitstelle LÖTZEN before it was attached to General der Nachrichten Aufklärung. In 1945 it was evacuated along the following route: FÖSSH, BURE and OSCHNITZ, where the station was intermittently set up. It specialised in picking up Red Army and NKVD traffic and concentrated on high frequency traffic.

57. Poste Hochstelle 11

Attached to Hochleitstelle Ost. First at REITZ, then at LOTZEN. Later in 1944 it moved to SPRYAN, where it was subordinated to General der Nachrichten Aufklärung. This station specialised in picking up Red Army and NKVD traffic.

In 1944 General der Nachrichten Aufklärung was situated in and around the SPRYAN area, with the main headquarters at GOSSEN, Gruppe IV at JÄMMBOG and Gruppe VI at FÖSSH.

59. In MID 45 the GR moved out of RUSSIA and the Department of General Intelligence (Artillery) moved SOUTH as follows:

Gruppe Z - ZOSER, BROSAT, and REICHENFALL.

Gruppe I, II, III and V - ZUSSEN and BAD REICHENFALL.

Gruppe IV - Part I moved WEIMAR and GRODOW near WEIMAR, in particular report is that GRODOW near WEIMAR; others direct to BAD REICHENFALL.

Subsequently these remnants at WEIMAR and GRODOW re-joined the remnants of Gruppe IV at BAD REICHENFALL. The section of Gruppe IV at WEIMAR, namely the Hollerith component, remained in that area and it is believed that have been captured by the Americans (PW CS/2318 Ostlt WEIMAR confirms this).

Part BAD REICHENFALL in MID 45 report 1 of Gruppe IV moved to WEIMAR in the neighbourhood.

On 5 Apr 45 the remnants of Gruppe IV moved from BAD REICHENFALL to WEIMAR, where they were joined by Report 1 of Gruppe IV.

Gruppe VI - POESCH, STUTTGART, ROSENHEIM.

60. Final Picture

Gruppe Z, V, II, III and V: BAD REICHENFALL;

TECHNIQUES

CRYPTOGRAPHIC  
WORK OF GRUPPE IV

61. Gruppe IV received undecipherable traffic from several "Y" units. Its range of work as regards Russian ciphers was as follows:

62. 2-figure traffic

The Russians used large numbers of 2-figure keys, usually of two with multiple substitutions, used systematically or unregularly. Most traffic of this nature was located if a route was obtained. The number of different ciphers of this kind was in the thousands, and very hundreds of these were deciphered successfully.

63. 3-figure and 4-figure traffic

These appeared in the form of either:  
3-figure or 4-figure ciphers in which the cipher was constructed on individual letters or syllables, or:  
3-figure or 4-figure ciphers constructed either alphabetically or phonetically, systematically or unregularly. In addition, the ciphers of this type were used with cards, syllables or letters were used as frequently and cipher systems were used. Most traffic of this nature was deciphered in hundreds of different ways. Deciphering of this traffic was done by the use of a large number of keys. 64. 6-figure traffic

This form of traffic had many forms of assignment, the bulk were received system with special indicator groups, all based on a code. Particular traffic was also cut in codes, particularly in Partisan traffic, were reconstructed. It is possible that certain reciprocal 5-figure traffic was broken but not uncertain on this subject.

65. 5-letter traffic

This was picked up, but to Ws' knowledge never broken.

SPECIAL INTER-  
CAPT TECHNIQUES

66. The German intercept authorities dealt with the following special types of traffic:

X-traffic (X-Verkehr)

67. This consisted of Russian wireless telephone traffic. Attempts were made to pick up such traffic by equipment developed at the Bureau Val'ent under Dr LOTZE and operated at PLASTIC at KCHINSBERG during 1942-43. The traffic was also picked up by personnel in Ref 4 of Norddeinstelle (Oct) LOTZEN.

68. The channels monitored mainly from East of MOSCOW and were along lines MOSCOW-ALMA ATLA, MOSCOW-TASHKENT, MOSCOW-FRANZ. The traffic was chiefly of an economic character and was successfully recorded. In 1944 the Russians developed the bulk of their wireless telephone traffic and, after unsuccessful efforts to intercept it, the monitoring was dropped.

Y-traffic

69. This referred to the transmission of photographic messages by wireless means. Such traffic was picked up from all over the world, including lines from MOSCOW to STOCKHOLM; LONDON to MOSCOW; LONDON to CINCINNATI, NEW YORK and MOSCOW etc. Non-Russian channels did not yield any valuable intelligence as the photos intercepted were normally only of news agency interest. Internal Russian traffic of this nature did, however, yield technical drawings and charts which were communicated by wireless methods.

70. Y traffic was picked up in Ref 1 c of Gruppe VI. The activity was discontinued in Jan 45.

71. Z-traffic

This was the same system to Russian Bureau traffic, which the German authorities in intercepting at various stages of the war.

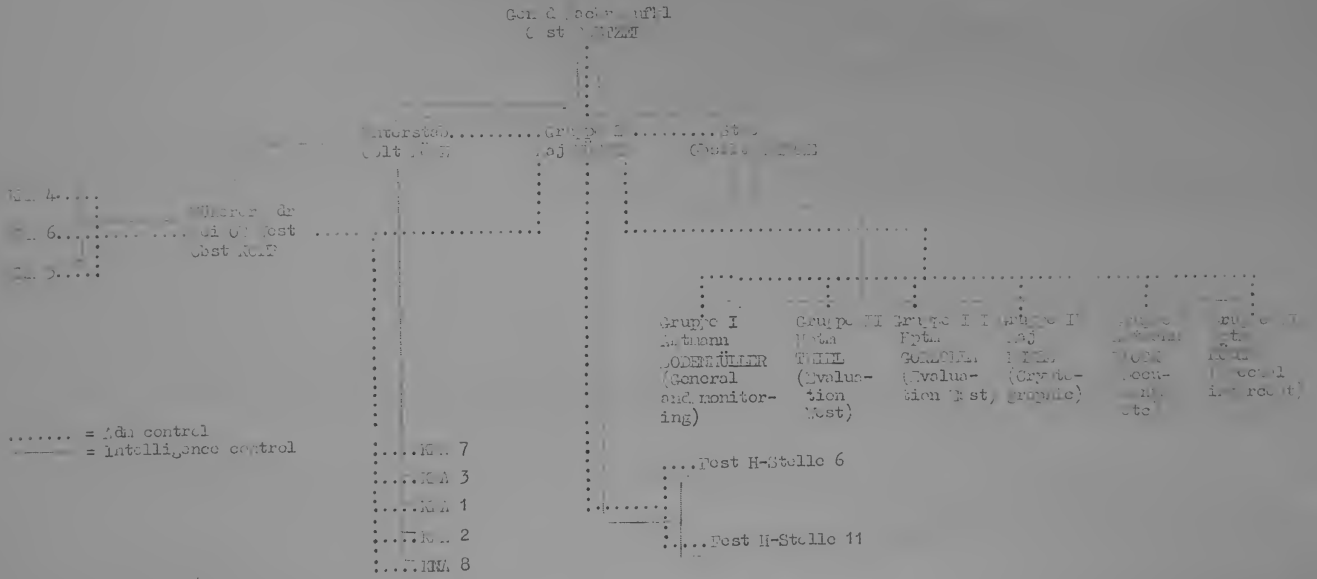

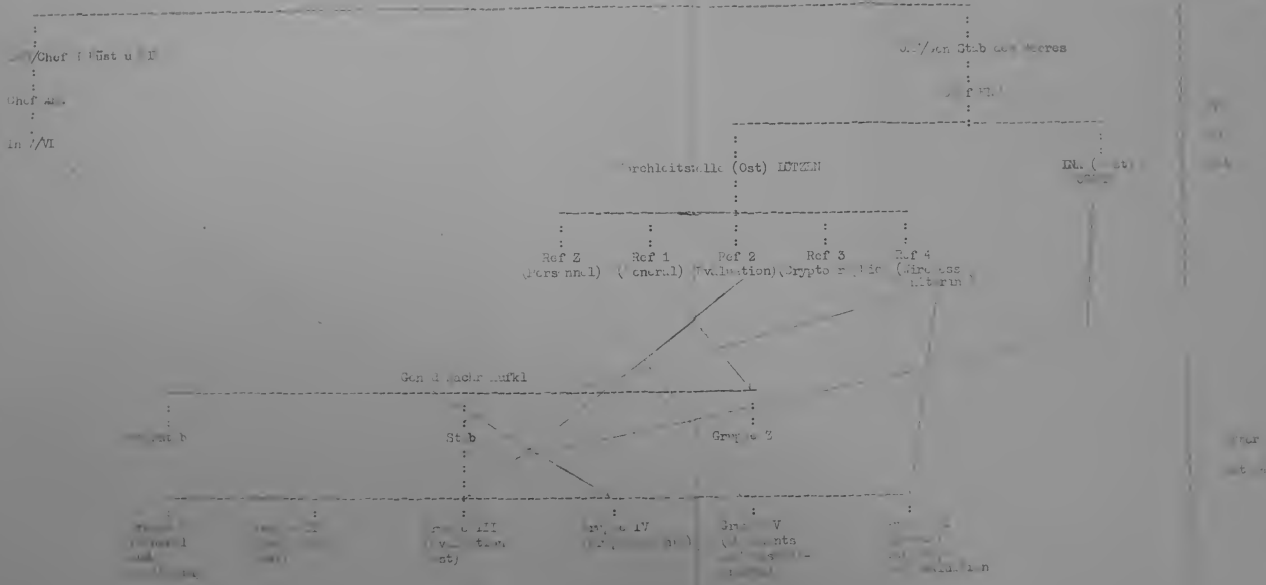
ANNEX 1
