Is there a specific reason why BGen Huglin's current bio identifies his middle name as "Quisckey"? Army & Air Force documents I've located from 1929 to 1953 list BGen Huglin's middle name as "Quiskie," from his 1929 USMA graduation to multiple editions of the Congressional Record from 1941 to 1946 and the 1953 AFHRA Historical Study 91. Huglin's grave at Arlington National Cemetery only uses his middle initial. (Note: I'm a retired AFSC 3H091 Enlisted Historian doing research on Air Force generals) Hope to hear if it's a typo or if something fundamental changed in BGen Huglin's name. Thanks!
