DEATHS

1. **Marquardt**, Sophie, bn. 2 Nov. 1829, in Fahrenholz, Germany, died 24 Apr. 1884, after long illness, age 53 yr. 5mon. 22 days. She leaves six children, 4 grandchildren, 2 sisters. Funeral text: Phil. 3:20,21.

2. **Dierks**, Georg, bn. 30 Dec. 1884 at Welge, Ill. , died 30 Jul. 1885, 8 am. in the morning, age 6 mon. 21 days, buried 31 Jan.

3. **Allwardt**, G. G. bn. at Clausdorf on 23 Apr. 1809, was married to Maria Elisabeth Weishen in 1850, came to America with his wife 6 Jul. 1868, to Ashford, Catterangus Co. NY. They were blessed with 7 children, 5 lived. He died in Wine Hill, Il. on 18 Jan. 1886, at age 76 yr. 8 mon. 26 days, leaving 5 children, 32 grandchildren, 3 Gr-grandchildren. Funeral Text: John 14:13. Rev. F. Schulz

4. **Schulz**, Caroline Sophie Emilie Ida, bn. at Welge, Ill, 23 Aug. 1886, died 18 Dec. 1886, at Welge, Ill. age 3 mon. 25 days. Rev. R. Knoll officiated at the funeral.

5. **Bartels**, Anna Margaretha, nee Meyer, bn. 14 Jan. 1820 at Hoenan in Hannover, was married to Claus Bartels in 1847 and in 1854 they came to America. Her husband died 10 Jul. 1881. They had eight children, four lived. She died at age 66 yrs. 11 mon. 19 days. Funeral text: I John 3:1,2. Rev. F. Schulz

6. **Schulz**, It has pleased the Lord to take from this life into Eternity, Caroline Sophie Elisabeth Schulz, the dau. of Mr. H. Welge and his wife, Caroline, nee Dettmer. Their dau. was born 23 Jun. 1864 at Wine Hill, and was confirmed at 14 yrs. of age. She was married 8 Nov. 1885 to The Reverend F. Schulz. On 23 Aug. 1886 God blessed them with a child, and on 18 Dec. 1886, the child died. Caroline died on 26 Mar. 1887 at the age of 22 yrs. 9 mon. 3 days., she was buried 29 Mar. 1887. Pastor R. Knoll of Mt. Olive, Ill. officiated at the funeral, text: Philip. 3:20,21.

7. **Sickmeyer**, Clara Sophie, bn. 5 Aug. 1890 at Welga, Ill. died 7 Apr. 1892 at the age of 1 yr. 8 mon. 2 days. Funeral text: John 17: 24.

8. **Clasen**, Johann Heinrich Georg, born 27 Aug. 1835, left his home in Germany and came to America when he was 20 yrs. old, he worked his way to the state of Illinois, making his home here. His health declined as he grew older, his strength decreased and on 13 Jan. 1894, he quietly and without pain, passed away. He was 58 yr. 3 mon. 17 days old.

9. **Welge**, Heinrich Conrad Adolf, was born 8 Oct. 1863 in Wine Hill, Ill. He was confirmed 9 Apr. 1876 and 8 years later he married Miss Auguste Welge and they had 10 years together. He became ill and on Tuesday, around 11 am. 23 Oct. 1894, he passed away. He was buried 25 Oct. at age of 31 yr. 15 days. Funeral text: John 11:25 Rev. Krieger

10. **Dierks**, Heinrich Louis, was born 14 Jun. 1814, Provinz Hannover, Germany, he left his fatherland and came to America. He lived in Illinois over 30 years, he was steady and constant in his belief of God and Lutheran doctrine, a vigorous singer. He died 16 Feb. 1895 of pneumonia, buried 18 Feb. He was the father of four sons and three daughters. He was 80 yr. 8 mon. 2 days old. The Funeral text was I Pet. 1:13. Rev. Krieger
