"SHORT BROWN LIST"

The attached report lists ten German Cryptanalysts and Signal Intelligence Officers whom we have been unable to trace for interrogation and who are considered to be the most important individuals still outstanding as far as TICOM is concerned.

2. The list was signalled to G.S.I.(S), B.A.O.R., and to Director, A.S.N., Europe on 28th June, 1946, with the request that a final effort should be made to trace these individuals. This is now being done, and although several of the persons listed are almost certainly in Russian hands, the rounding up of any single one should be of real value.
3. Will any recipients who can provide additional relevant information regarding these persons please inform Commander Dudley-Smith, Room 31809, Eastcote.
